## **PROGRAM**

Delgado Community College students with an Associate of Arts degree in American Sign Language Studies will be admitted as juniors in Interdisciplinary Studies at the University of New Orleans provided they meet UNO's admission requirements.

The total number of credit hours required to complete the IDS degree at UNO is 120 hours and students can transfer up to 60 semester hours with a grade of C or better for degree credit from Delgado to UNO. This is a 2 + 2 program in which students transferring from Delgado will earn a Bachelor's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from the University of New Orleans after successfully completing at least 60 additional semester hours meeting all UNO and Interdisciplinary Studies degree requirements.

Students will follow the requirements in the UNO undergraduate/Graduate Catalog in force at the time they enter UNO.

The University of New Orleans is in full compliance with Louisiana Act 356.

## **PREREQUISITES**

Some courses in this program may require prerequisites. Students are responsible for all decisions regarding selection of course work and meeting prerequisites. See the Delgado and UNO catalogs for specific information.

1. Maximum 60 hours of course work completed at Delgado with grade of C or better.
2. General education, elective, or prerequisite work remaining at UNO. Will vary with program completed at Delgado.
3. Upper-division (3000-4999) course work dedicated to Integrative Learning Plan (ILP).
4. Upper-division (3000-4999) course work supporting ILP development or elective.

The Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies is a unique and rigorous degree program administered by the Office of Academic and Student Affairs at the University of New Orleans. The program provides versatility for students seeking to design an academic plan of coherent concentrations through the process of integrative learning.

Integrative learning refers to the process of combining and coordinating academic elements into a whole or aggregate. IDS students develop a 36-credit hour integrative learning plan (ILP) with the guidance and assistance of IDS professional staff. The ILP will incorporate a minimum of two disciplines that clearly represent a focus for the student's studies.

Students eligible to participate in the 2+2 agreement will have the option to use ASLS as a discipline within their ILP. Examples of past ILP concentrations incorporating ASLS have included Business and Urban Studies, Health Studies, Legal Studies, American Studies, and Behavioral Studies. Through personalized academic planning and advising, additional coursework will be selected to support the student's personal and professional development.

## TERM AND TERMINATION

This agreement shall be for a period of three years from the date of execution and may be amended or extended by mutual consent of the parties. Either party may cancel this agreement by providing 30 days written notice to the other party.


## PROGRAM EVALUATION AND RENEWAL

Interdisciplinary Studies at UNO and American Sign Language Studies at Delgado will evaluate the progress of the 2 + 2 program on an annual basis and the results of the annual evaluation will be reviewed by both parties.






