SUMMARY

AY 2020-21 Students Transferred to Four-Year Institutions as of Year-End, AY 2021-22

<u>Report Methodology</u>: following LCTCS conventions, a student is counted as transferring to a four-year university if they are enrolled at Delgado in one academic year (Summer-Fall-Spring), and enrolled at a four-year university during the next academic year (July 1-June 30). All transfer enrollment data is retrieved via National Student Clearinghouse search. Delgado enrollment data is drawn from the Statewide Student Profile System (SSPS) official census reported to Board of Regents.

Notable Data and Trends:

• 14.7% (2,790 of 18,938) of Delgado students enrolled in AY 2020-21 had transferred to a four-year institution by the end of AY 2021-22.

• 10.9% (2,061 of 2,790) of transfers were to a four-year institution in Louisiana; of these, 83% (1,711 of 2,061) were to a public four-year university.

• The most popular transfer destinations were Louisiana State University (577 students), University of New Orleans (547 students), University of Louisiana, Lafayette (211 students), and Southeastern Louisiana University (182 students).

• Total AY 2020-21 students transferred to four-year universities dropped below the previous year's number. However, AY 2020-21's students transferred number is approximately consistent with the totals of previous years, as shown below. Lower total enrollment at Delgado is a significant factor.
