## SUMMARY

### AY 2021-22 Students Transferred to Four-Year Institutions as of Year-End, AY 2022-23

Report Methodology: following LCTCS conventions, a student is counted as transferring to a four-year university if they are enrolled at Delgado in one academic year (Summer-Fall-Spring), and enrolled at a four-year university during the next academic year (July 1-June 30). All transfer enrollment data is retrieved via National Student Clearinghouse search. Delgado enrollment data is drawn from the Statewide Student Profile System (SSPS) official census reported to Board of Regents.

**Notable Data and Trends:**

- 13.5% (2,336 of 17,257) of Delgado students enrolled in AY 2021-22 had transferred to a four-year institution by the end of AY 2022-23. While the number (2,336) is lower than previous years, as a percentage of total students (13.5%), the outcome is consistent with recent trends.
- 75.0% (1,751 of 2,336) of transfers were to a four-year institution in Louisiana; of these, 78.7% (1,378 of 1,751) were to a public four-year university in Louisiana.
- The most popular transfer destinations were the LSU system (496); University of New Orleans (408); Southeastern Louisiana University (160); University of Louisiana - Lafayette (152); and Chamberlain University (101).
