# Academic Year 2022-23 Placement of Graduates in Employment

#### **SUMMARY**

## Academic Year 2022-23 Placement of Graduates in Employment

Report Methodology: the following pages display employment placement outcomes for graduates of terminal-award, job-ready programs, who did not remain enrolled at Delgado after graduating. Results are shown by program (p.2-3) and by industry sector (p.4-5). A student is counted as placed in employment if they had payroll earnings in the State of Louisiana within two quarters of graduating, as reported by the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC).

#### Notable Outcomes:

- 80.2% of AY 2022-23 graduates obtained employment.
- The top 5 programs with the highest numbers of employed graduates were: Registered Nursing (257), Business & Management (45), Electrician (45), Radiologic Technology (44), and Criminal Justice (28).
- The top 5 industry sectors in which graduates obtained employment were: Hospitals (163), Management (152), Food Service (56), Ambulatory Health Care Services (48), and Administrative and Support Services (40).

<u>Report Limitations</u>: Employment status cannot be confirmed for graduates who are selfemployed, or who are employed in other states, or in military service. The outcomes reported here make no indication regarding the specific job the graduate obtained.
