

**Articulation Agreement
Dillard University and Delgado Community College
2015 - 2020**

Dillard University (Dillard) and Delgado Community College (Delgado) hereby enter into an articulation agreement to establish a transfer program that will bridge the Delgado Associate Degree to a Dillard Baccalaureate Degree for the programs outlined in the agreement.

Admission Requirement

- Ensure acceptance of prior coursework from Delgado students who have completed the associate program with an overall 2.0 GPA and a letter grade of C or better in all transferrable coursework.
- Guarantee admission to Dillard at junior standing with the acceptance of 60 semester hours from Delgado. Students will be made aware of additional prerequisites and coursework needed to complete the baccalaureate degree.
- Facilitate the waiver of the initial admission application fee at the time of admission to Dillard.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the Dillard undergraduate catalog in the semester/year of entrance, provided there has not been a break in enrollment from the completion of the associate degree at Delgado to entrance into Dillard of more than five (5) years.

Evaluation

On an annual basis the Dillard University Office of the Recruitment, Admission and Programming will report to the Delgado Office of Academic Affairs the number of students who applied for admission, number of students admitted, retained and graduated.
