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2018-19 Student Transfers to 4-yr Institutions as of April 2020

Summary

According to data received from the National Student Clearinghouse, 3,328 Delgado students enrolled in Academic Year 2018-19, or 16.5%, transferred to a 4-year institution by Spring 2020.

Most transfer students transferred to UNO (22%), followed by LSU (16%), and then Southeastern (10%).

Of transferrers' programs at Delgado, Teaching (Grades 1-5) had a transfer rate of 28%, Louisiana Transfer programs had a transfer rate of 24%, and General Studies had a transfer rate of 19%.

It should be noted that not all programs are designed for transfer. Nor can we be sure that the students continued their same major at the transfer institution.

Report Limitations

This data is furnished to us by the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). NSC cannot provide attendance and completion data for colleges that do not report these data to the Clearinghouse; nor do they report data for students or schools who block their response.
