

## **Fourteenth Day Enrollment Report**

**Fall 2013**



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## SUMMARY

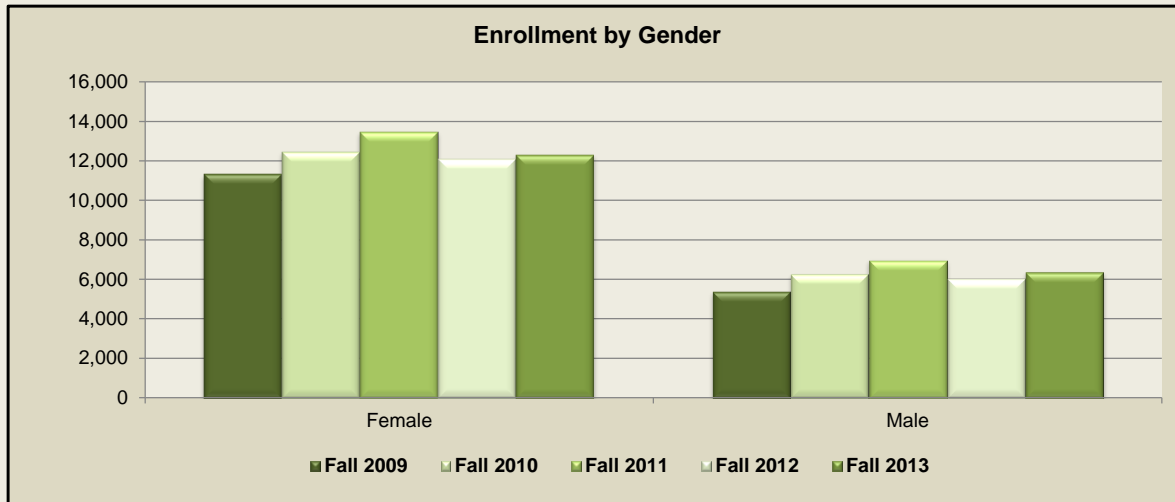
- ✓ Enrollment increased 3% from Fall 2012 (18,115) to Fall 2013 (18,684).
- ✓ Male students increased by 5.5% from Fall 2012; female students increased by 1.9%.
- ✓ African American enrollment increased by 9.7% from Fall 2012.  
African Americans now make up 44.9% of our enrollment, up from fall 2012 (42%).
- ✓ Hispanic enrollment increased 4.6%.
- ✓ Caucasian enrollment decreased by 3.1%
- ✓ Continuing students decreased 0.7% , Readmitted students increased 14.6%.
- ✓ The number of students taking an online course increased by 14.0% from Fall 2012.
- ✓ Nursing, General Studies and Business & Management had the largest enrollment in Fall 2013.
