SUMMARY

AY 2019-20 Students Transferred to Four-Year Institutions as of Year-End, AY 2020-21

Report Methodology: following the annual reporting method of the LCTCS "Louisiana 2020" initiative, a student is counted as transferring to a four-year university if they are enrolled at Delgado in one academic year (Summer-Fall-Spring), and enrolled at a four-year university during the next academic year. All transfer enrollment data is retrieved via National Student Clearinghouse search. DCC enrollment data is drawn from the Statewide Student Profile System (SSPS) official census reported to Board of Regents.

Notable Data and Trends:

- 14.5% (2,969 of 20,437) of Delgado students enrolled in AY 2019-20 had transferred to a four-year institution by the end of AY 2020-21.
- 79.9% (2,371 of 2,969) of transfers were to a four-year institution <u>in Louisiana</u>; of these, nearly 85% (352 of 2,371) were to a <u>public</u> four-year university.
- The most popular transfer destinations were University of New Orleans (641 students), Louisiana State University (622 students), Southeastern Louisiana University (217 students), and University of Louisiana, Lafayette (209 students).
- Total AY 2019-20 students transferred to four-year universities dropped below the previous year's number (3,320 for AY 2018-19 students, an historic high). However, AY 2019-20's students transferred number is consistent with the totals of previous years, as shown below.
