**New Course:** PAST-217: Pastry Arts Capstone. Creation of a new course PAST-217: Pastry Arts Capstone (3-4-5/105). This course incorporates all the processes of the bake shop into a capstone course. Students will take a certification examination as well as a final practical examination that is evaluated by industry chefs. Includes managerial concepts of the bake shop to include cost control. Plating, sanitation, and display techniques will be emphasized.

**New Course:** PAST-251: Baking and Pastry Work Experience III. Creation of a new course PAST-251: Baking and Pastry Work Experience III (0-20-3/300). Work (20 hours per week) in a cooperating bakery/pastry institution. Maintenance of a log book describing work experiences containing recipe files and photographs of display work is required.
