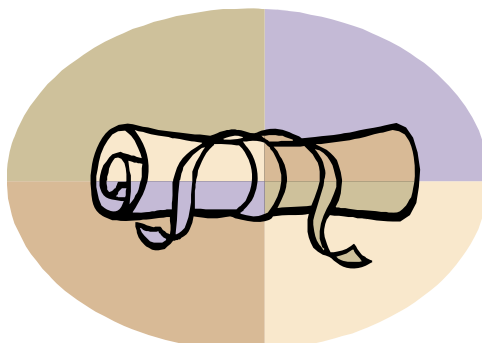

## **Status of Fall 2006 Delgado students who transferred in Fall of 2007**

### Summary

According to data received from the La. Board of Regents, 550 Delgado students that were enrolled in Fall 2006, transferred to a four-year institution by Fall 2007. Sixty-seven percent were female, 33% male. African Americans made up 36%, Hispanics 4% and white students made up 42%. Freshmen made up 50%, and 11% were first time freshmen.

### Report Limitations

This data is furnished to us by the Board of Regents in aggregate form. Individual students are not identified, therefore we can't evaluate this report in terms of how the student performed while at Delgado. We do not know how long the student was at Delgado. We do know if they were above or below the Sophomore level. This means we know if they had more or less than 30 hours. We don't know if they were in good academic standing while at Delgado.

### Results

Overall 78% were in good academic standing.

The most significant statistic for us is that the longer students remain at Delgado, the better their chances for success at a four-year college. Seventy-four percent of freshmen were in good standing where as 82 % of sophomores and up were in good standing at the transfer institution.

By transfer institutions, students who transferred to UNO had the highest percentage of students in good standing (82%). Southern Baton Rouge has the lowest with 55%. This is based on institutions with at least 10 transfer students.

Of the 43 programs with transfers, 13 (40%) had fewer than 80% in good academic standing.

### Recommendation

Of the 13 programs with less than 80% in good academic standing, 7 had 10 or more transfer students. These programs, particularly those whose transfers were primarily sophomores or above, may want to review program content from the standpoint of what students in those programs need to be successful at a 4 year institution.

It should be noted that not all programs are designed for transfer. Nor can we be sure that the students are majoring in the same field at the transfer institution.
