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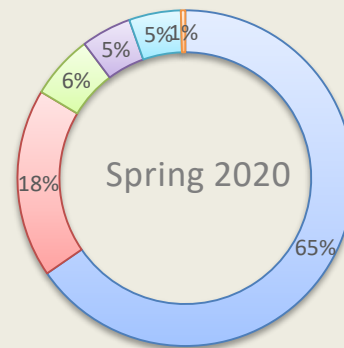
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## SUMMARY

- ✓ Though Delgado's total enrollment fell by 1.3% this spring, student credit-hours rose by 2.5%, reflecting a more intense average student schedule.
- ✓ The new Winter Session drew 272 students, 2% of total spring enrollment.
- ✓ The proportion of female students rose to 69%, the highest on record.
- ✓ Dual enrollment fell 61%, with transfer-in students and first-time freshmen picking up the slack.
- ✓ Average student age rose to a record-high 28.6 years old as dual enrollment dropped.
- ✓ Even before COVID-19 forced courses online, a record 46% of students were taking online classes. A record 20% of students took only online classes in spring.
- ✓ Nursing (16.9%), General Studies (8.9%) and Business & Management (5.9%) have the largest enrollment of any of Delgado's programs of study.

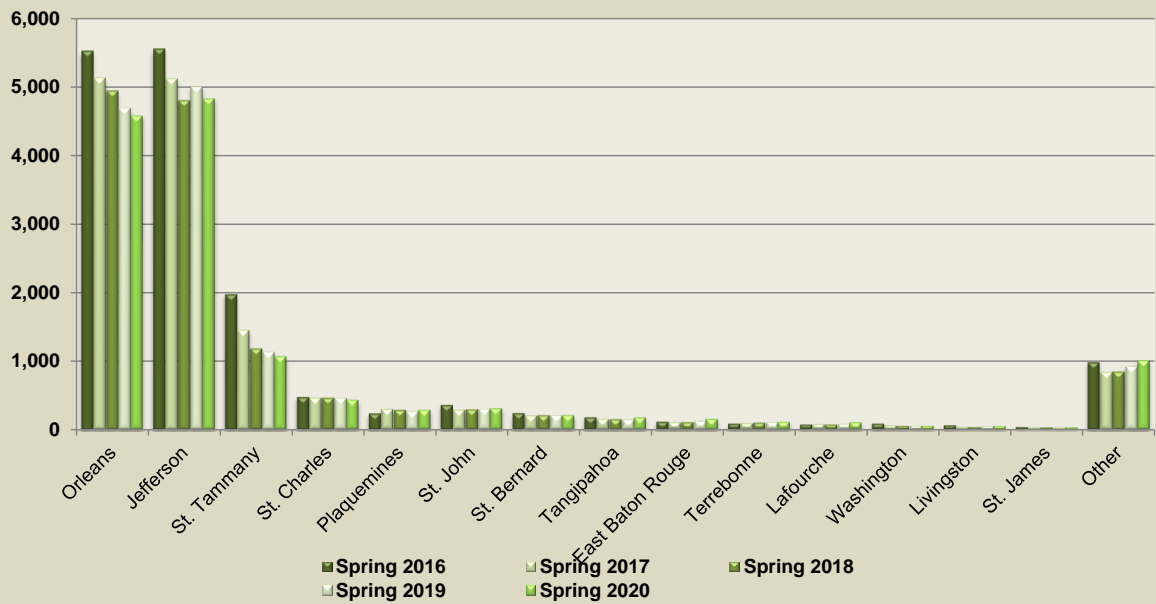
