Figure 1. Total Awards and Total Graduates for 2010-2011 to 2014-2015 Academic Years




Figure 3. Graduates in 2014-2015 Academic Year by Ethnicity





Figure 2. Graduates in 2014-2015






Figure 4. Graduates in 2014-2015 Academic Year by Degree Type


