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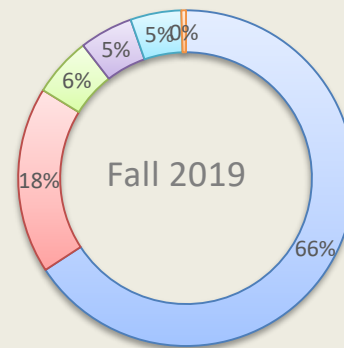
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SUMMARY

- ✓ Delgado's fall enrollment sank to a ten-year low in 2019, with headcount declining 0.8% from 14,258 to 14,140.
- ✓ The proportions of male and female students remained steady, with 68% of students being female.
- ✓ The Pacific Islander population at Delgado continued to grow, and now accounts for one in forty students.
- ✓ Dual-enrollment students remained a growing population; 5% of students are now preparatory.
- ✓ Full-time enrollment dropped precipitously, dipping to 34% for the first time this millennium.
- ✓ 39% of all students attended at least one class online -- an all-time high -- taking an average of 2.01 courses online. 16% of students took only online classes, also an all-time high.
- ✓ Nursing (19.6%), General Studies (10.1%) and Business & Management (6.5%) have the largest Programs of Study enrollment in Fall 2019.

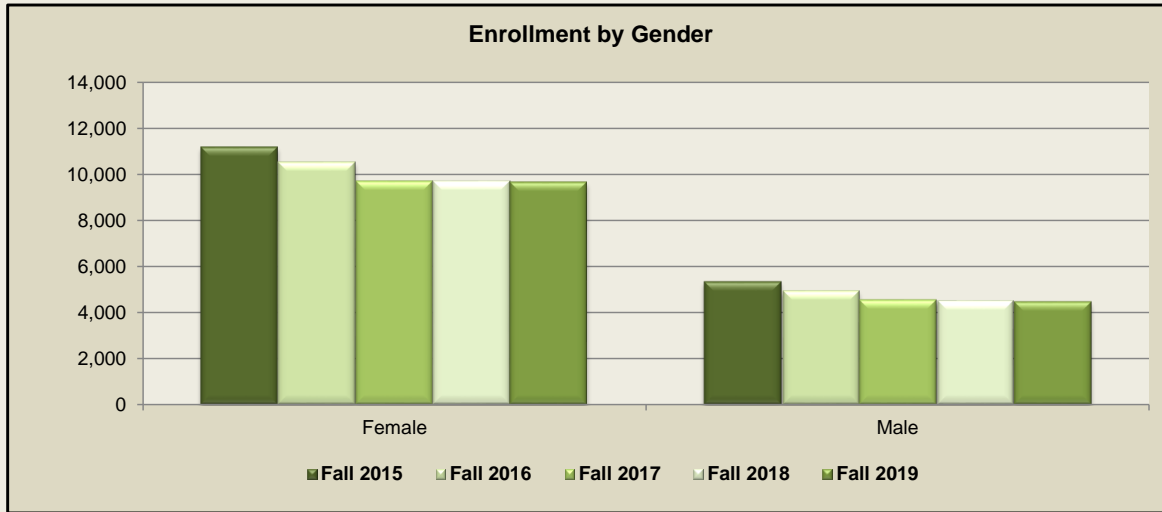

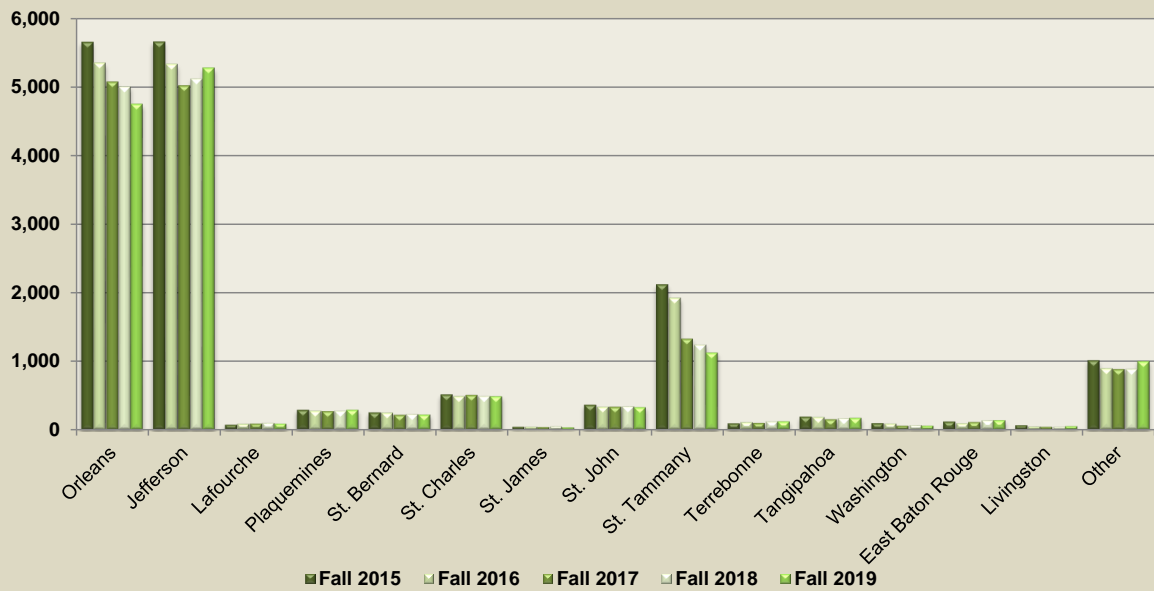
