AGREEMENT BETWEEN

The Department of Education of Our Lady of Holy Cross College

AND

The Education Department of Delgado Community College (Delgado)

Fall 2015 through Fall 2017

The Department of Education of Our Lady of Holy Cross College (OLHCC) and the Division of Arts and Humanities of Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+ 2 program. This 2+ 2 program allows students who complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's Associate of Science Degree in Teaching to transfer to OLHCC and will lead to a Bachelors of Arts or Bachelors of Science Degree in Elementary Education from Our Lady of Holy Cross College.

2 + 2 Agreement

Program

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an Associate of Science Degree in Teaching will be admitted as juniors in the Education Department of Our Lady of Holy Cross College (OLHCC), provided they meet OLHCC's admission requirements and have successfully passed PRAXIS I and the Elementary Education Content Knowledge Section of PRAXIS II. Course requirements for Delgado's associate degree in teaching are described on page two of this document.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from OLHCC is 123 semester hours, and students can transfer up to 60 semester hours for degree credit from Delgado to OLHCC. This is a 2 + 2 program in which Delgado students will earn a bachelor's degree from OLHCC after successfully completing at least 63 additional semester hours in the Elementary Education Program at OLHCC and meeting all OLHCC degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the OLHCC Undergraduate Catalog in force at the time they entered Delgado provided the Catalog is not over 10 years old. In addition, there shall be no break in student enrollment over 5 years.

In order to graduate from OLHCC, students must complete at least 50 % of Education courses at OLHCC and achieve a quality grade-point ratio of 3.0 or better in all Education coursework. Students must maintain a minimum grade-point average of 2.5 overall.

Program Evaluation

This agreement will be renewed every three years from the date of signing and will be continued, modified, or terminated upon mutual agreement of the parties.








