SUMMARY

AY 2022-23 Students Transferred to Four-Year Institutions as of Year-End, AY 2023-24

Report Methodology: following LCTCS conventions, a student is counted as transferring to a four-year university if they are enrolled at Delgado in one academic year (July 1 - June 30), and enrolled at a four-year university during the next academic year. All transfer enrollment data is retrieved via National Student Clearinghouse search. Delgado enrollment data is drawn from the Statewide Student Profile System (SSPS) official census reported to Board of Regents.

Notable Data and Trends:

Total students transferred from Delgado to four-year universities in AY 2023-24 was 2,352, a slight increase over the previous year's number (2,336).

The top five transfer destinations for Delgado students were 1. LSU, 2. University of New Orleans, 3. Southeastern Louisiana University, 4. University of Louisiana, Lafayette, and 5. Chamberlain University.

276 of Delgado's transfer students exited after earning a terminal award at Delgado, such as an associate degree or technical diploma.

73% of students transferring to a four-year university went to an in-state institution.
