SUMMARY

- ✓ Enrollment decreased 5.1% from Spring 2017 (14,331) to Spring 2018 (13,596).
- ✓ Male students decreased by 7.8% from Spring 2017; female students decreased by 3.9%.
The percentage of Delgado Community College students who are female is at a five-year high.
- ✓ Hispanic enrollment increased by 3.7% from Spring 2017 and is now above 10% for the first time.
Black Non-Hispanic enrollment decreased by 5.3%.
- ✓ White Non-Hispanic enrollment decreased by 8.8% to a five-year low.
- ✓ Enrollment at the Sidney Collier and Charity School of Nursing campuses reached five-year highs.
Enrollment at the City Park campus declined 7.6% to a five-year low.
- ✓ Students seeking 1- and 2-year degrees sank to five-year lows in favor of non-degree-seeking students.
- ✓ The percentage of students taking online or only online classes were nearly flat.
The average number of online courses taken by students was 1.99, a five-year high.
- ✓ Nursing, General Studies and Dual Enrollment had the largest enrollment in Spring 2018.

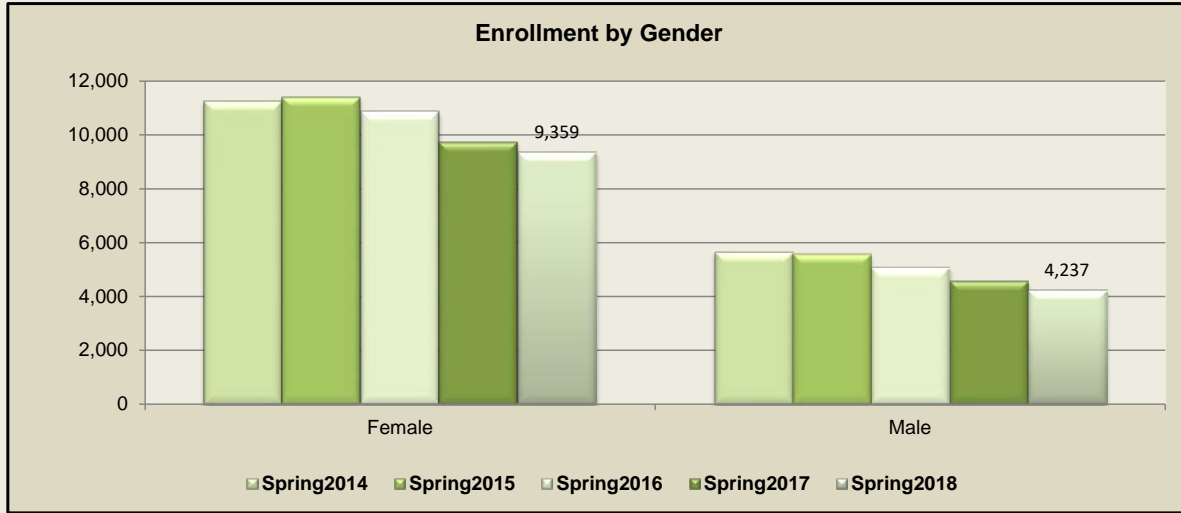

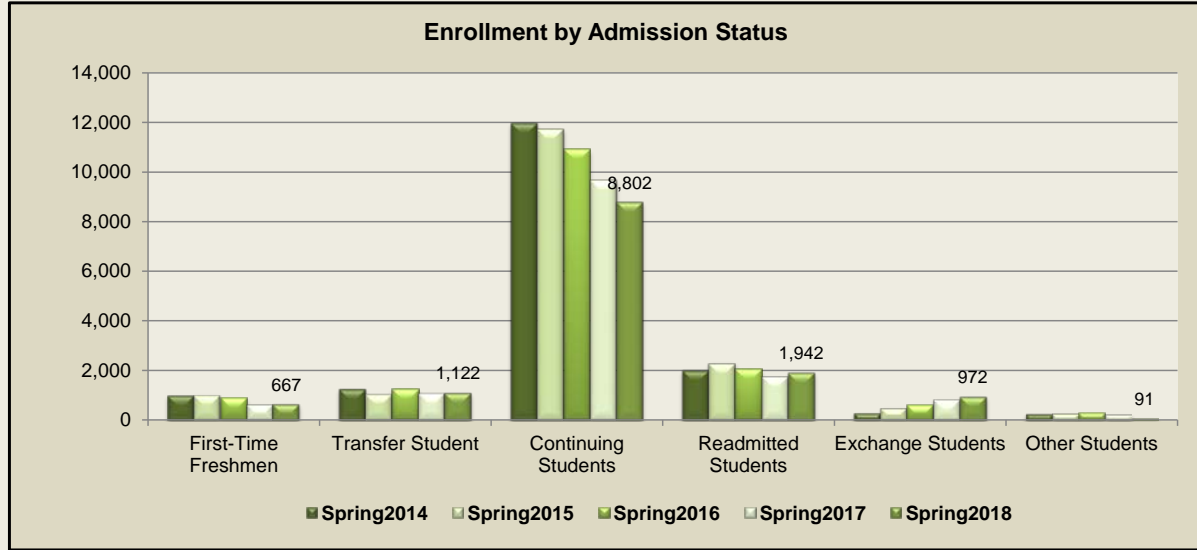

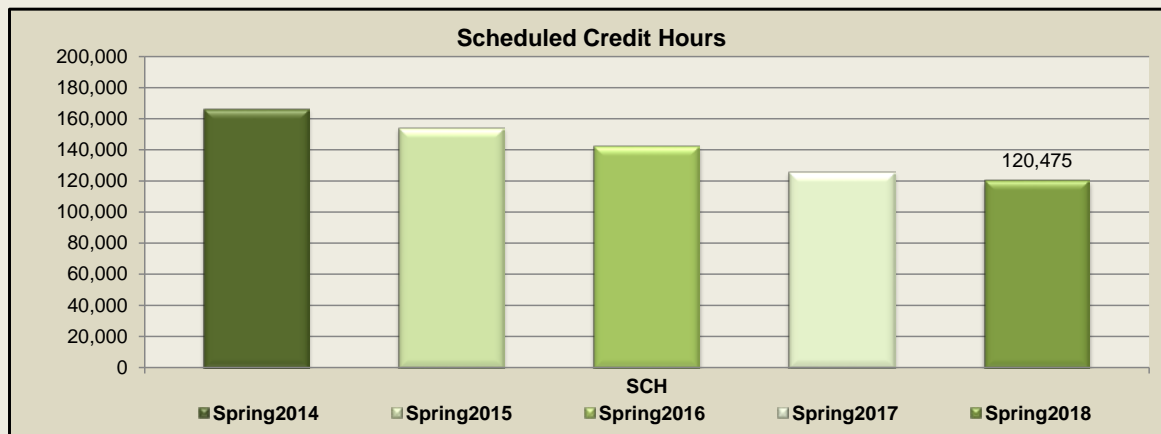
