## Summary

- Our enrollment continues to increase, but at a lower rate than in the fall. It increased 2\% over Spring 2004.
- Hispanic enrollment increased by 12\%. African American enrollment increased by $2 \%$. White enrollment decreased slightly by $0.4 \%$.
- African American students are the largest ethnic group at Delgado making up 43\% of the students attending Delgado.
- $57 \%$ of our students are minorities.
- Both Male and Female enrollment increased by only $2 \%$.
- The Northshore Site had the largest increase at $11 \%$. Charity School of Nursing follows with 10\%. City Park increased by 1\%. West Bank Campus had an 1\% decrease.
- The age group of 18 years and under decreased by $14 \%$. Age group of 50-64 year olds increased by $30 \%$.
- Part time increased from 9,268 to 9,677.
- First-time Freshmen decreased 13\%, Readmitted students increased by $16 \%$.
- Nursing majors (including pre-nursing) increased by 9\%. Physical Therapy Assistant increased by 14\%. Computer Information Technology decreased by 29\%
- Enrollment from St.Tammany Parish increased 11\%.
