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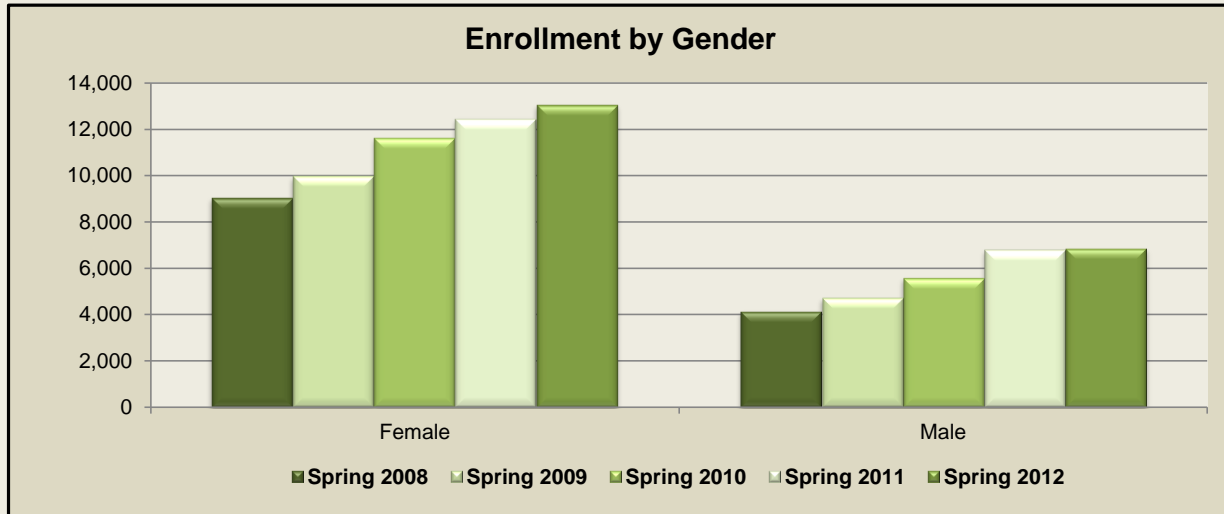
SUMMARY

- ✓ Enrollment increased 3.4% from Spring 2011 (19,258) to Spring 2012 (19,909).
- ✓ Male students increased by 0.8% from Spring 2011; female students increased by 4.8%.
- ✓ African American enrollment increased by 7.4% from Spring 2011.
African Americans now make up 42.2% of our enrollment, up from Spring 2011 (41%).
- ✓ Hispanic enrollment increased 7.0%.
- ✓ Caucasian enrollment increased by 0.7%.
- ✓ The Northshore site had the largest increase from Spring 2011 with 5.8% gain in enrollment, City Park campus increased by 4.7% and West Bank campus increased by 3.1%.
- ✓ Charity School of Nursing decreased by -1.4% and Technical site decreased by -12.4%.
- ✓ Exchange students increased 11.2% , Readmitted students increased 4.9%.
- ✓ Pre-Nursing, General Studies, Business & Management, Radiologic Technology and Business Administration had the largest enrollment in Spring 2012.

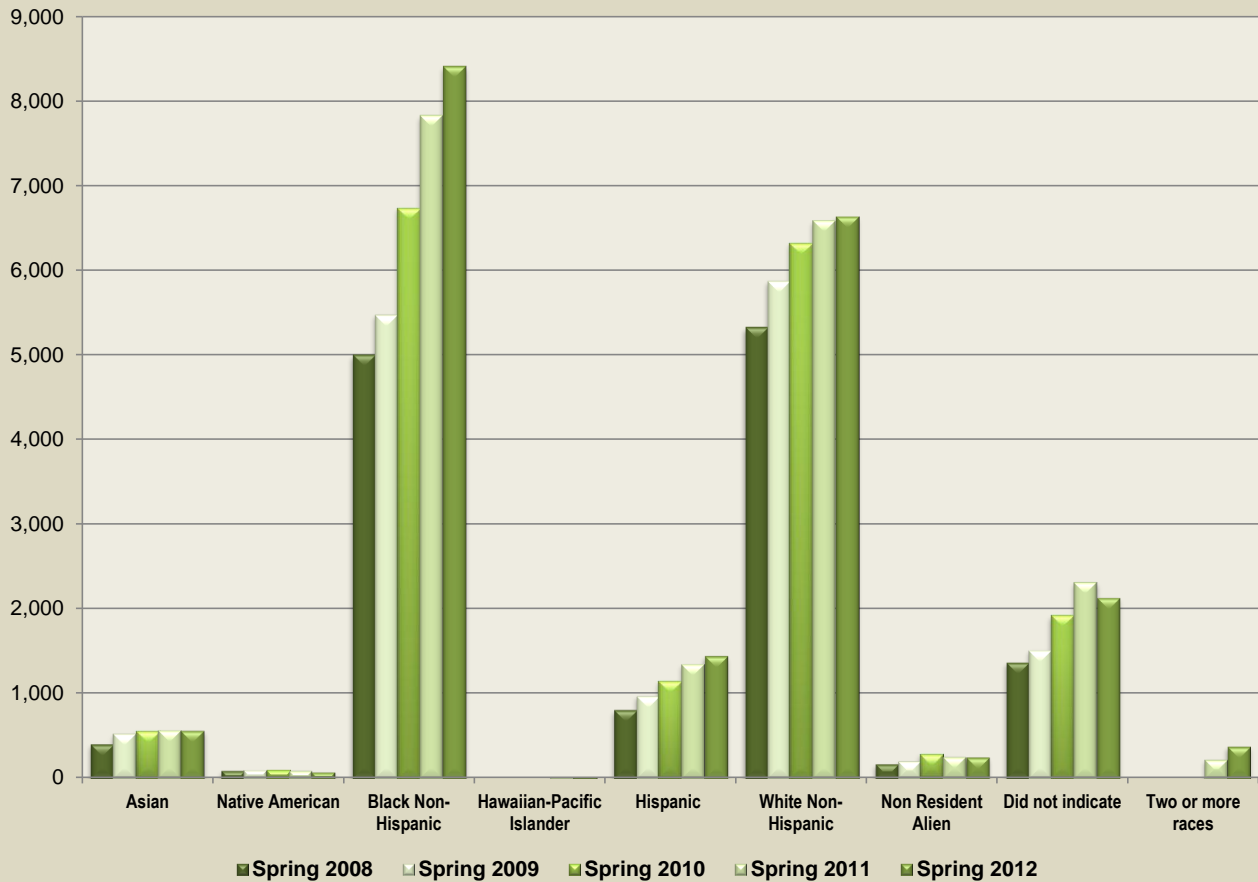

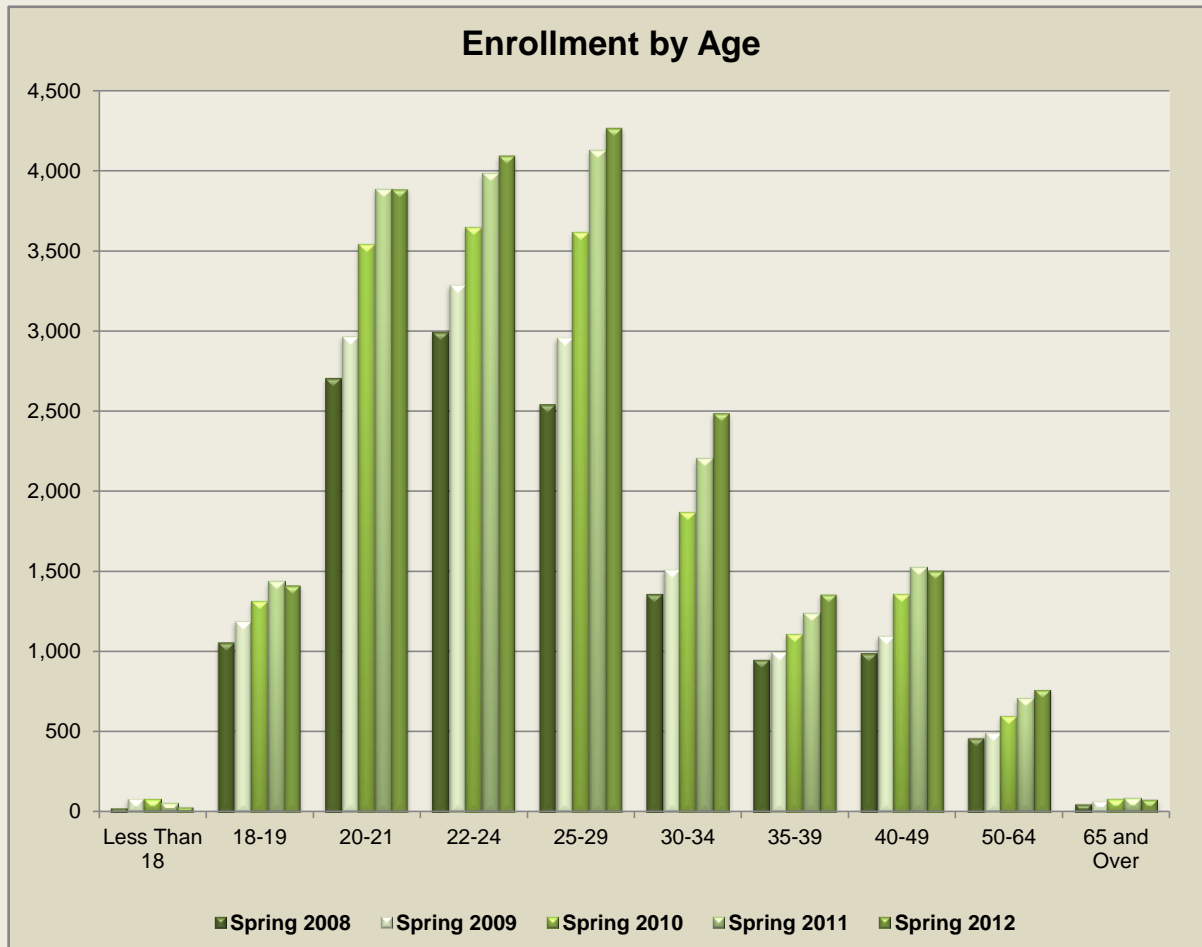

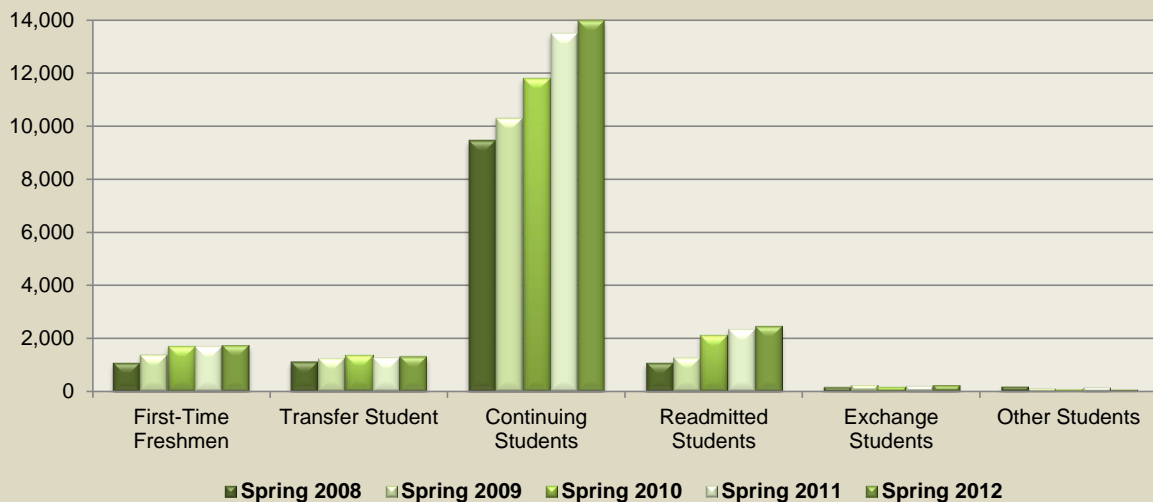

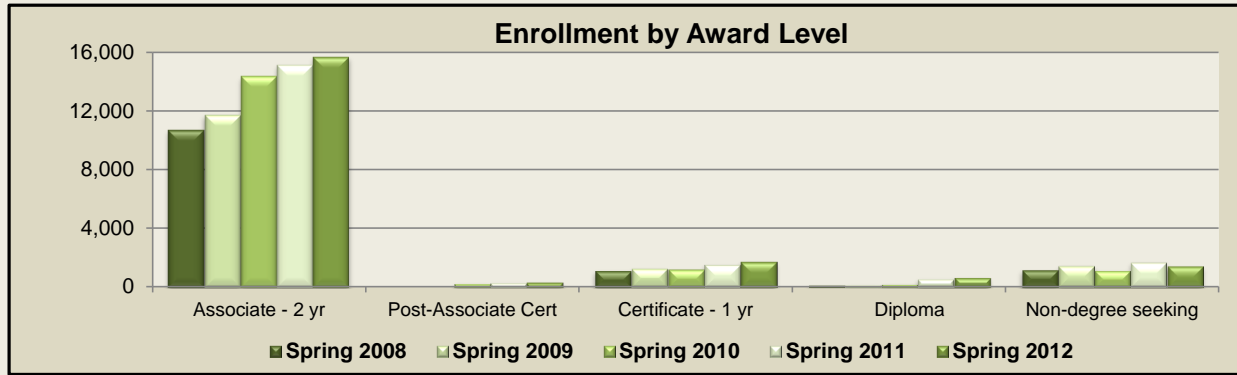

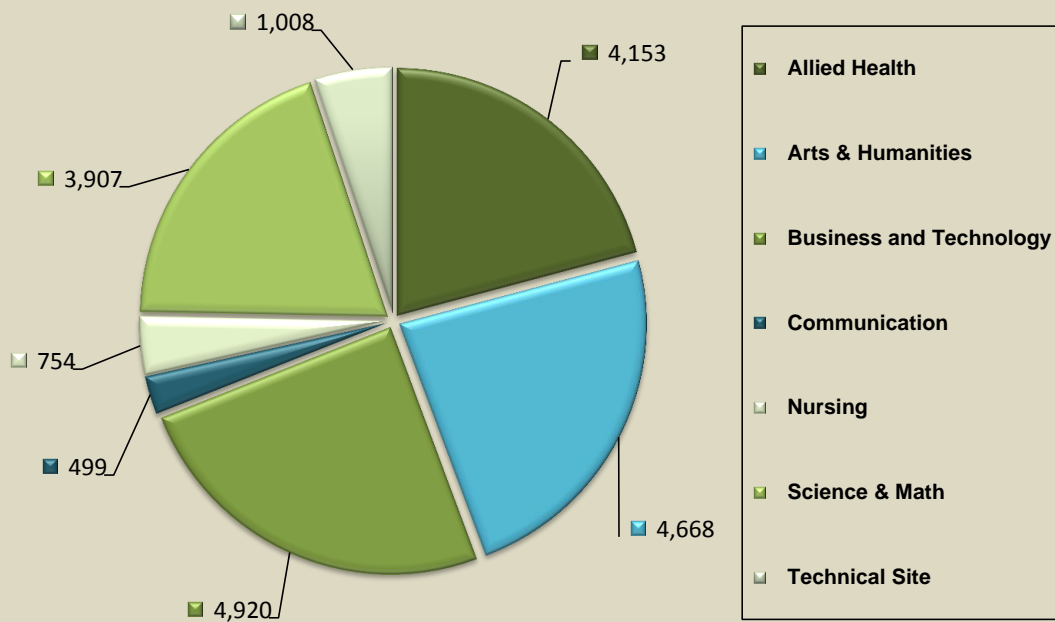
