The College of Arts and Sciences of the Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) and the Science and Mathematics Division of Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students that complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's General Science Associate Degree to transfer and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Biology from the College of Arts and Sciences at SUNO.

Delgado 2 SUNO Agreement

Program

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an associate degree in General Science will be admitted as juniors in the College of Arts and Sciences at the Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) provided they meet SUNO's admission requirements. Course requirements for Delgado's associate degree in General Science are described on page two of this document.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree from SUNO is 124 semester hours and students can transfer up to 63 semester hours for degree credit from Delgado to SUNO. This is a 2+2 program in which Delgado students will earn a bachelor's degree from the Southern University of New Orleans after successfully completing at least 60 additional semester hours in a prescribed major at SUNO and meeting all SUNO degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the SUNO Undergraduate/ Graduate Catalog in force at the time they enter Delgado provided it is not over 10 years old and provided there was no break in enrollment of over 5 years.

In order to graduate from SUNO, students must complete at least 50% of Biology courses at SUNO, and achieve a quality point ratio of 2.0 or better in all work attempted, all work taken at SUNO, and all courses in the major taken at SUNO.

If the performance of 2+2 students is significantly lower than that of continuing SUNO students, faculty representatives from SUNO and Delgado will meet to enhance the alignment of courses from the two programs.

This agreement will be renewed every three years from the date of signing and will be continued, modified or terminated upon mutual agreement of the parties.
