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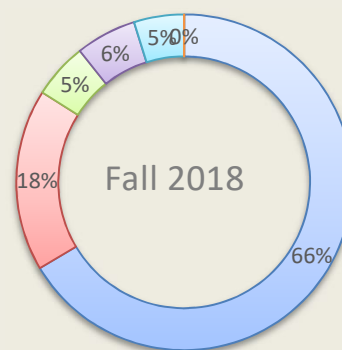
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SUMMARY

- ✓ Delgado's seven-year downward trend in fall enrollment flattened this year, with enrollment rising from 14,240 to 14,258 (0.1%).
- ✓ The proportions of male and female students remained steady, with 68% of students being female.
- ✓ Hispanic enrollment continued its upward trend, increasing by 6.0% to nearly 11% of all students.
- ✓ Returning students increased by 12.4% from last year, mostly at the expense of visiting students.
- ✓ Delgado enjoys a large crop of freshmen this year, up 10.5% from last fall.
- ✓ Students taking only face-to-face classes declined by 1.2% from Fall 2016. Online-only students decreased by 1.7% and are now 13.3% of all students.
- ✓ Nursing (18.0%), General Studies (10.4%) and Business & Management (5.5%) have the largest Programs of Study enrollment in Fall 2018.

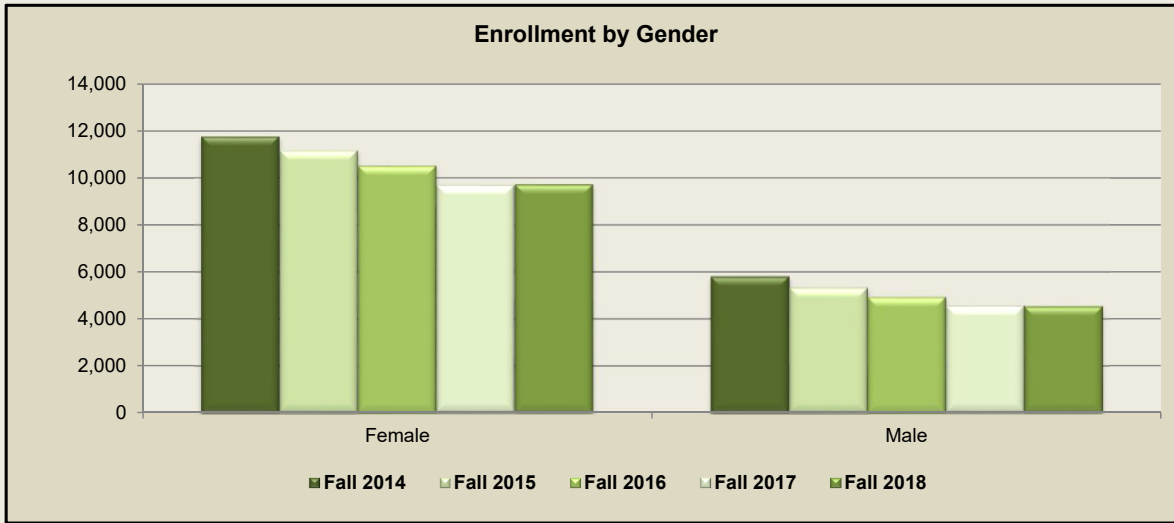

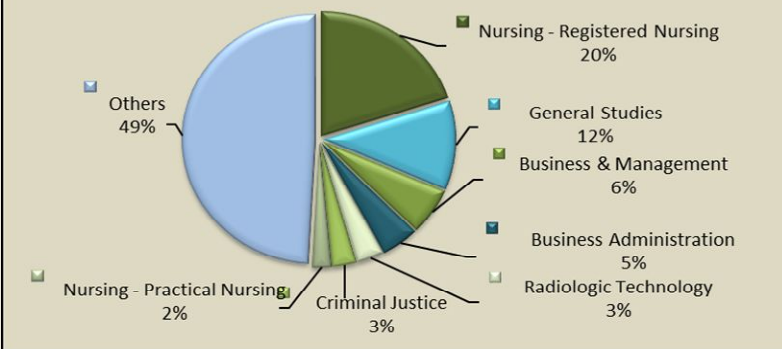

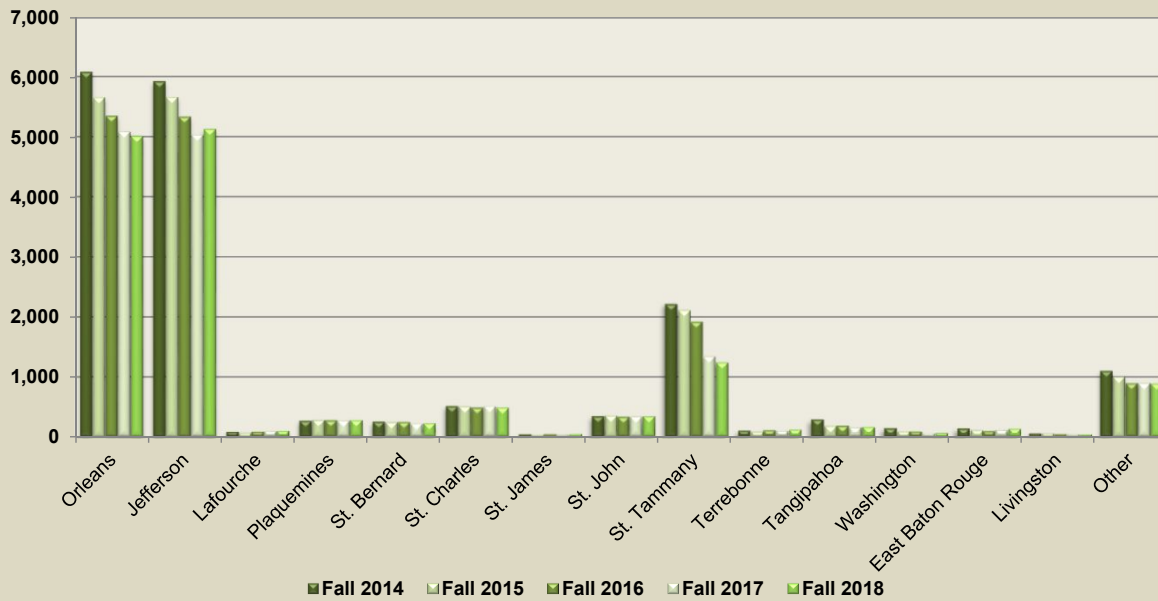
Fall 2017 Top 7 Major/Program
