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## SUMMARY

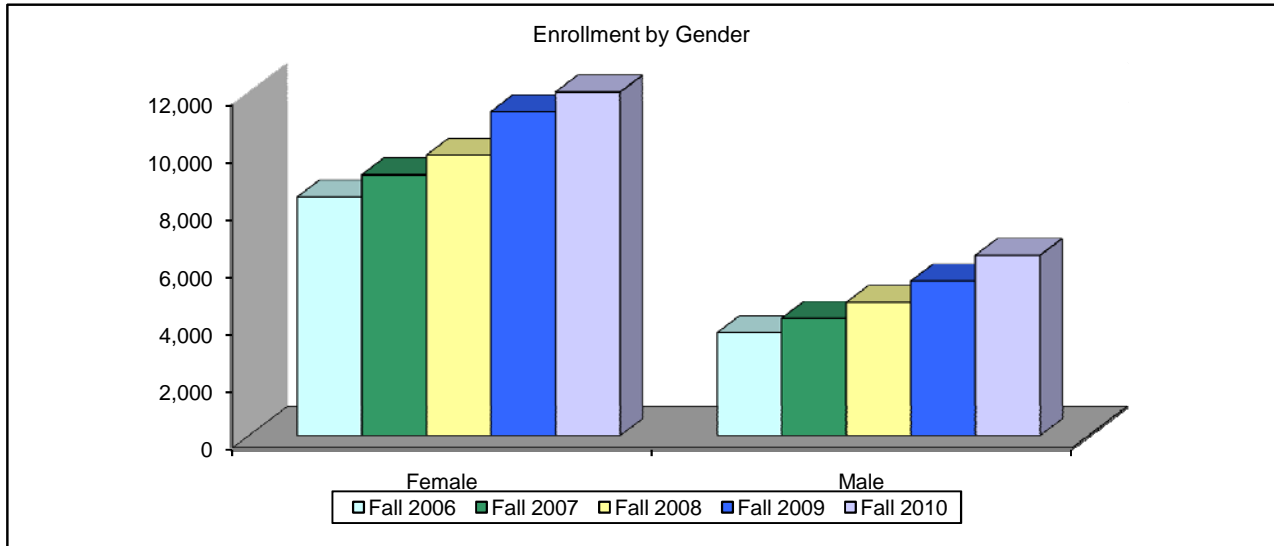
- ✓ Enrollment increased 12.3% from Fall 2009 (16,715) to Fall 2010 (18,767).
- ✓ 4.6% of the increase was a result of the merger with Louisiana Technical College - Region 1, which became the Technical Division of Delgado on August 25, 2010.
- ✓ Male students increased by 16.7% from Fall 2009; female students increased by 10.2%.
- ✓ African American enrollment increased by 16.4% from Fall 2009.  
African Americans now make up 38.4% of our enrollment, up from fall 2008 (37%), but still less than the pre-Katrina 42%.
- ✓ Hispanic enrollment increased 15.7%.
- ✓ Caucasian enrollment increased by 3.5%
- ✓ The Northshore site had the largest increase from Fall 2009 with 11.4% gain in enrollment.  
City Park campus increased by 10.6% and West Bank campus increased by 1.2%.  
Charity School of Nursing increased by 7.3%.
- ✓ First-time freshman increased 13.1% , continuing students increased 17.8%.
- ✓ Pre-Nursing, General Studies and Radiologic Technology had the largest enrollment in Fall 2010.
