Figure 1. Total Awards and Total Graduates for 2015-2016 to 2019-2020 Academic Years




Figure 2. Graduates in 2019-2020 Academic Year by Gender




Figure 3. Graduates in 2019-2020 Academic Year by Ethnicity




Figure 4. Graduates in 2019-2020 Academic Year by Degree Type


