Methodology

Graduates were surveyed six months after their graduation. Two survey mailings were distributed to graduates. Departments then followed up by phone.

Summary of Results

- ✓ 44.3% of students who graduated in Fall of 2002 graduates filled out the survey.
- ✓ 82.4% were generally satisfied with their chosen occupation.
- ✓ 29.1% continued their education and 71.4% of those students continued in their Delgado major.
- ✓ 61% of students who transferred were unable to transfer some credits. The most common reason was there being no comparable course.
- ✓ 84.1% felt well prepared from their Delgado studies to continue their education.
- ✓ 85.7% of students felt Delgado prepared them well to efficiently and effectively perform their job duties.
- ✓ 86.4% of student felt Delgado prepared them for their career goal
- ✓ 90.2% of student felt the program at Delgado could be completed in a reasonable amount of time.
- ✓ 87.2% of students were satisfied with the quality of instruction they received.
- ✓ Students who majored in Diagnostic Medical Sonography reported the highest wages of all graduates who are working in their field.

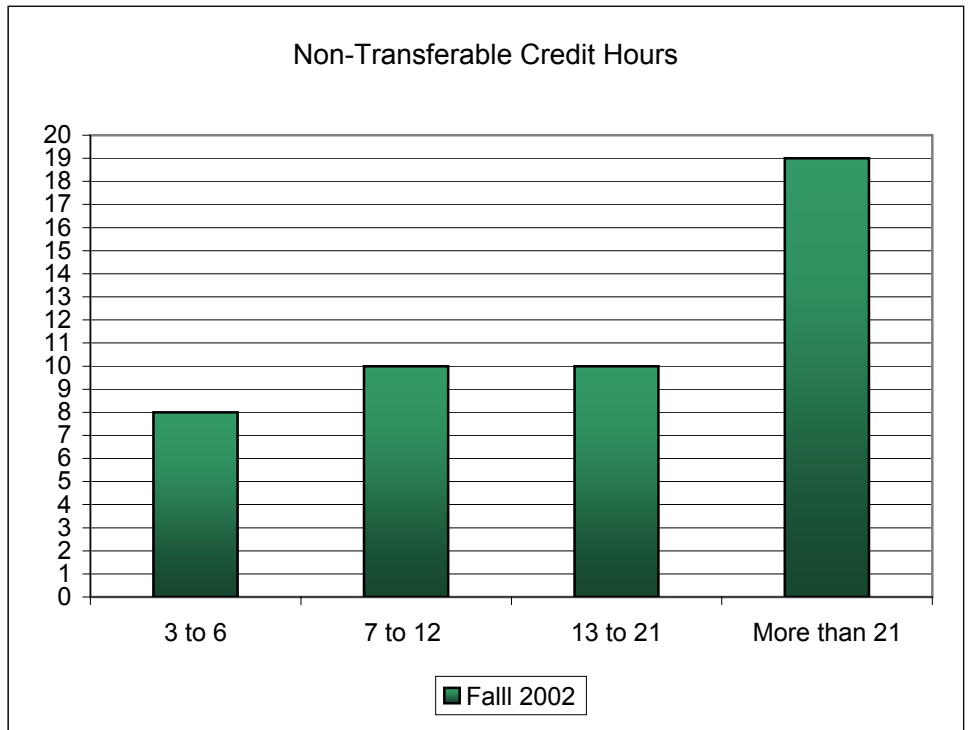

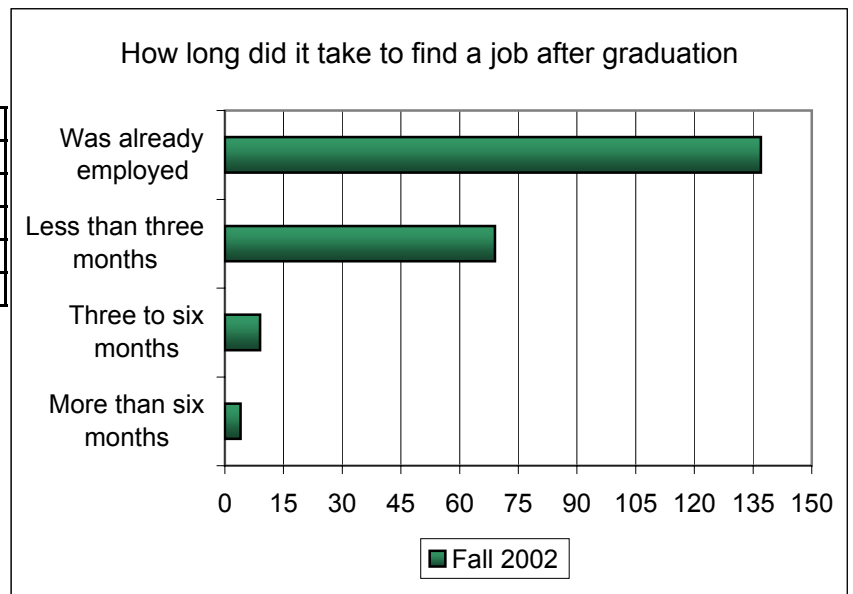

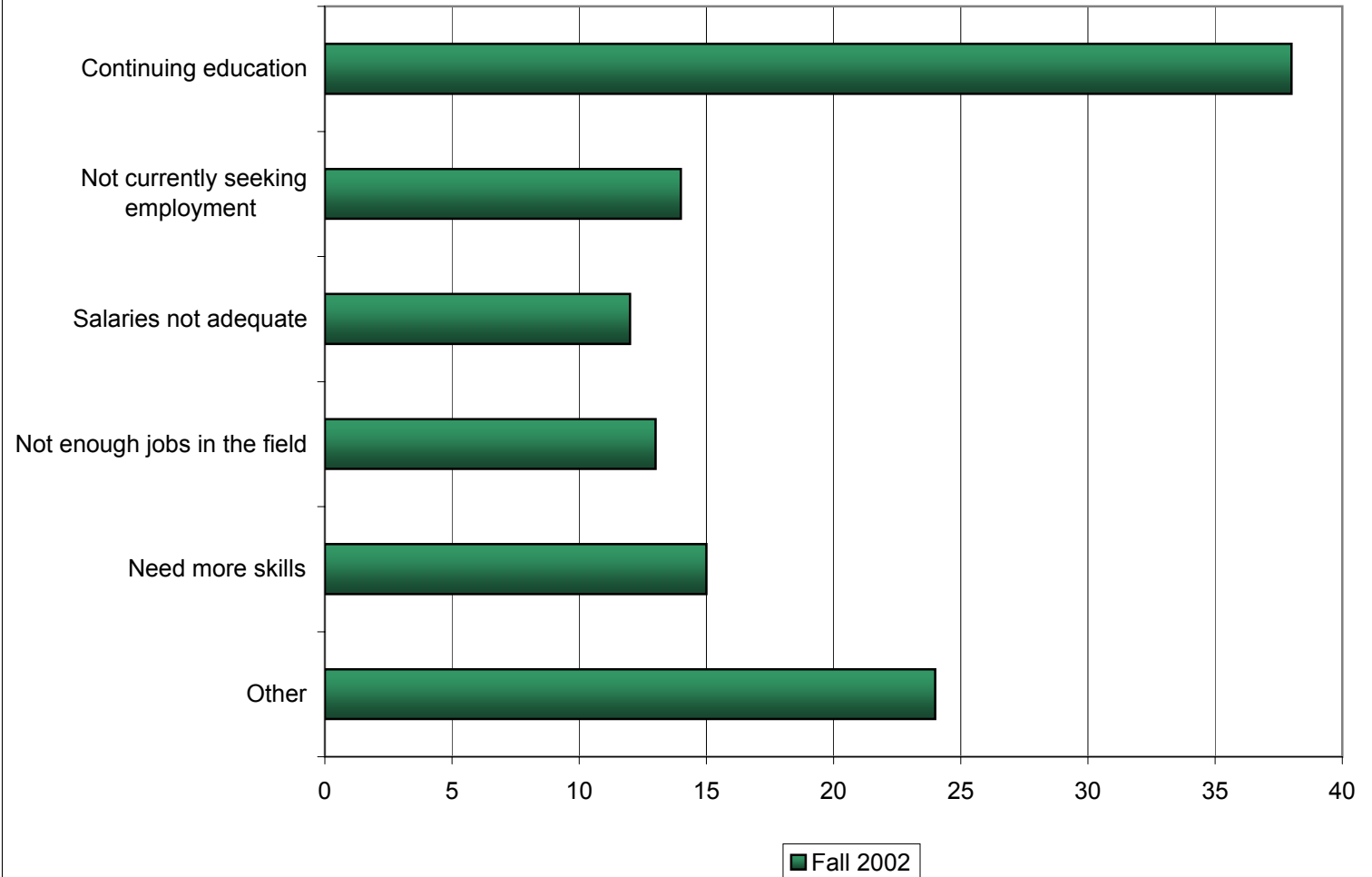

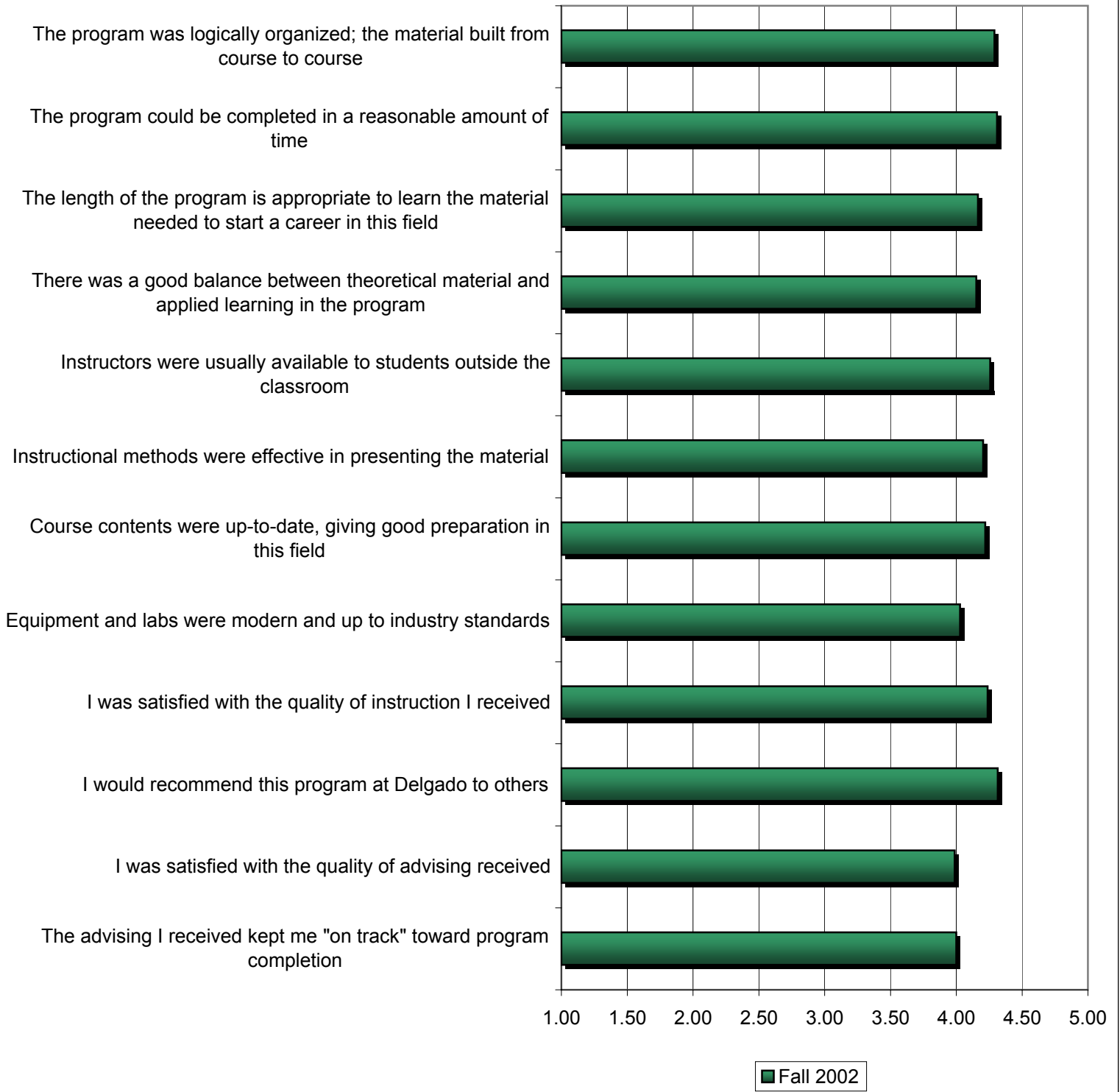

My educational experience at Delgado was spectacular. I meet a lot of friendly people; also the staff members were very supportive in their field. I will always cherish the moments at Delgado. If I had one wish for Delgado, I wish Delgado were a four-year degree university. If it were so, I would continue my education at Delgado with "Great Pride".

I thoroughly enjoyed my time at Delgado. Instructors were great. I am disabled but planning a career as a writer.

I want to start off by thanking all of Delgado's staff members that had anything to do with my education while at Delgado, including those in the tutorial labs. I enjoyed my classes, which have really prepared me in my job area. In the beginning getting into Delgado was kind of rocky. Due to the fact that I have a foreign accent, I was assigned to ESL which was incorrect. I'm glad it eventually got straightened out. The Practicum classes are very intense but great. I just wish I had a little more time to complete it. On the whole, I miss Delgado and have sent or recommended about 8 or 9 people to Delgado. Presently 5 of them are attending Delgado and enjoying it or finding it a challenge. I was to attend SUNO but I have to keep putting it off because of unforeseen circumstances. Anyway thanks again for 3 to 4 great years! Hope I can continue relying on you all for help in the future.

Additional comments can be obtained if someone wishes to phone me. I'd rather NOT document my opinion in writing, as it could be detrimental to a particular professor. Personally, I like the individual, but I strongly feel that HE/SHE did little to prepare the students for a career in this field. (Details can be disclosed). The only thing that I didn't like was some of the times to take a class were midday instead of morning or evening. That conflicted in a lot of scheduling for me & others that I know attend Delgado.

Also, there were times in my classes where some of the students behaved very inappropriately, and nothing was done about it. These students acted out in class, talked on cell phones, etc. This is not high school; we are supposed to be adults now. These disruptive students should not be allowed to attend class-They obviously aren't interested in learning.

My major was Criminal Justice. I have been unable to find a job with my associate Degree in this field. Also starting pay for the job I was interested in pays \$8000 dollars less a year than what I currently make.

My time at Delgado was very unique. It was very interesting when it came to some of the students that went there. I would recommend Delgado to anyone who asks me how I felt about going here.

General

There are a few people that allowed my stay at Delgado to be relaxing and their help ensured me that I was going to prosper in my continuing studies. Please keep these people on staff. They are: Dr. Eric Gamble (the best advisor-teacher), Mr. Alvin Mitchell, Dr. Donald Harwood (I know he's not a doctor but he's an excellent math teacher), Mrs. Sandra Madison, Susan Blackwell, Anne Lewis (excellent English teacher) and last but not least, Ms. Rosalind Williams (Registrar's staff). The day I was down Rosalind encouraged myself and many others that had a bad day if it was because of class schedule or just a bad day. I'd like to also thank Ms. Janet G. (I don't want to mess up her name. She handles the exit interview in the Registrar's office for graduation. Thank you all!

I feel I got a good education at Delgado. But I think students need more help finding a job. Because I have been looking since I graduating in December. And I still am not in my field of accounting.

Ms. Charlotte Jeffers was as great inspiration for me. She talked with me whenever I went to her office. She took time to encourage me not to stop, but keep positive and keep my chin up. I am deeply grateful for her. The program was exciting, long & hard (challenging), but I made it. Thank you all.

The lady in the **** office needs an attitude adjustment. I wish I could remember her name, but she has a nasty attitude and is very rude when speaking to someone. She sits at the desk where you go for directions or questions in the *** department.

I was satisfied with my education from Delgado, with the exception of a single teacher. The rest of your staff made up for her behavior. Mr. Foy, Physics on Westbank campus was awesome! He is so great at what he does. He was wonderful!

The only problem I had with Delgado Charity School of Nursing was the fact that we started approx 10 days earlier than the main campus but we had to wait for financial aid. It was difficult to get the expensive Nursing books needed for the first day of class with no money. Quite a few of my peers complained and got behind because of this. The instructors expected a few chapters to be read before the 1st day of school -actually.

Although instructional material was up to date, labs and hands-on for the computer repair and networking courses were inadequate. The labs look more like storage for broken equipment than places to learn. Problems with a/c power to the labs went unresolved for the two years I was there. No apparent communication between instructors of different courses using the same equipment which often left students setback in their progress in configuring systems. I learned a lot because I was at the front doing things. A lot of students only know what they learned from the book and this reflects poorly on Delgado Information Systems program.

My experience as a student at Delgado was a most rewarding one. Most of the teachers that I have worked with have been wonderful. The only complaints that I have are about the inadequate parking space and also the lines during registration time.

The biggest problem I had with Charity was parking. It was terrible.

Transfers

The education I receive from Delgado was very good, and prepared me for my future career objectives. Most of my instructors were accommodating and very knowledgeable in my field of study. Their advice and guidance helped me through the program, and towards my degree. One instructor that I owe a lot of credit to is Diane Cohen. The lessons and knowledge, along with her enthusiasm for teaching, will help me become the teacher I want to be. However, my problems and concerns came when I attempted to continue my education, and transfer my credits towards a BA degree in Early Childhood Education. Private universities in our area would accept almost all of my 83 credits, but their costs were beyond my means. Enrolling in our local public university, University of New Orleans is where my problems began. In my chosen field of ECED, UNO will only accept 24 of my 83 credits. This is total contrast to what I was informed of when I enrolled at Delgado. This is also in conflict with the information I received by reviewing the transfer of Credit Course Guide from UNO for Delgado Community College.

All information I have seen over the past 6 years focused on the need for qualified teachers in our area, and the programs available to assist candidates towards this profession. I also heard our governor speak of the needs and advantages of our junior colleges to help prepare and transition our students into their careers. I loved my opportunity to students teach, and am convinced that my career plans were sound, and my chosen field is where I should be employed. But to go to school at Delgado for 6 years, while working full time, and graduating with honors in Early Childhood Education only to have UNO tell me that only 29% of my education at Delgado is acceptable towards a degree that will qualify me to teach in Louisiana is tragic. I feel that I have been betrayed by Delgado, along with the overall educational system, in my effort to become a teacher.

The University of New Orleans will, however, accept 79 of the 83 credits I have from Delgado, but only 24 of these 83 could be used towards a degree in Early Childhood Education. Fifty-seven of my credit hours would be accepted towards a General Studies degree. UNO will accept transfer of 77 of my 83 credits, but because many of my courses were education based subjects most do not fit into any other degree program. Also, UNO informed me that a minimum of 50% of the required courses in a degree program must come from UNO. Another reason to avoid a community college. This was not my goal, nor will it lead me to what I hoped would

When I tried to have previous credits transferred from other community colleges, it was a nightmare. Out of 63 credits, only 3 transferred automatically, and that was after a two day wait. The other CC's I attended (Michigan & California) had all my credits transferred in two hours, allowing me to register on time and accurately. When my credits didn't transfer right away, I was told that I had to personally go to every department head to have the credits approved personally. I ran all over campus doing this, myself. When completed, all my necessary credits were finally accepted. Then, the admissions department told me I was not supposed to get credits approved on my own. Yet without having those credits, I could not register because the classes I needed required pre-requisites- which would satisfy with a full transfer of my previous credits.

My time at Delgado not only prepared me for my occupational career, but it also helped me in my academic career by helping me to better understand the ways that I learn best. I know now that I am a better learner when I am able to receive the individual attention that I've gained from attending a smaller college such as Delgado. Therefore, I know that my continuing educational choice should be a small college, which is why I choose Holy Cross. Furthermore, Delgado has helped me considerably in my personal life. My success in my education at Delgado has boosted my self-esteem, which has able me to have the confidence that I was so lacking in my life. Now, "the world is my oyster." Thank you Delgado!

Transfers

I enjoyed my time at Delgado and feel that I was well prepared to transfer to a four year college. It had been twenty years since I was in school, but I found that the instructors helped me to get back in the swing of things.

I've compared my educational experience at Delgado Community College with SUNO's and found that Delgado is exceptionally outstanding when it comes to education. The instructors were really helpful. They took out the time and effort in helping me to succeed. Delgado has an outstanding technology system. I really enjoyed taking on-line courses. I also enjoyed the special features of registration, such as: by phone or on-line. Delgado is the place to be for an outstanding educational experience. As a matter of fact, Delgado should consider being a four-year university.

I transferred from Delgado to Tulane and after only 1 semester, my feeling is that Delgado is like kindergarten compared to Tulane. I strongly feel that Delgado does not offer the necessary courses in the CMIN field to adequately prepare the students for the next level or even the same level of courses. It's like I felt like a genius at Delgado, but then I sure was "put in my place" at Tulane! Thanks! And I mean that sarcastically.

Instruction

Some classes at Delgado were great and were a wonderful experience for me. In the summer of 2001 I had taken Fundamentals of Accounting at the westbank location. My final grade was a "C". This class was by far the hardest. This class was the worst experience at Delgado. If you see all of my other grades, I had all A's and B's. This instructor was not very good, he told me that if I did not ask questions in the class that day, not to ask a repeated question next class day. When I did ask a question he made me feel very little in front of my classmates. I would never take another class with him again, I have complained before, but he is still teaching others as far as I know. Other than that all my other class experiences the rest of my teachers were caring and understanding.

One instructor was an above average instructor, but below average with human relations. He consistently raised the bar on academics and lowered it on personal growth. While very satisfied with Delgado in general, I was highly dissatisfied with my particular program. I would not recommend it due to the hopeless nature of the job field in this area; but highly recommend Delgado as an institution. Thank you!

Consider Math instructors carefully because some instructors don't help as much as they should and Math is a weakness to many people. I had a horrible teacher who would not stop if you had a question or offer out of class assistance.

Since graduating I have been experiencing health problems and so my employment and continuing education has been placed on hold. However, while I was in school, the theatre skills I picked up helped me in my theatre career. Worlds of opportunity have been made available to me since I started at Delgado and I thank you for it.

I enjoyed my studies at Delgado. I loved the one on one help I got from my instructors.

Professors in the program were not satisfied with it, or with their benefits in the school. It's very difficult to teach and transmit knowledge with that attitude, which fault relies on the direction of the school.

Allied Health

I would like to study "Allied Health Information Tech" at Delgado, but the school makes to very difficult for working adults.

I enjoyed the Physical Therapist Assistant program that Delgado has. The instructors and especially the program director are very organized. The only concern is that the time is too short for a lot of information. I am actually enjoying my job and I am glad that I chose this program.

The instructors were very unprofessional! One "taught" by verbal abuse towards students, constant accusations were made to any student who did well that she "had to" have cheated! I was accused of cheating after I spent hours preparing for each exam! I feel that someone needs to closely look at how students are treated! Yes, she taught me the material, but at the expense of my humiliation & loss of self worth! NOT WORTH IT! I have since told my friends not to go to Delgado's Surg Tech program. It is just not professionally run!

The only major complaint I have with the Respiratory program was the fact that in the second year of the program, where lab class was most important, (ventilator, O2 hook up, etc.) we either had equipment but no working air or O2 or the equipment didn't even work. We spent the whole ventilator semester having to go to Charity Hospital to have lab class; in addition we had to endure more parking fees that would not be reimbursed when we already paid a lab fee. A letter was written and signed by all respiratory students requesting a refund of our lab fees for that semester, but was turned down.

I feel the Nuclear Medicine Program at Delgado is ok, but needs a lot of help. We never had one particular classroom. There were never any learning materials for us (labs with Nuclear Medicine Techs are in very high demand right now in Louisiana and elsewhere in the USA. I just feel that more time, money, and attention could be brought to this program to make it a better one. I actually have recommended several people that I work with to Delgado's program. Their calls and emails were never returned when they finally did get in touch with the secretary. They were told that they were not eligible for the program unless they were x-ray techs. This is very wrong information that she is giving them. I had a girl in my class that wasn't an x-ray tech. You are missing out on a lot of money and very good people. The information and class work was horrible. What was taught was almost always different from the test. There were several times when we were tested on information that was never taught (and graded on). I feel that this could be a great program and a wonderful asset to Louisiana, but it needs a lot of help. I am very glad that I had the opportunity to

My experience at Delgado Community College was a very excellent one. All of my instructors at Delgado were very positive & encouraging people who were willing to go beyond the classroom if help were needed after hours. All of my instructors in the Radiology field were always willing to help. I felt we became a family for those 2 yrs. The Ultrasound program was a very different experience for me, not as positive as the Radiology, but I was able to successfully complete the Ultrasound program. I'm currently working in both fields. Thanks to Delgado, the instructors and all the instructors in the field of Allied Health.

The Surgical Tech program needs some shaping up. It was much unorganized and I also found the instructors were not always there to help. I also started to dislike the field halfway through the program & realized it was not what I wanted to do but I had already come too far to quit. You guys need a Vet Tech program!!

attend Delgado for the Nuclear Medicine Program. I do have a wonderful job and I have doubled my income. I just want to thank you for giving me that opportunity to attend the program and I hope that my suggestions will help to better this program and am useful to future students. Thank you for your time.

Allied Health

I am currently a student through Delgado in the Diagnostic Sonography Program and will be finishing in December. I feel that the Program needs a little more organization concerning schedules and classes. I have found myself extremely frustrated due to the fact that I don't remember where it is I am supposed to be nor do I know which class subject will be talked about to bring the appropriate notes. However, I feel the program has been a great learning experience and the instructors are understanding and nice. Thank you.

I applied for a job before graduating and was told position was mine when graduation was over. Equipment was as up to date as your clinical site provided. The x-ray table & machine at Delgado for labs could be updated & properly functioning. The range of motion of this equipment was not able to perform all positions that are taught in class to truly give the full impact of angles used and equipment position and maneuverability. It would be greatly to Delgado's advantage and the students taking this radiology tech course to be able to go into class & maneuver and practice on decent equipment to get the course's full impact.

Respiratory Lab needs new updated equipment for better understanding of proper functioning equipment. More access to computers for learning objectives. Many LSU students have a choice of learning to do echocardiograms. I wish I could have had that choice. Many respiratory therapists also have this background.

I was very satisfied with the Radiology program. The teachers in the program were excellent. I am possibly going to Holy Cross to receive my Bachelor's in Radiology.

Business

The Computer Repair program was much unorganized and spread out way too far. I hope this will help you to improve the program.

I had a lot of fun in the Culinary program at Delgado. The instructors were all very nice, helpful, and energetic. The instructors tried as hard as the students themselves to make the student a success. I'm really happy with my choice of Delgado's Culinary Arts Department over other Culinary Schools throughout the state and country.

My experience at Delgado CC was good for the most part, but I strongly feel that Delgado CC should address "Terrible Customer Service Issues" in the Financial Aid Dept., Registrar's Office, Bookstore, Flex Lab, etc. I spent 3 years getting the "run-around" from the City Park Campus and the different offices within the City Park Campus. There are many problems within these offices that I mentioned above and they should be addressed. Also, over all I am satisfied with my degree program in CMIN, but I feel that the material should be updated to current programs being used such as, C, CTT, Java, Oracle, etc. Not- COBOL which is no longer used today. Some of the computer course instructors know the material but do not know how to teach it and should be removed from teaching. The computer courses need to be available at all campuses, not just City Park. I took 1 year off after graduating from Delgado CC and will be continuing my education at either UNO or Tulane with a major in Computer Science. I will start at UNO or Tulane January 2004.

Student Services

The Radiology program is wonderful. The teachers were very helpful and caring. The help around campus was horrible. Every time I would telephone Delgado no one ever knew anything. With you having students working in different departments makes things very difficult. Especially when you don't train them well enough. Every time you ask a question no one ever had the answer which makes it a bad experience.

Overall my experience at Delgado was a pleasant and wonderful one. That only goes toward the curriculum and teachers. Although my experience was a wonderful one I can only suggest one thing. Please provide your students and future students with helpful people. I did not like the attention I received from your workers. One department in question, your admissions dept. I found them very rude and unhelpful. In one instance I called and was told to hold on, while I heard a conversation of the girl on the phone talking to another about how she disliked a movie. I would rather my question answered rather than hearing about how someone disliked a movie. And that's only one example your staff workers I find, some, are rude and do not seem to care. That was very disappointing. Other than that I loved going to Delgado and it I am very proud to have graduated a Delgado student.

The only thing that I was very unhappy with was graduation. My graduation date was December 19, 2002. I was unhappy with the way the crowd was able to control the whole night and no one was able to get order. It made me feel like going to this school was a joke. I was ashamed to have been associated with this school.

I believe Financial Aid Office needs improving. Sometimes information was not totally accurate.

The person who handles the screening of applications to this program (prior to program director) knows very little about the requirements and who meets them. I and one other student that I am aware of almost didn't even get our applications reviewed by the director because she did not know where to check for transfer credits and names of classes that were equivalent to the prerequisites. I almost didn't even get a chance because of her incompetence. I am not sure of her title, but she definitely did no advising. She was sharp, rude, and inconsiderate.

Trying to obtain information from the Registrar's Office was a challenge. The amount of misinformation regarding transferred credits from other universities was frustrating. The cashiers were also a frustrating experience. It was as if you were bothering them when paying your tuition. Instructors and courses were very good.

The actual classroom experience I received at Delgado met my expectations, however dealing with most of the office staff (i.e. financial aid) was a very bad experience- on more than one occasion I was wrongly informed on situations. It seemed as if I had to go through three or four staff members to get to someone that knew what they were talking about – I am not the only person who feels this way about Delgado. Other than that Delgado was a great starting point for my higher education.

I originally started Delgado in the fall of 1993 and just graduated in the fall of 2002. For the most part, my experience at Delgado has been good. I liked the fact that I was not just a number to my teachers. I also liked the fact on how Delgado has improved the physical appearance of the Campus. However, I do have a complaint to make about some staff. There is one lady in particular in the Bursar's office. I have been a student off and on for ten years, and I must say she was the rudest individual that I have ever run into while I was attending school. Also, a few semesters ago, I had a teacher insult me once during class and then had the nerve to put a bonus question on our final exam about the comment he used to insult me with. I certainly did not appreciate being humiliated not once, but twice in front of the class. Other than these two individuals, my experience at Delgado has been fine. Also, the lady who I did my exit interview with was very nice and understanding of these concerns that I brought to her attention.

Student Services

This comment had nothing to do with the programs at Delgado. If I am not mistaken, my first 2 years I used financial aid. Is there anything you guys can do about this office? It is a disaster. There is always someone new at the counter, and they have no idea what they are doing. People are not helpful and their attitude is really bad. They misplace information, you name it. Thank you very much. I hope something can be done for students still needing these services.

I believe student orientation should make sure students know about all labs required for courses. Also, meeting with their advisor should be a requirement to enter school. It can be difficult to find good advice regarding transfer students. We hate to repeat or take the wrong classes because we're not advised correctly. Evening students have no Life Center yet but they pay for it. –No dinny???

Delgado Community College was a supportive environmental that allowed me to improve my study habits either with tutoring labs or seminars. Most of the time however, I studied alone. Regardless of the way I chose to study, I considered the availability of the different tutoring labs and tutor an asset for all Delgado students. I also got good use out of the opened student computer lab to conduct research for papers and typing assigned projects, instead of waiting to do them at home. It saved me time and frustration. I also used the computer lab for recreation to calm my nerves. While I was in the Occupational Therapy Assistant program, I had the opportunity of taking a practice certification exam on the last day of class. I was very nervous, and after taking the exam, I wished I had a second chance to take it again. I was not satisfied with my score.

This system between admissions and registration, along with credit transfer is completely inadequate. There is no reason why a student, new to Delgado and New Orleans, should have to go through what I went through to get credits transferred. And it should not matter that they were out-of-state credits, because other CC's in the country can process out-of-state credits within one day- with no hassle!

I was assigned to an “off-campus” work study position which also gave me experience and the opportunity to obtain knowledge in my future career as a social worker. Ms. Ware assigned me to a non-profit organization where I was always in contact with SW, this also assist me in gaining info and good examples for my future. Thanks a lot Ms. Ware (City Park) and Mr. Miller (Westbank)

It was OK to go to Delgado and get an associate degree. But getting advised was a major problem. Also getting help from the internship job department was impossible. They did not help me try and look for an internship at all. They told me I had to go out and ask for myself. 1. The reason I went there was to get help on getting an internship in the first place. I didn't know how I was I suppose to go about it. 2. The office was always filled with people who just wanted to “hang out”. Most likely why I could never get help! You have to get a better program on helping students look for interns in their field of study or most of them will feel like they went to school for nothing!

Nursing

I know that I should be grateful for the education I received at Delgado. Most of what I learned was in the AD-RN program when I first started there in Jan '98. I took this knowledge I learned in the RN program I used to help me and my fellow students in the LPN program. Much of the experience I obtained from clinical and not classroom work. The teachers were fair to average in their teaching skills. The program should return to a longer program (about 18 months) because they need more time in several specialties such as Internal Medicine (Med.-Surg), Maternity, Pediatrics, and Surgery. I would always recommend this program to others because of the overall experience and the Charity Hospital reputation. I would hope that in the future the administration and curriculum coordinators will take into consideration every graduate's advice. Thank you. Class of 2002!

I feel that the Nursing program should be 3 years instead of 2 yrs. It is too much material to try to cram into 2 years and actually retain most of it. Some people can retain a lot. For me, it would have been more effective training on a slower pace.

If possible I would like to receive information about continuing my education to become a registered nurse. I will be employed one year as an L.P.N. and would like information about "fast track". I believe that is what you call it when an LPN can ship over any pre-requisites after being employed for a year or two. I look forward to hearing from you soon. I thank you for a wonderful education through your school. It was the best decision (next to having my 5 yr. old daughter) that I ever made. I love being a Nurse and look forward to my future with the best job I could ever ask for. Thank you again, God Bless.

I was ill-prepared to be a registered nurse when I got out of school. I feel like the course of clinical training that I received from Charity School of Nursing was an exercise in humiliation, intimidation, and degradation. Instructors did not assist or guide me through any area of the hospital nor did they provide any type of hands-on experience to me as a student nurse. I learned from preceptor at the hospital where I was employed numerous nursing skills that I should have learned in nursing school. If you asked a question that you would not receive the answer and that you would be threatened with failing the clinical experience. I would not recommend anyone to Charity School of Nursing, not even my worst enemy!

I felt Charity Nursing School was an excellent education; however I would be very hesitant to recommend it to others because Financial Aid was so hard to receive my aid until the last month of school! I barely survived, bought books, remained in school due to the extreme tardiness of my aide EACH SEMESTER. In fact, my brother chose a different Nursing School after watching my experiences (whose aide advisors found him opportunities so that his education will be completely paid for). Class of '02.

I attended Delgado's Charity Nursing School. When I started my occupation as an R.N., I felt well prepared & knowledgeable about the skills I was taught in school to anyone wanting to pursue this job.

I think the Nursing course could be expanded through summer as to not cram so much information into 4 semesters. However my experience at Charity School of Nursing, although rough, was very worth it.

I feel proud to say I attended Charity of Nursing as agressed to others (nursing school) in the area. I felt more prepared clinically & just as prepared theoretically with the associate degree from Charity in comparison for those who graduated with a bachelor's from other schools. The area needing most improvement is financial aid. Three out of the four semesters I received financial aid, I did not receive my loan check until the week of finals. That is unacceptable, and should be unacceptable to your institution also. Overall, I had a great experience. Thank you for this opportunity to comment.

Nursing

Delgado-Charity School of Nursing-AND program did more than adequately prepare me for the workforce. I work in the ER. The environment is fast paced. You have to think on your feet. I was amazed at the things I could recall from Nursing School –from A & P and able to improve patient outcomes. My preceptor, who has been a nurse for 30 years, was impressed. She stated that “she never had a new nurse ask so many detailed questions that she would have to think about before giving a reply”. Made me feel good!!!! But, I owe all of this to the instructors I had while attending Charity Delgado School of Nursing. So if you are, get to see this. “Thank You”

Anyone can do the Pre-Nursing program; but indeed you have to really want to in order to make it to the end & pass. The program was a great learning experience. The only one problem I had was when learning pediatrics; they should have taught more diseases in childhood like how to measure children and also about injections. I work with pediatrics and I already knew about injections because of previous schooling in Medical Assistant but common childhood diseases were never taught & you need to know them. We only learned about development, not even really on the correct vital signs & general things. The program was great & so were my instructions. Thanks!

Technology

The training/education I received from Delgado seems to be minimal. I completed all the safety courses with an acceptable to high grade. I had never worked in the field of safety therefore; I thought my learning was average for the field. However, since I have graduated and has applied for jobs in safety, I realized I hadn't learned much, or not enough to get an entry level job in safety. I have worked in my current field for approximately 15 years and was looking forward to a change. I am now required to pay back student loans on education I did not properly receive. The Safety program at Delgado may enhance the lives of people who are currently working in the field, but it is not designed for people who plan to enter into the field. I was very dissatisfied.

I had a problem answering the lab questions! Because the Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Labs were bad! I don't know why I was charged lab fees. However, the labs in ELET impressed me and I felt I learned a lot more. I know Delgado has eliminated the AC/Ref. program since I have finished, but I believe this was a mistake. It would have been a great program if the proper money was invested in it like having Lab equipment. Thanks
