SUMMARY

Academic Year 2020-21 Placement of Graduates in Employment

<u>Report Methodology</u>: the following pages display graduate employment placement outcomes i) by program and ii) by industry sector. Among students completing job-ready programs, who graduated and left, a student is counted as placed in employment if they had payroll earnings in the State of Louisiana within two quarters of graduating, as reported by the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC).

Notable Outcomes:

- 76.2% of AY 2020-21 graduates (from job-ready programs) obtained employment.
- Programs with the highest numbers of employed graduates were: Nursing (241), Accounting (39), Criminal Justice (39), Business & Management (35), and Electrician (35).
- Top industry sectors in which graduates obtained employment include: Hospitals (342), Food Service (86), Ambulatory Health Care Services (67), Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (42), and Public Safety (33).

<u>Report Limitations</u>: Employment status cannot be confirmed for graduates who are selfemployed, or who are employed in other states, or in military service. The outcomes reported here make no indication regarding the specific job the graduate obtained.
