SUMMARY

Academic Year 2021-22 Placement of Graduates in Employment

<u>Report Methodology</u>: the following pages display employment placement outcomes for graduates of terminal-award, job-ready programs, who did not remain enrolled at Delgado after graduating. Results are shown by program (p.2-3) and by industry sector (p.4). A student is counted as placed in employment if they had payroll earnings in the State of Louisiana within two quarters of graduating, as reported by the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC).

Notable Outcomes:

• 79.8% of AY 2021-22 graduates obtained employment.

• Programs with the highest numbers of employed graduates were: Registered Nursing (240), Business & Management (47), Practical Nursing (43), Accounting (37), and Radiologic Technology (32).

• Top industry sectors in which graduates obtained employment include: Hospitals (319), Ambulatory Health Care Services (50), Food Service (37), Administrative and Support Services (36), and Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (30).

<u>Report Limitations</u>: Employment status cannot be confirmed for graduates who are selfemployed, or who are employed in other states, or in military service. The outcomes reported here make no indication regarding the specific job the graduate obtained.
