POLICY STATEMENT

Delgado Community College recognizes the benefit of involving community members in accomplishing its mission. To this end, the College officially sanctions the establishment of a Board of Visitors as an unincorporated association designed to serve the College. Specifically, members of the Board of Visitors serve Delgado by:

- gathering valuable information that provides guidance on the direction of programs and services;
- serving as ambassadors through informing the general public of the College's mission, goals, and values; and
- assisting with securing support for Delgado initiatives by relating the needs of the College to interested groups and individuals.

The Board of Visitors is established as a college-wide association, with each member assigned to specific campuses, sites or units. These are the City Park Campus, West Bank Campus, Charity Campus (including Allied Health programs), Delgado Northshore, Workforce Development and Education, and Region 1 Technical Campuses. The Board of Visitors operates through established bylaws, and membership consists of individuals with experience and knowledge of the College's programs and services, as well as strong community and civic involvement in the service area of the assigned campus, site or unit.
