The College of Arts and Sciences of the Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) and the Arts and Humanities Division of Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students that complete the courses prescribed in **Delgado's Criminal Justice Associate Degree to transfer and leads to a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice and a minor in Sociology from the College of Arts and Sciences at SUNO.**

Delgado 2 SUNO Agreement

Program

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an associate degree in Criminal Justice will be admitted as juniors in the College of Arts and Sciences at the Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) provided they meet SUNO's admission requirements. Course requirements for Delgado's associate degree in Criminal Justice are described on page two of this document.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree from SUNO is 120 semester hours and students can transfer up to 65 semester hours for degree credit from Delgado to SUNO. This is a 2+2 program in which Delgado students will earn a bachelor's degree from the Southern University of New Orleans after successfully completing at least 55 additional semester hours in a prescribed major at SUNO and meeting all SUNO degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the SUNO Undergraduate/ Graduate Catalog in force at the time they enter Delgado provided it is not over 10 years old and provided there was no break in enrollment of over 5 years.

In order to graduate from SUNO, students must complete at least 50% of general education courses, 16 credit hours in criminal justice, and 6 hours in sociology at SUNO, and achieve a quality point ratio of 2.0 or better in all work attempted, all work taken at SUNO, and all courses in the major and minor taken at SUNO.

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1. Students may graduate with an Associate's Degree from Delgado with Math 118. In order to participate in the articulation agreement with SUNO, students must successfully complete either Math 128 or Math 130 at Delgado OR successfully complete Math 151 at SUNO.
2. The 7 hours of natural science requirement must be completed in a series in the same subject plus a one hour lab. (i.e., 6 hours of Biology plus a Biology Lab).


Program Renewal


