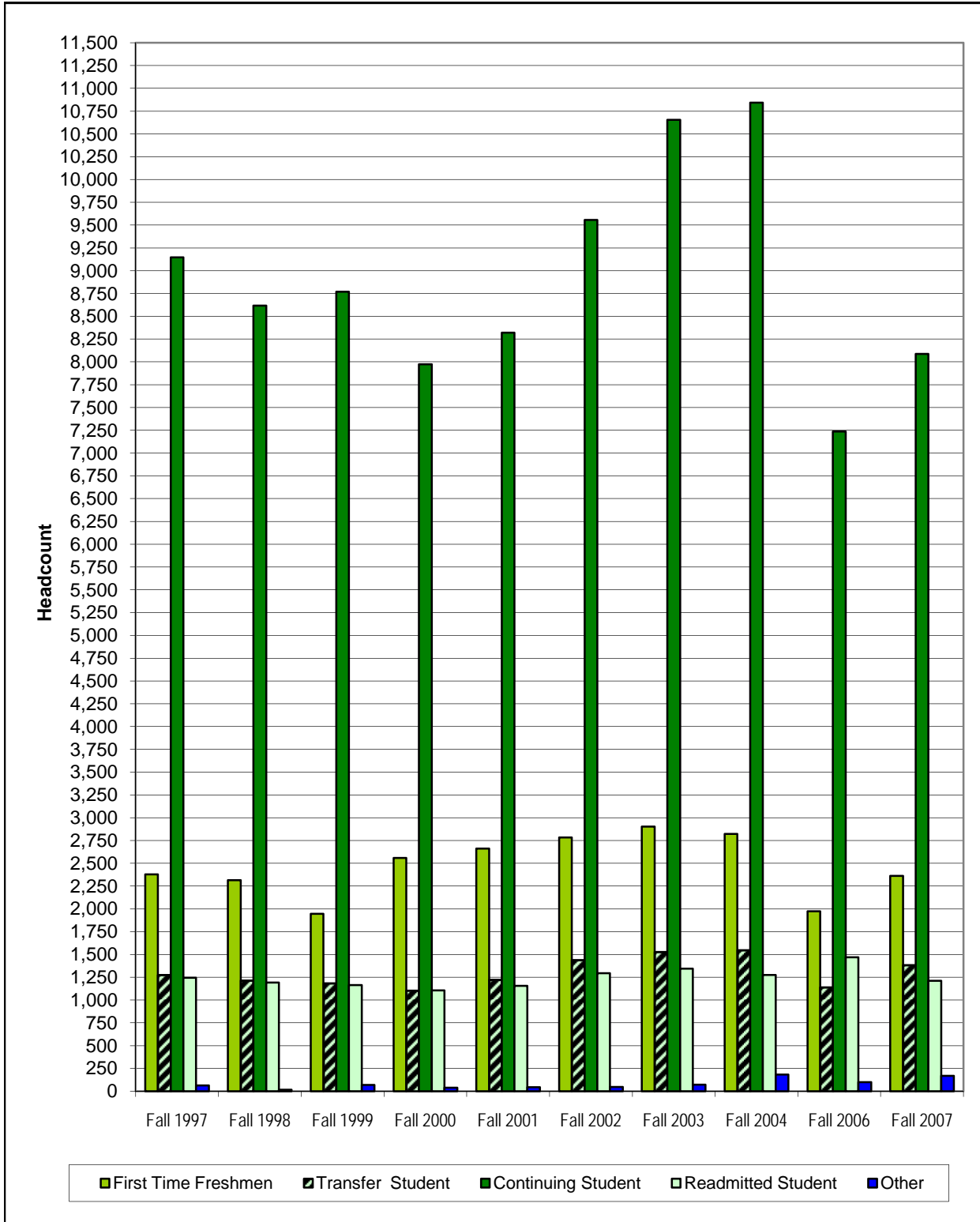

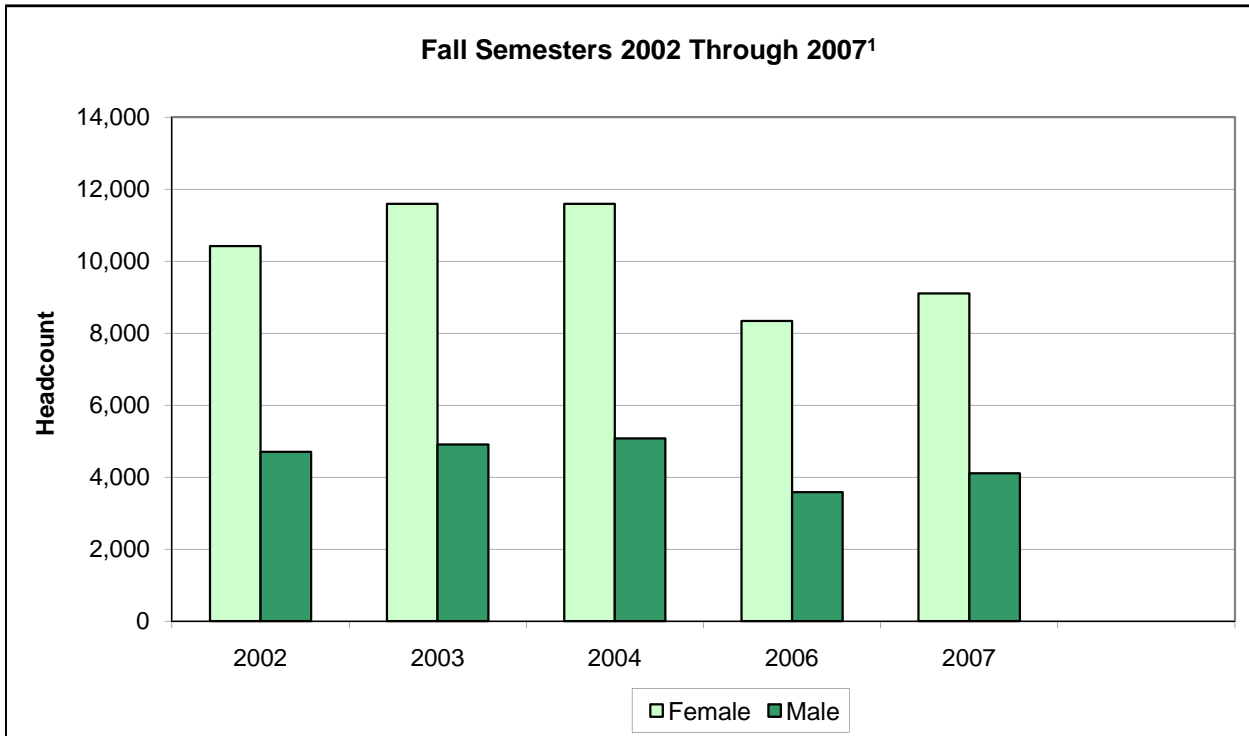

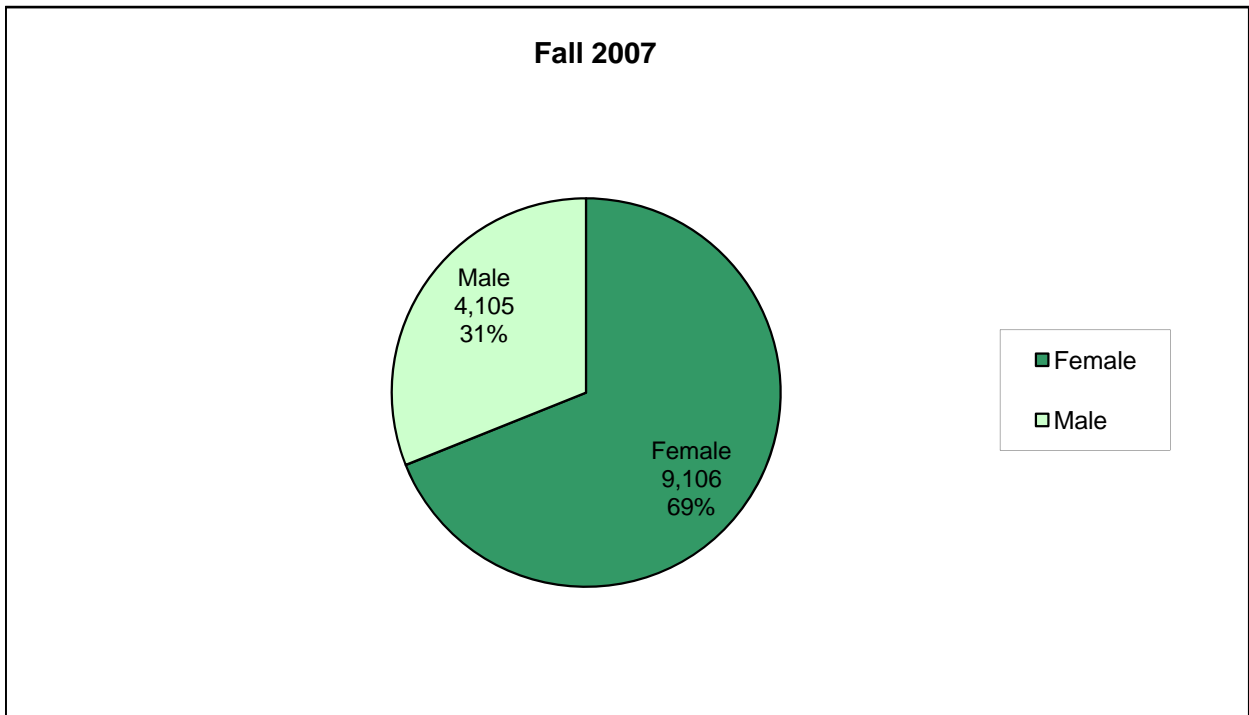

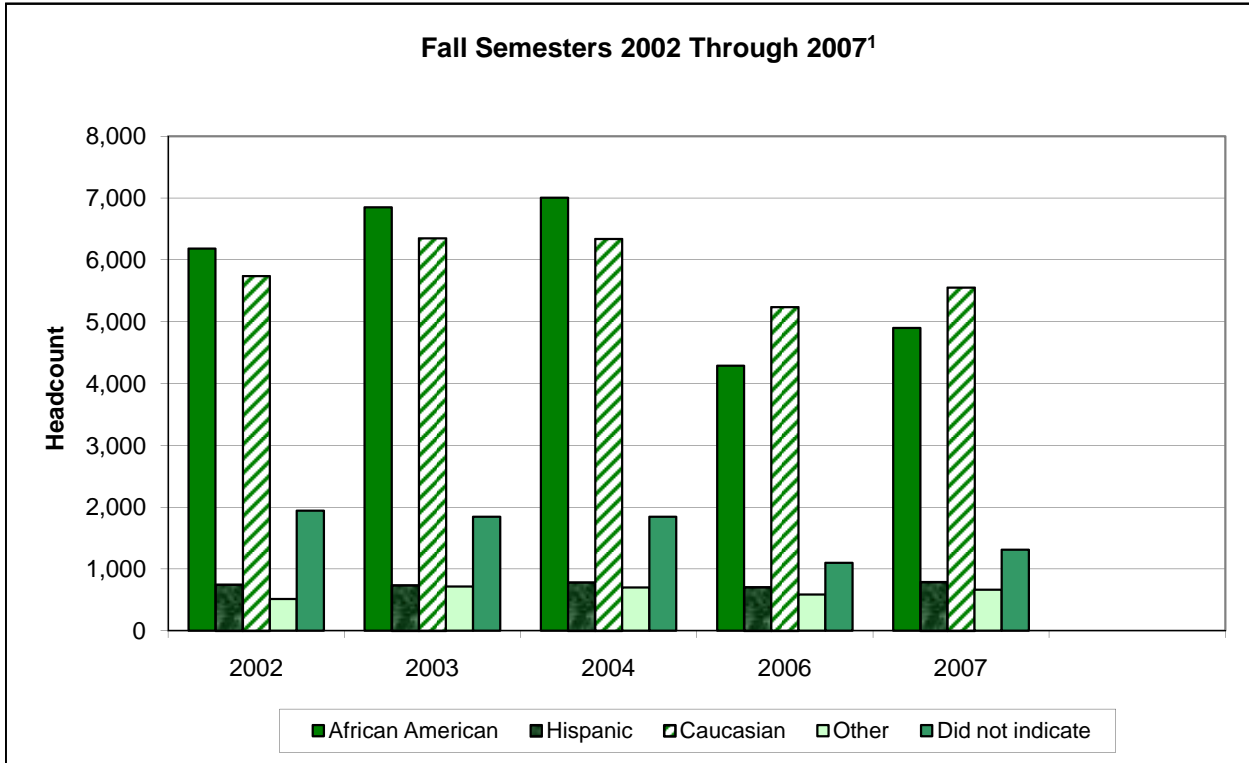
Enrollment by Gender



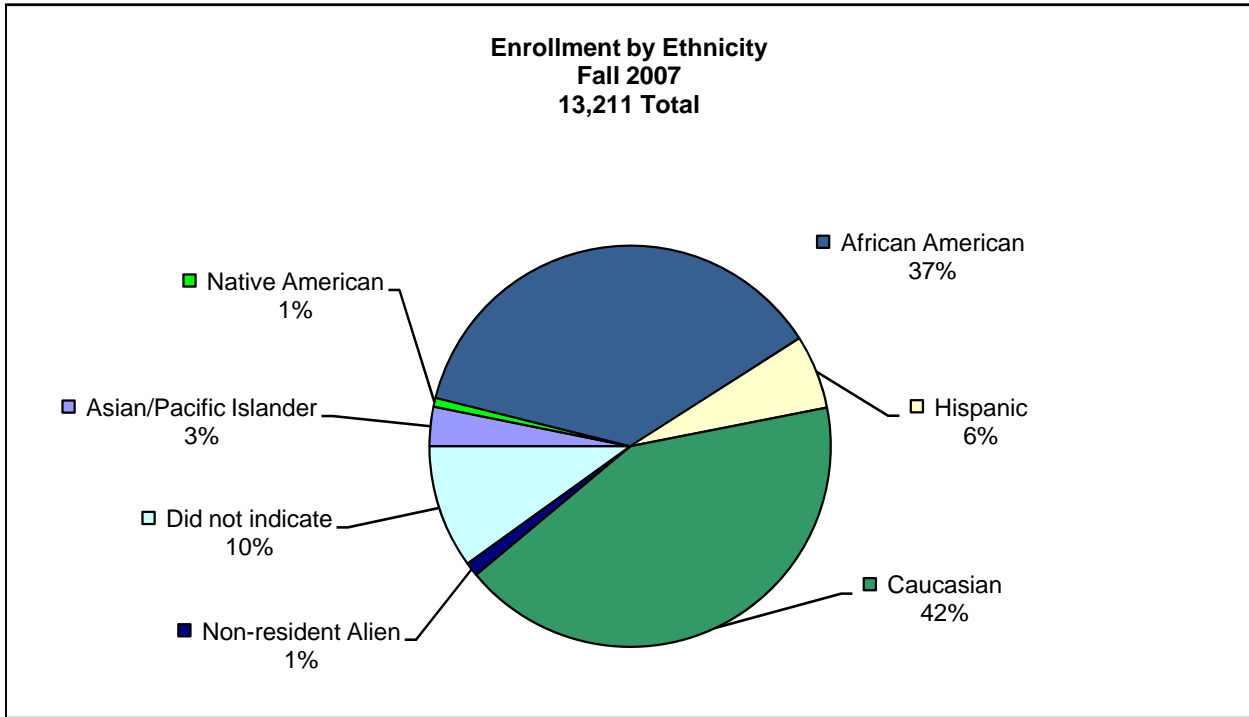

Enrollment by Age

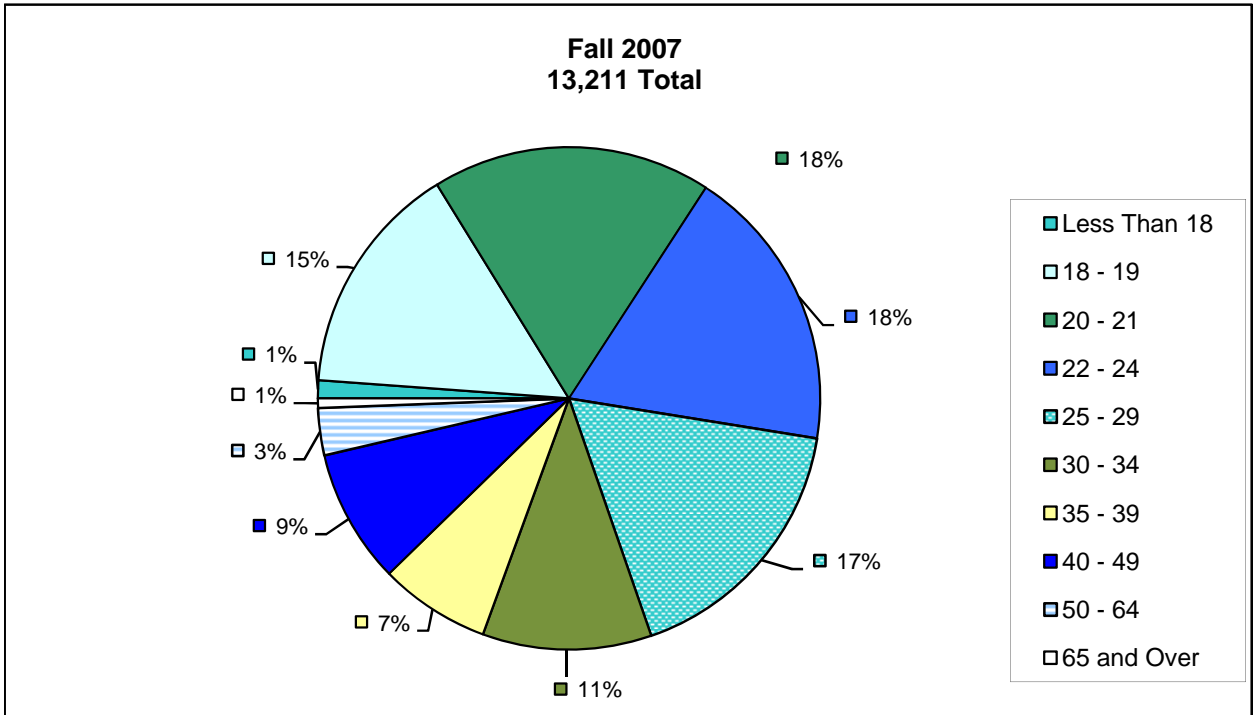
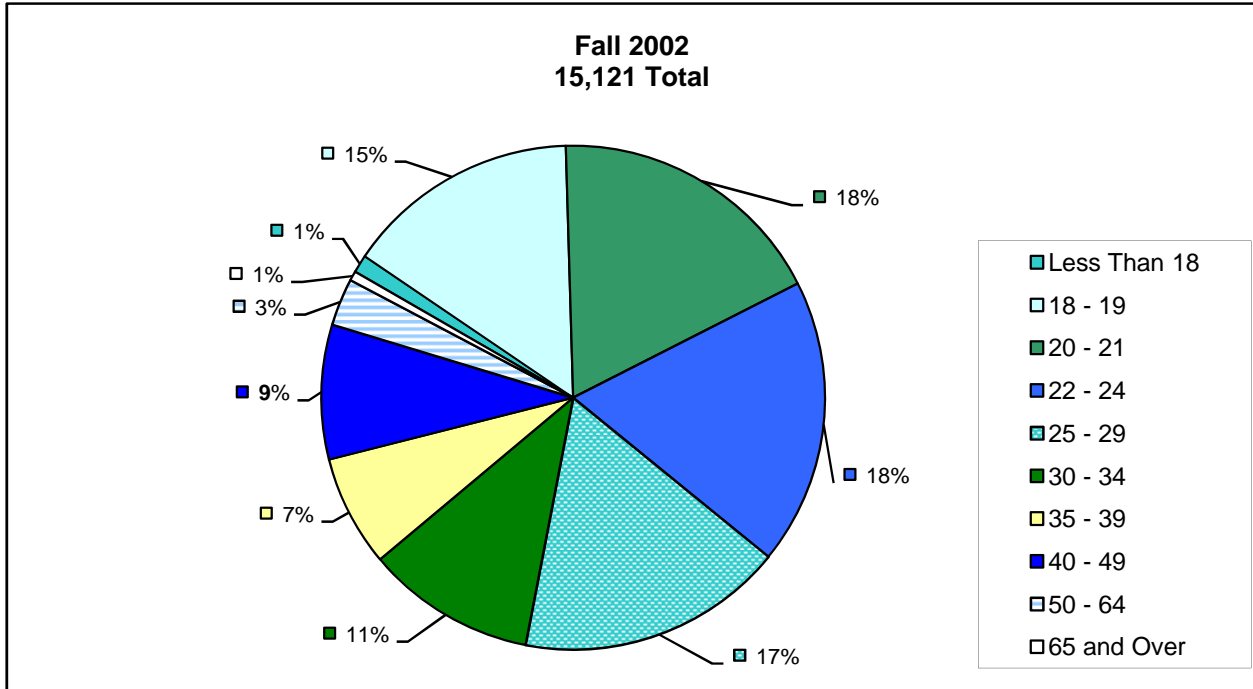

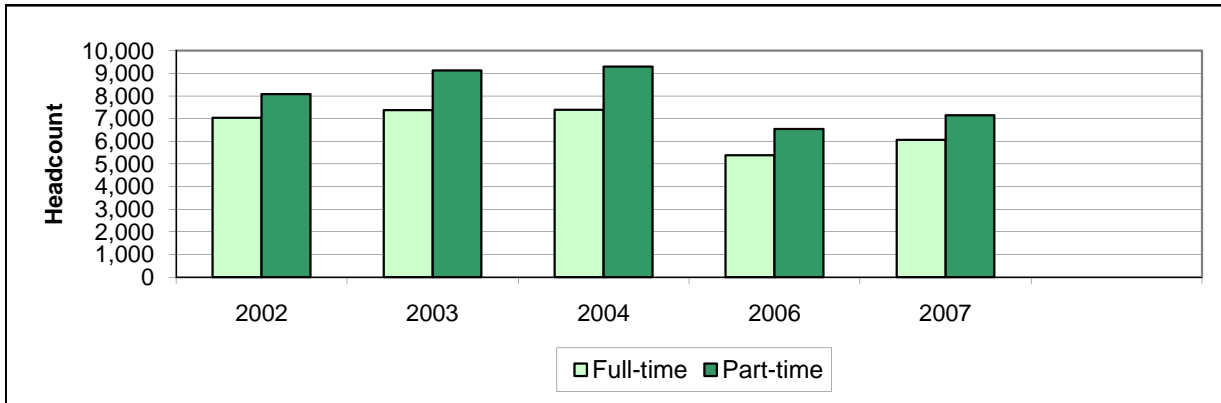

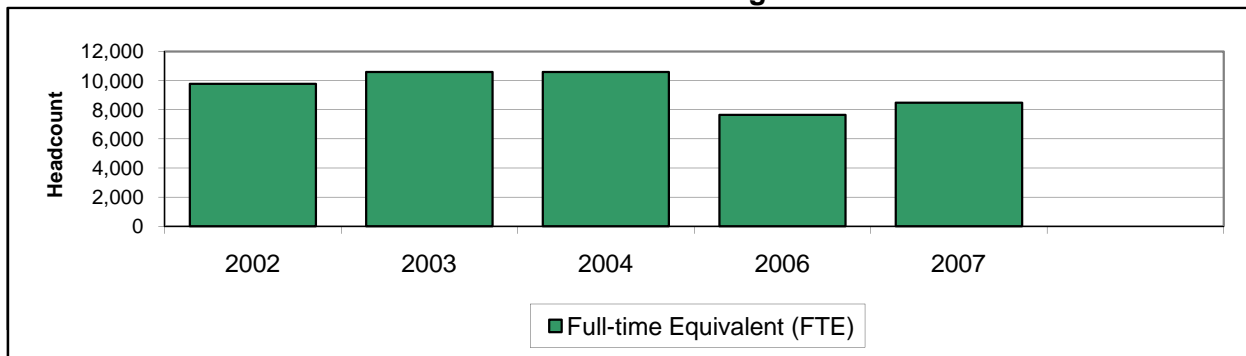

Fall Semesters 2002 through 2007¹**

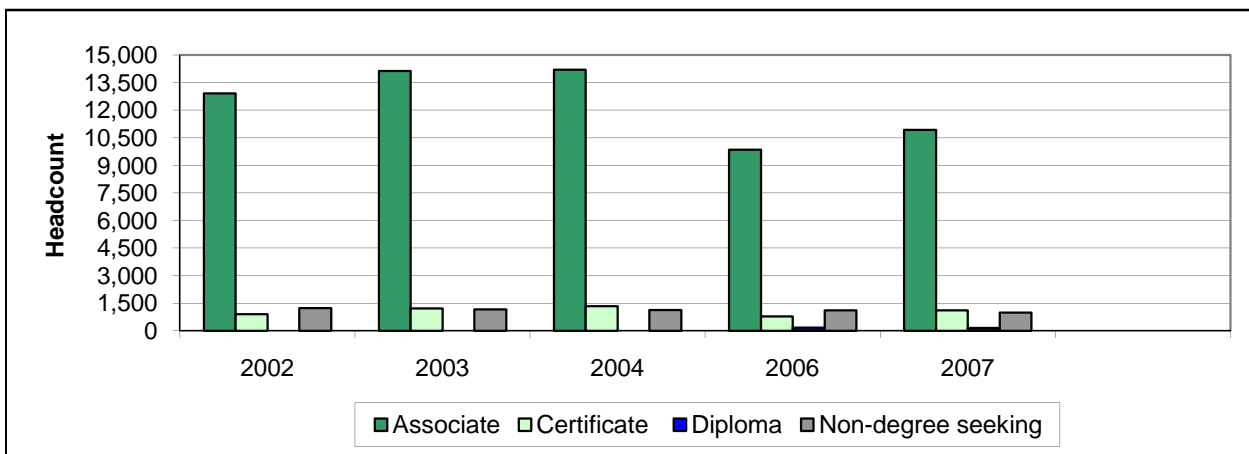


**Enrollment by Full-Time Equivalent (FTE*)

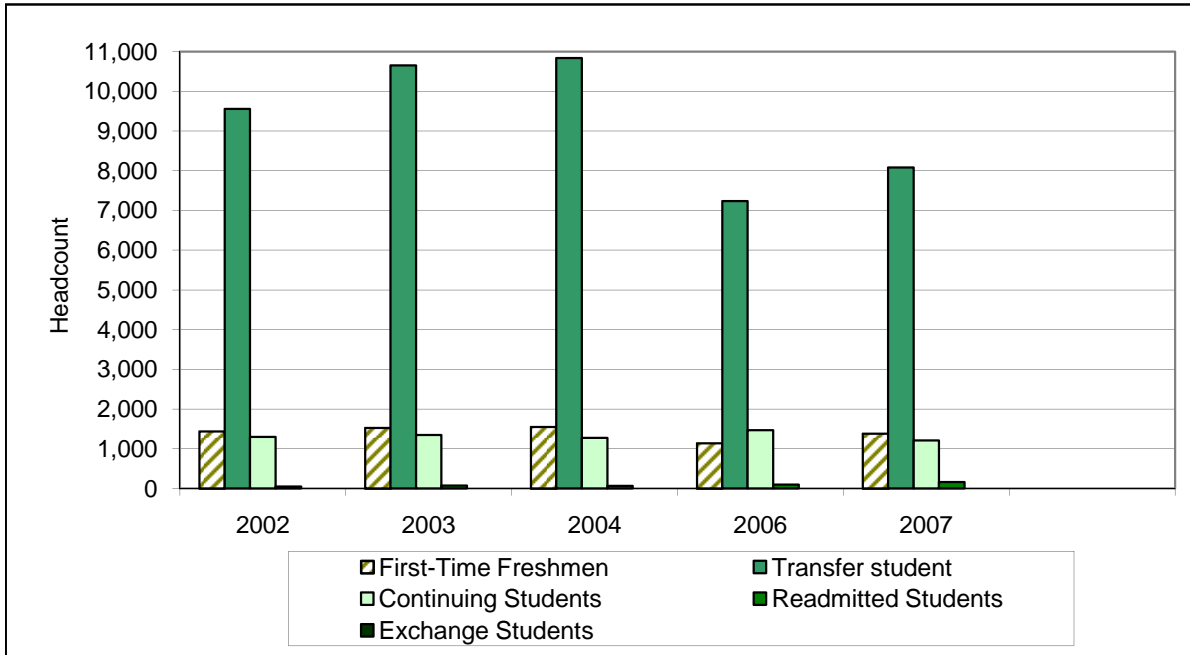

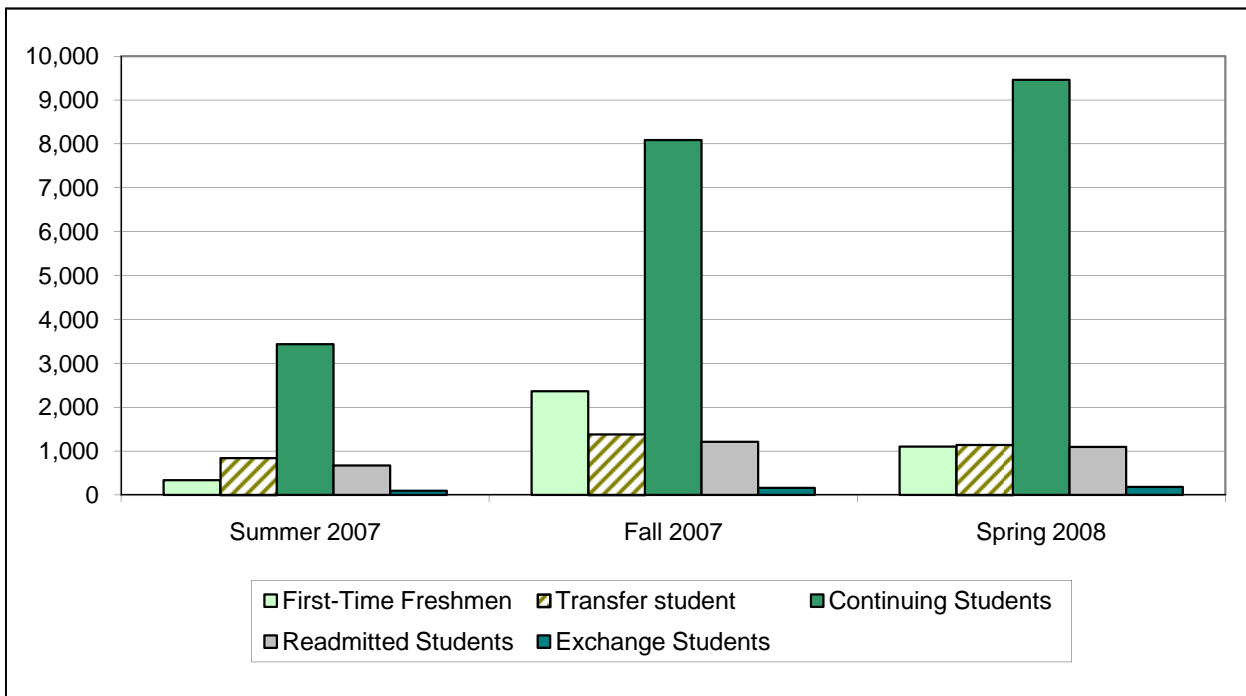

Student Admission Status Fall Semesters 2001 through 2007¹

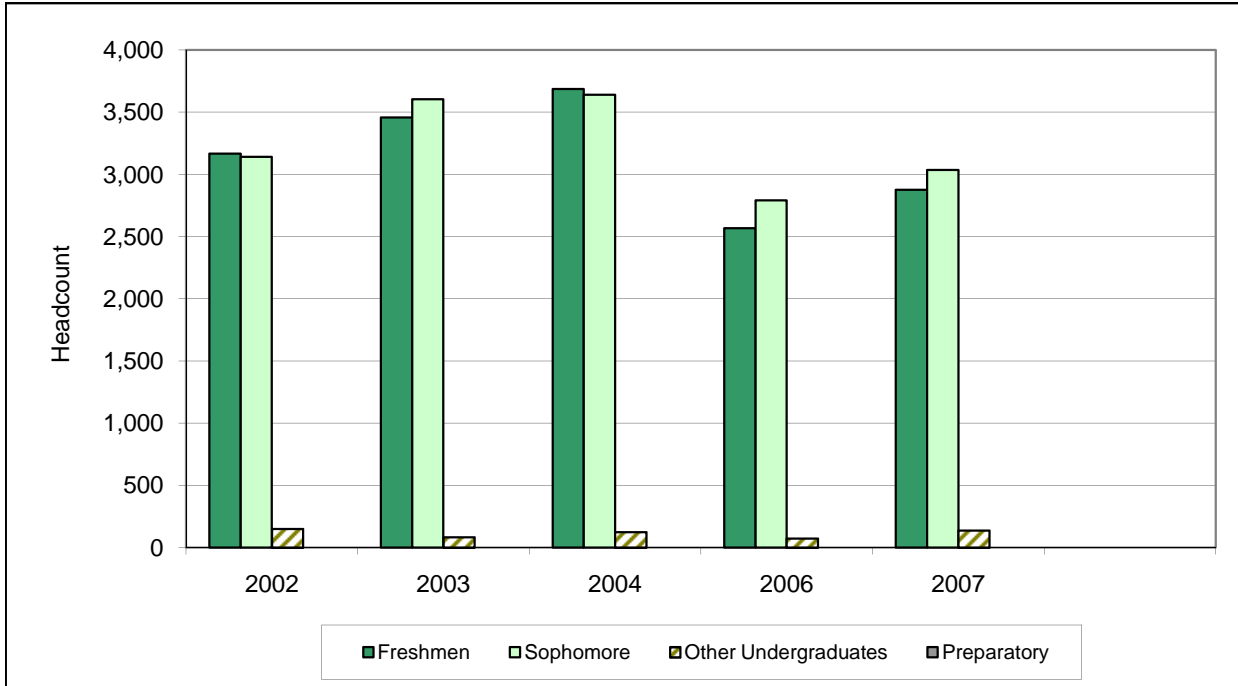

Student Admission Status Summer 2007 through Spring 2008

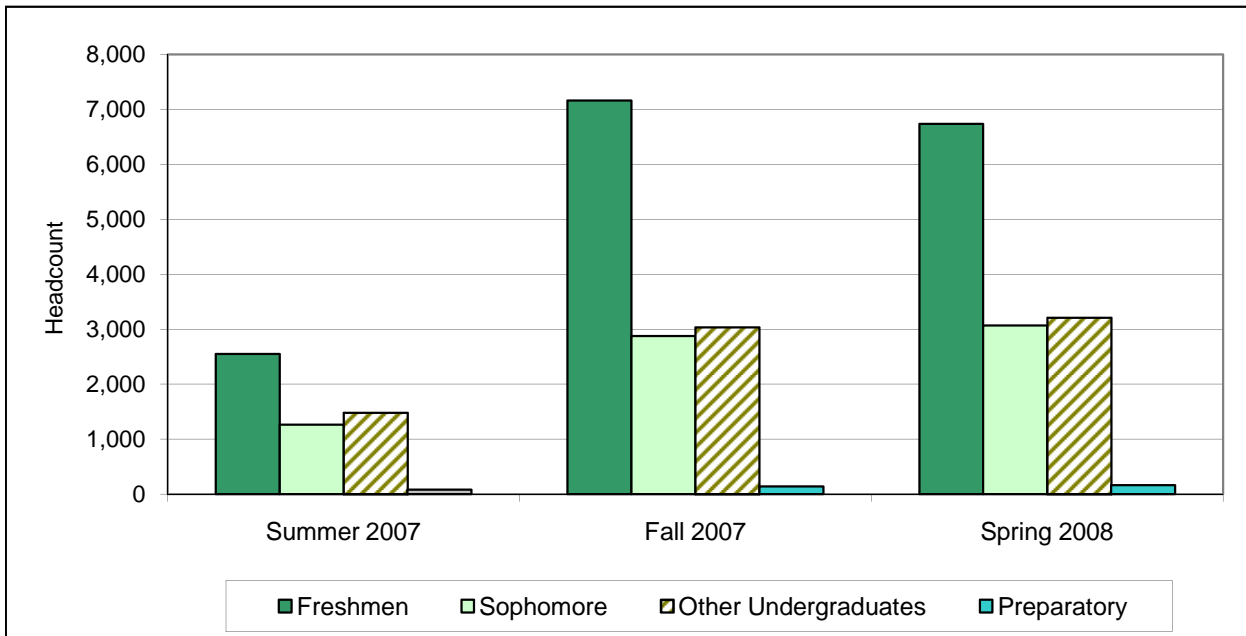


Student Classification Fall Semesters 2002 through 2007¹

Student Classification Summer 2007 through Spring 2008



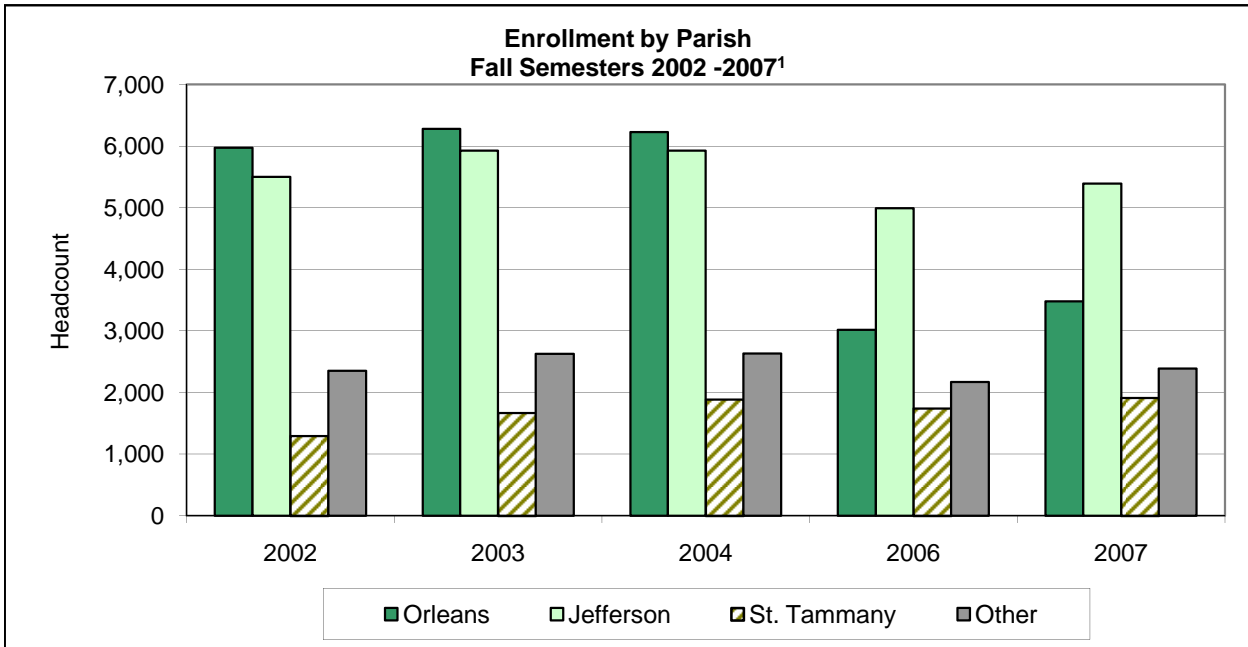

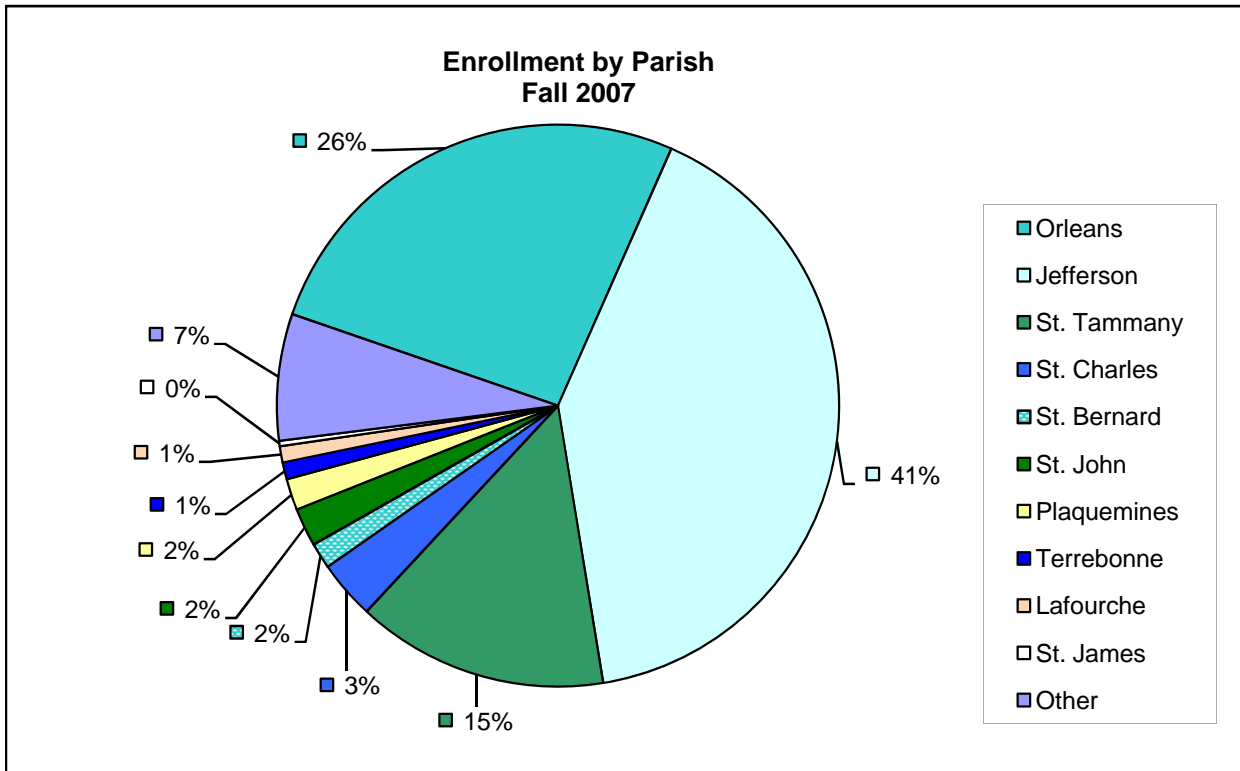
