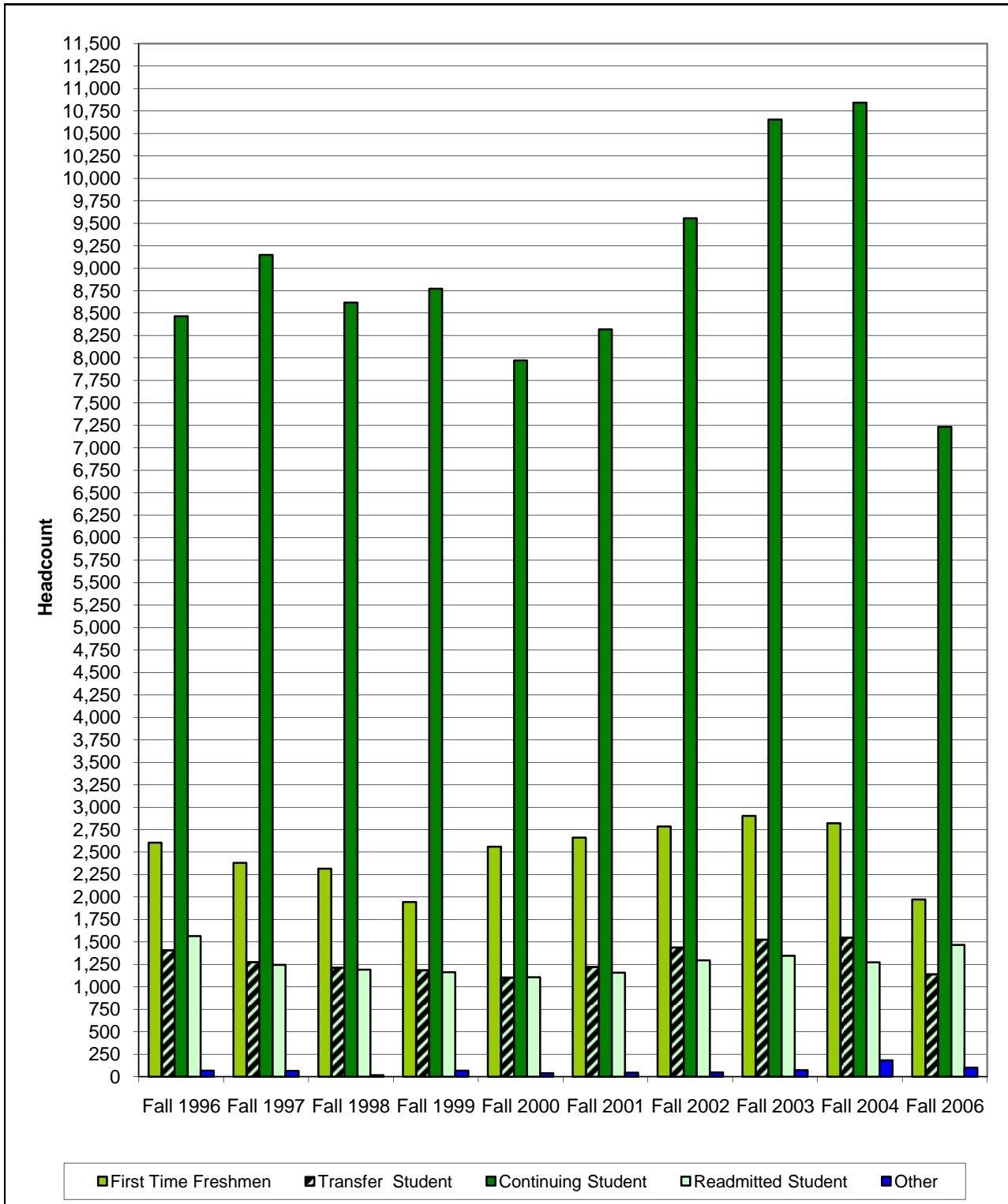

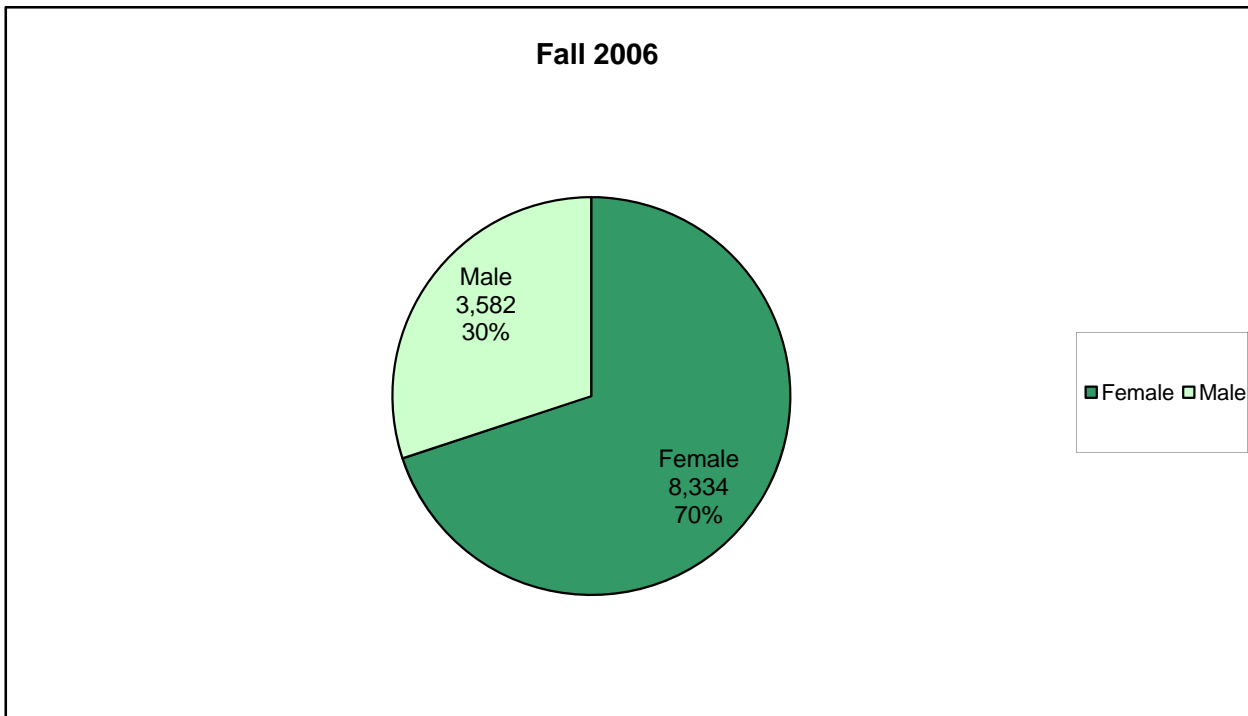

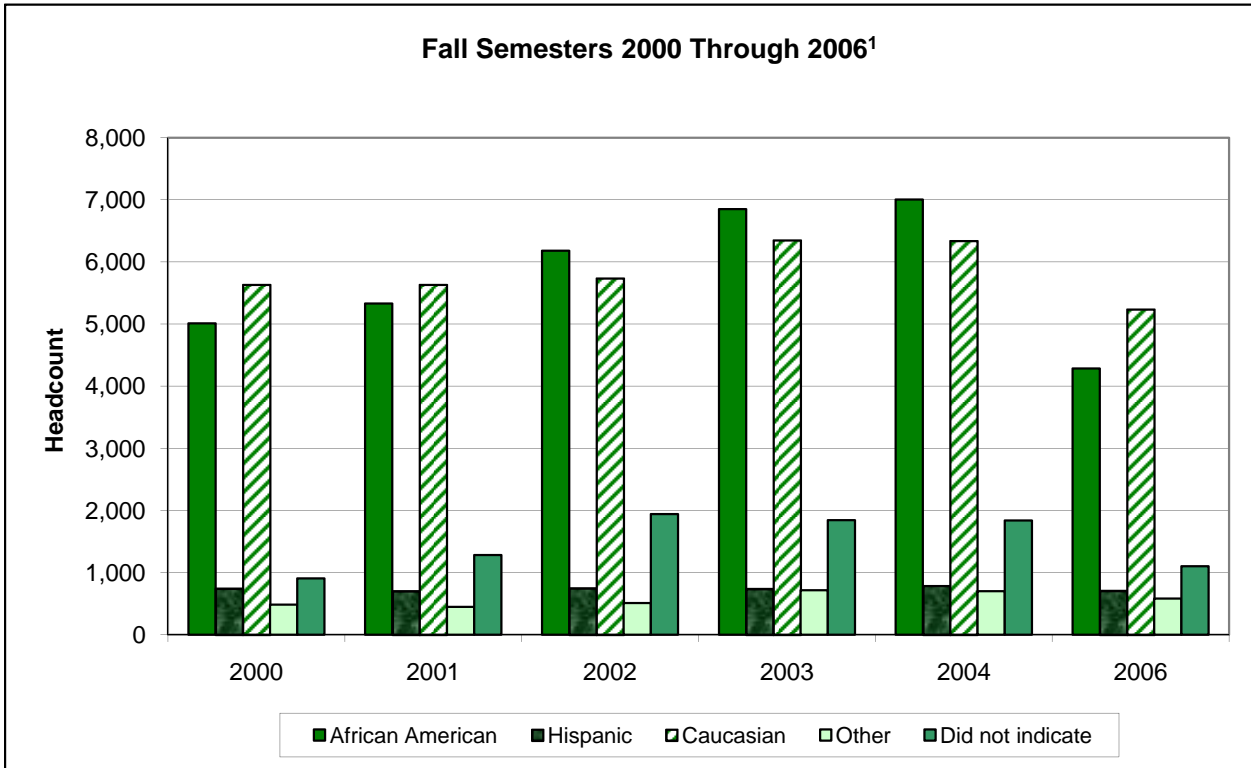

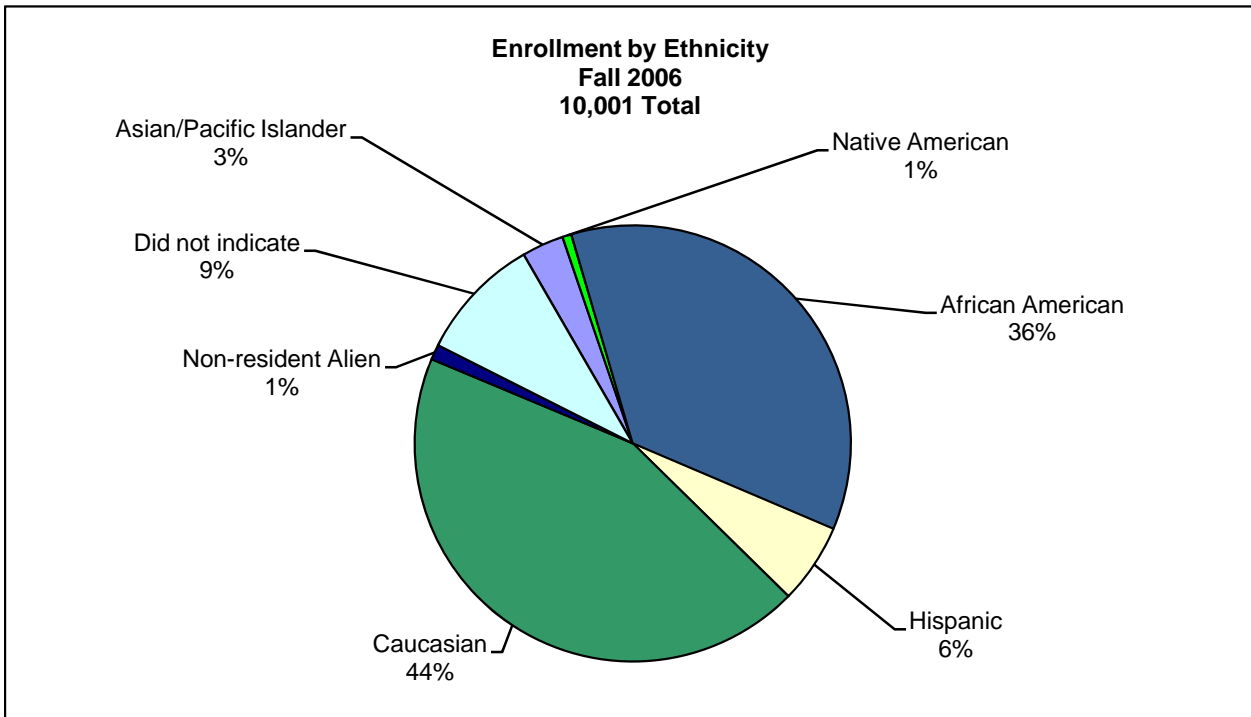
Enrollment by Gender

Enrollment by Age

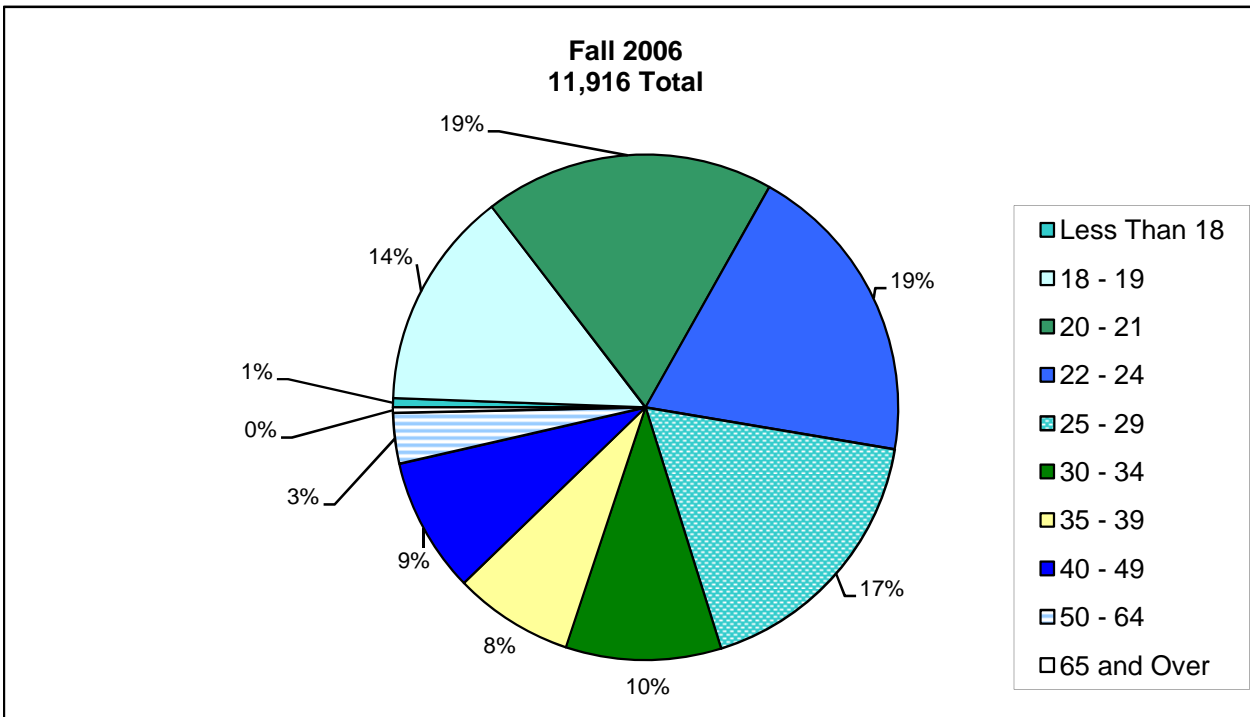
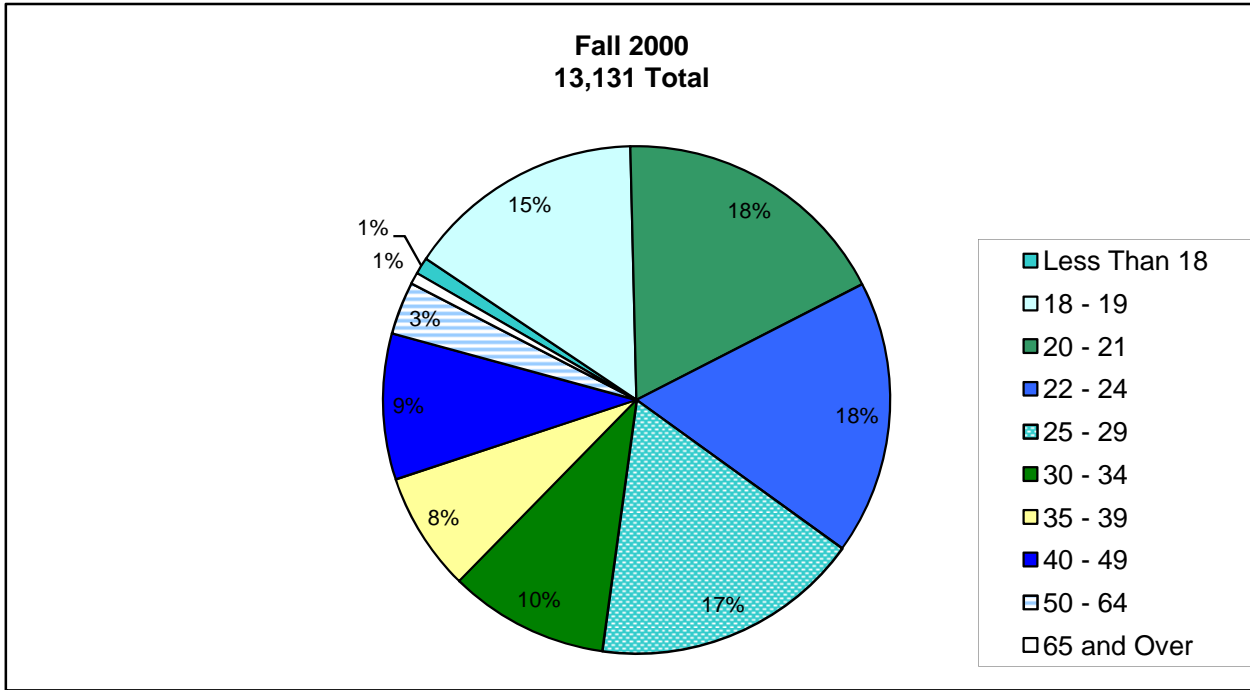

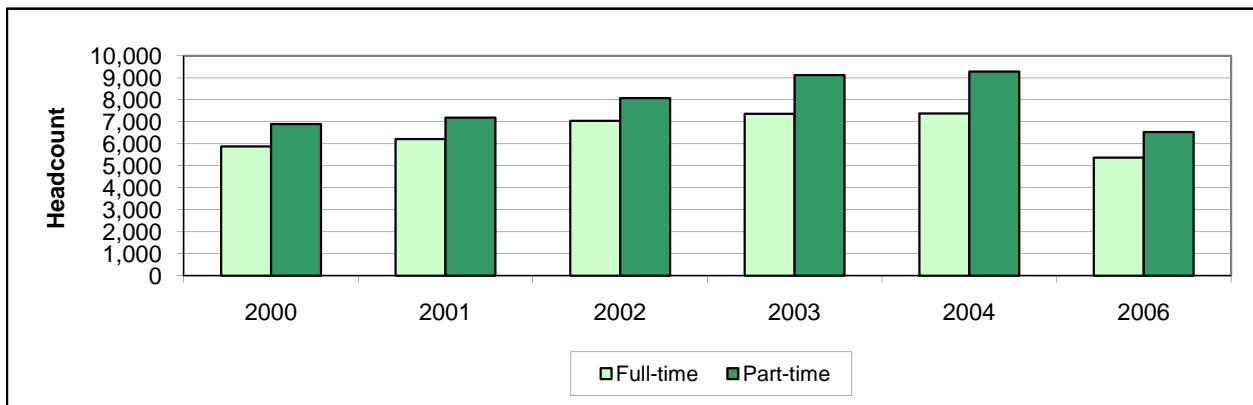

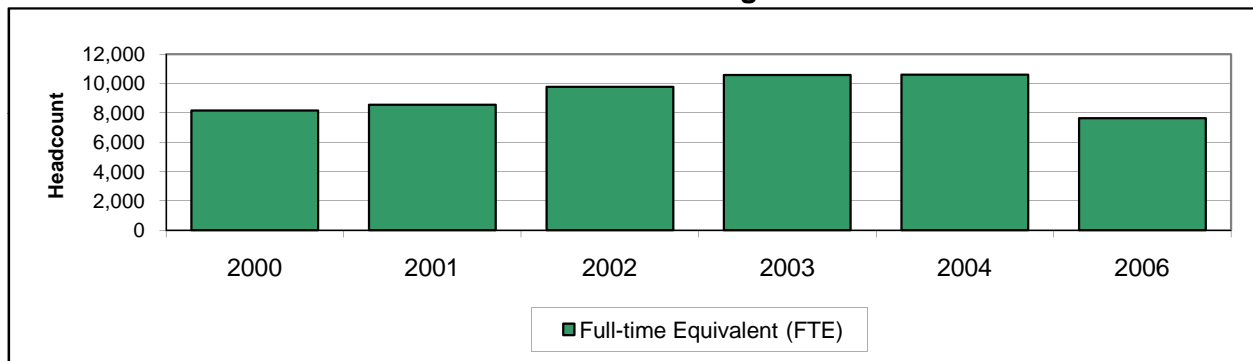

Fall Semesters 2000 through 2006¹**

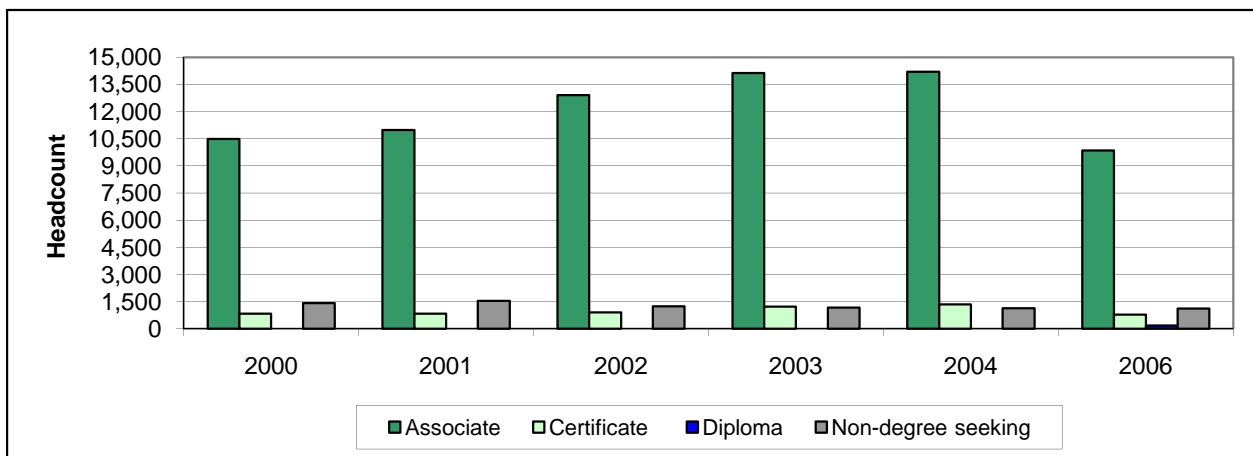


**Enrollment by Full-Time Equivalent (FTE*)

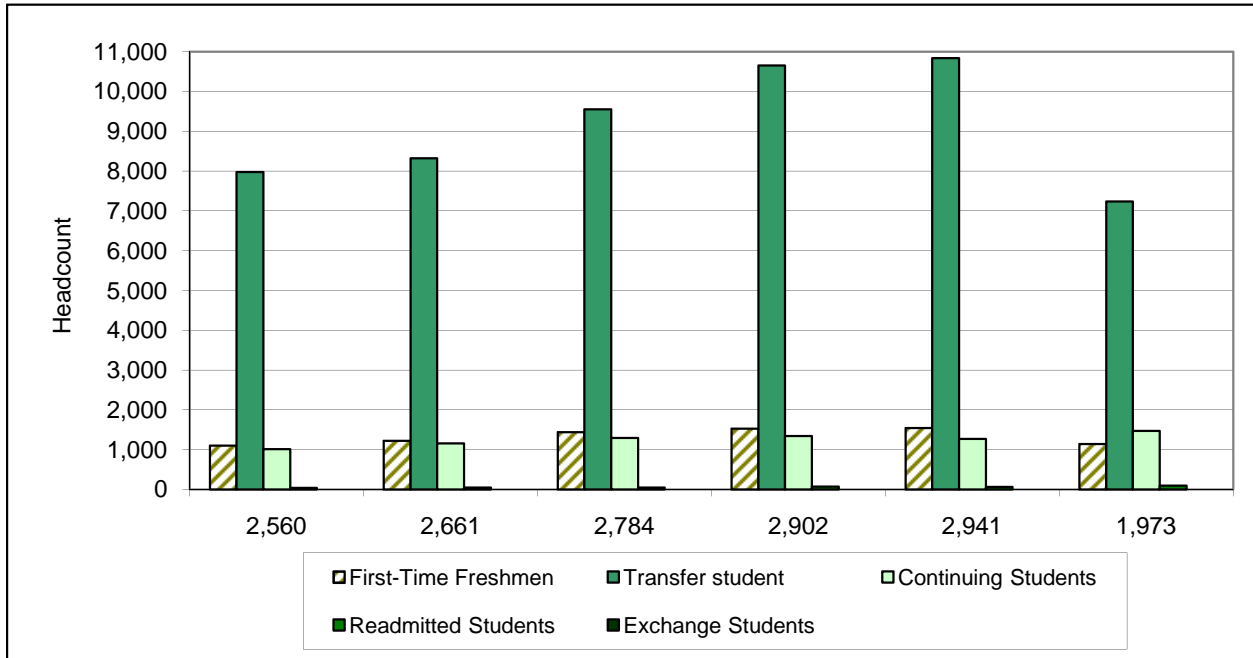

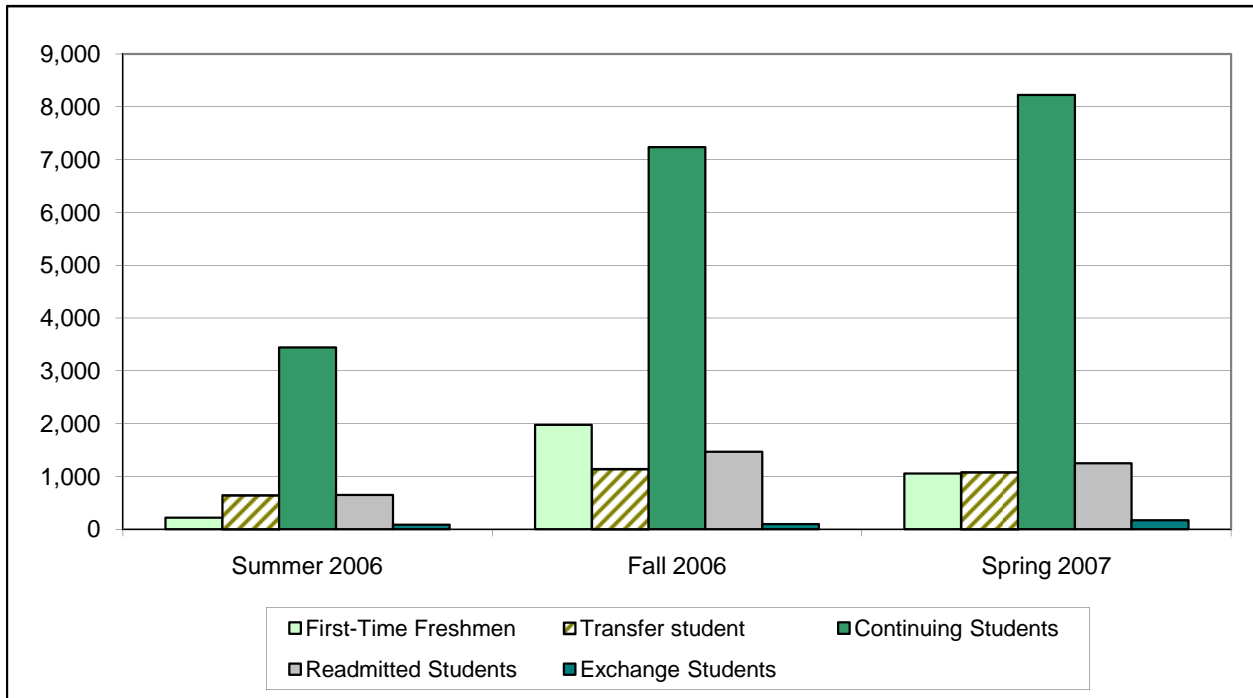

Student Admission Status Fall Semesters 2000 through 2006¹

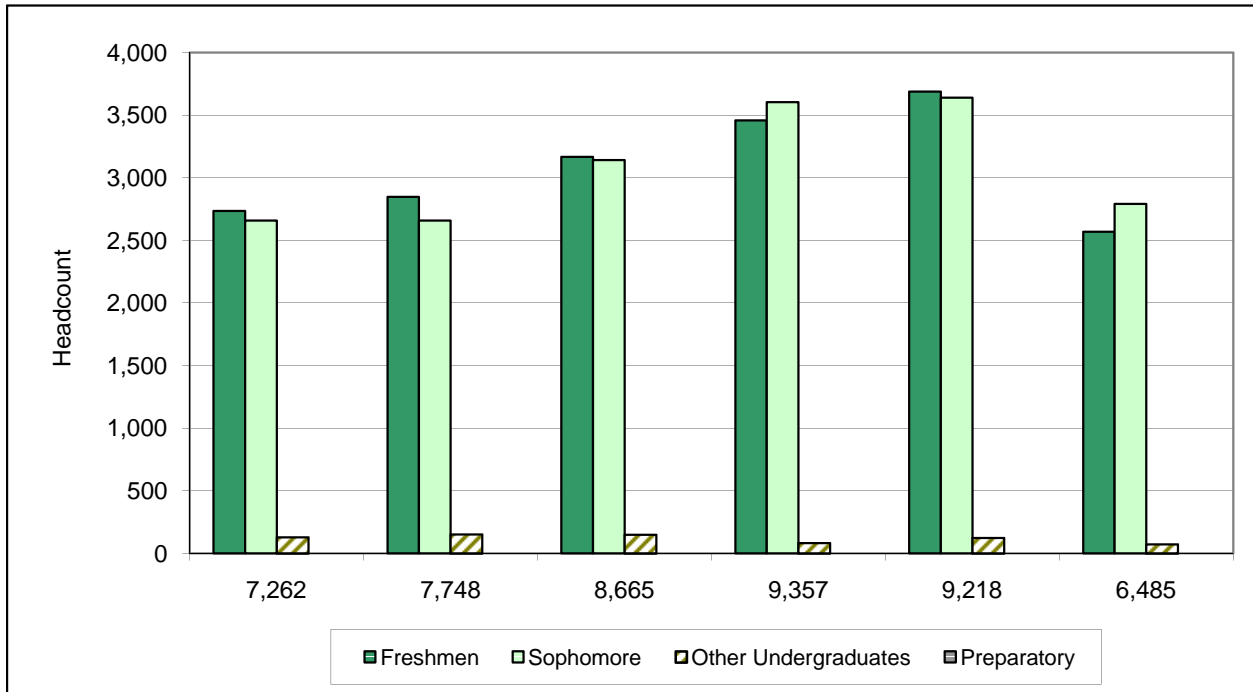

Student Admission Status Summer 2006 through Spring 2007

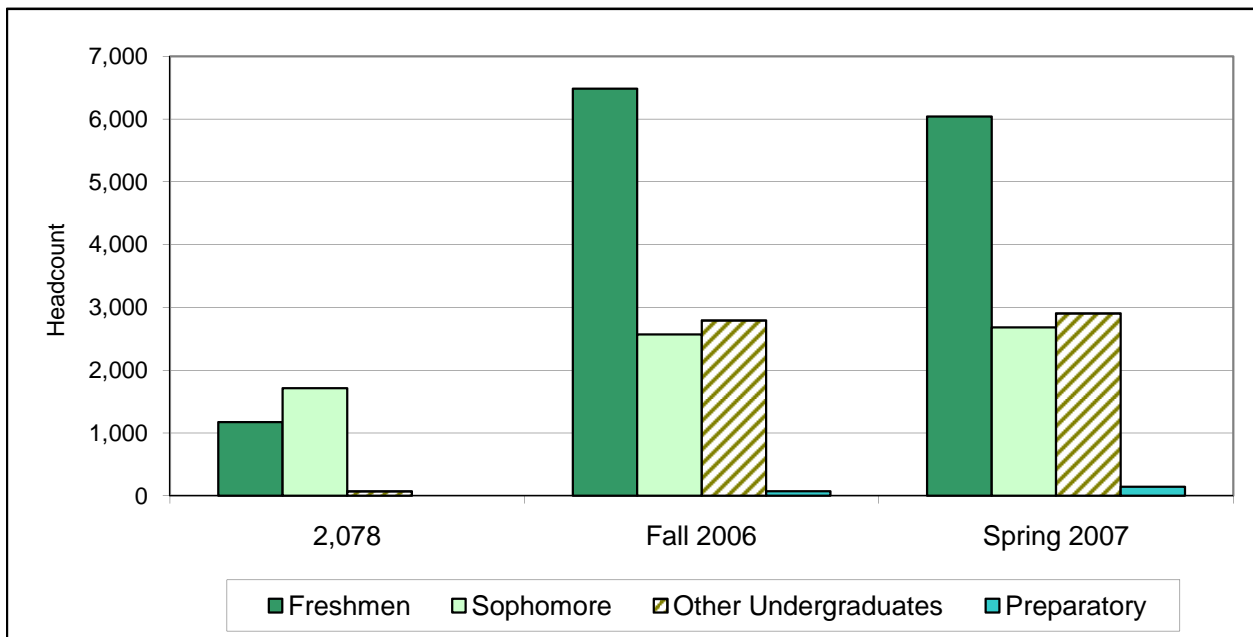


Student Classification Fall Semesters 2000 through 2006¹
