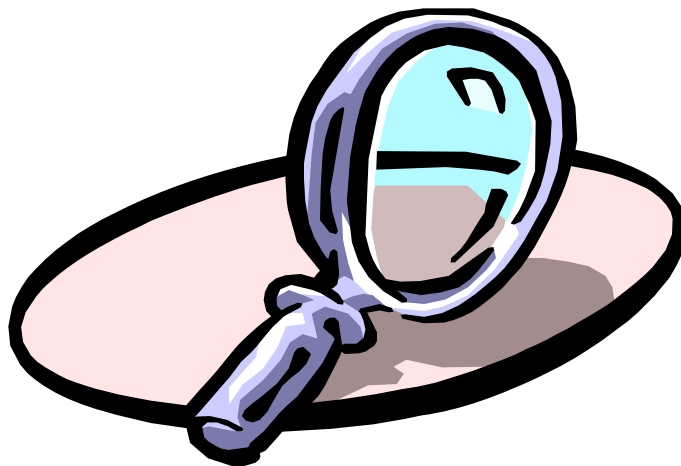

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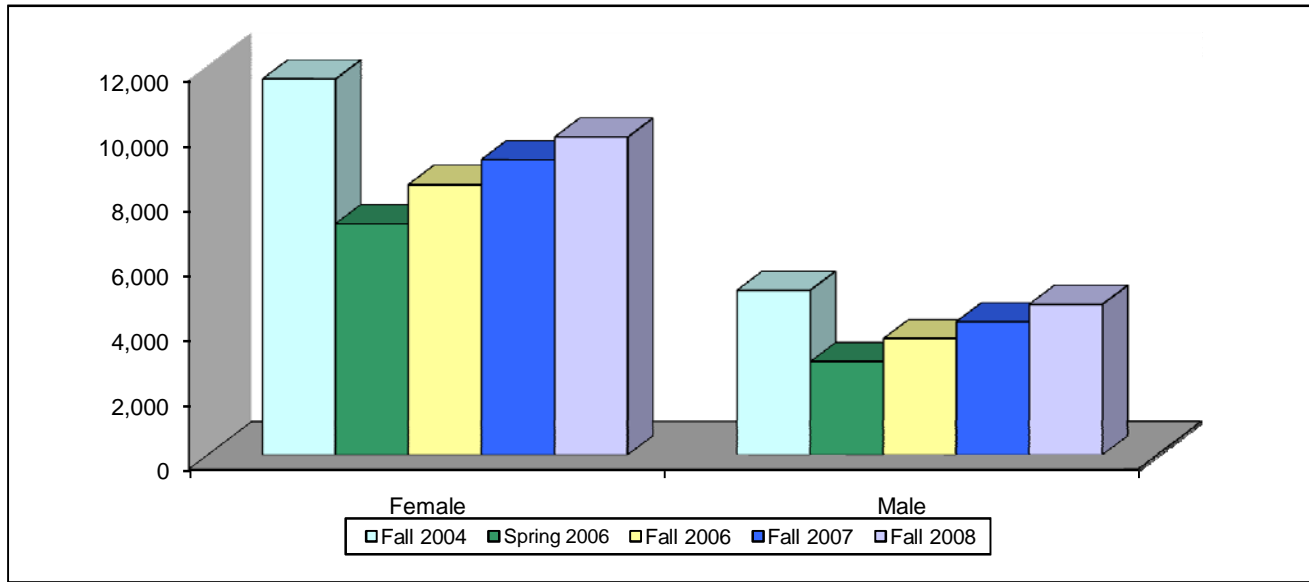
SUMMARY

- ✓ Post-Katrina enrollment increased 9.3% from Fall 2007 (13,211) to Fall 2008 (14,441).
- ✓ Male students increased by 13.2% from Fall 2007; female students increased by 7.6%. Our female student enrollment continues to make up almost 70% of the total.
- ✓ African American enrollment increased by 8.3% from Fall 2007. Asian/Pacific Islander enrollment increased by 17.4%. Caucasian enrollment increased by 5.3% and Non-Resident Aliens increased by 44.7%. African Americans now make up 37% of our enrollment, up from fall 2007 (36.7%), but still less than the pre-Katrina percentage of 42%.
- ✓ The Northshore site had the largest increase from Fall 2007 with 18.3% gain in enrollment. City Park campus increased by 13.4% over Fall 2007. Enrollment at the West Bank campus decreased -2.7%, and Charity campus decreased by -4.9%.
- ✓ Exchange students increases by 64.4% from Fall 2007; First-time freshman increased 7.1% from Fall 2007. Continuing students increased by 10.5%.
- ✓ Pre-Nursing, General Studies and Business Administration had the largest enrollment in Fall 2008.
- ✓ Business and Management, Teaching Grades 1-5, Pre-Nursing, English as Second Language, General Studies, and General Science had significant increases in program enrollment from the Fall 2007 semester.
- ✓ Funeral Service Education, Nuclear Medicine and American Sign Language Interpreting had significant decreases in program enrollment from the Fall 2007.

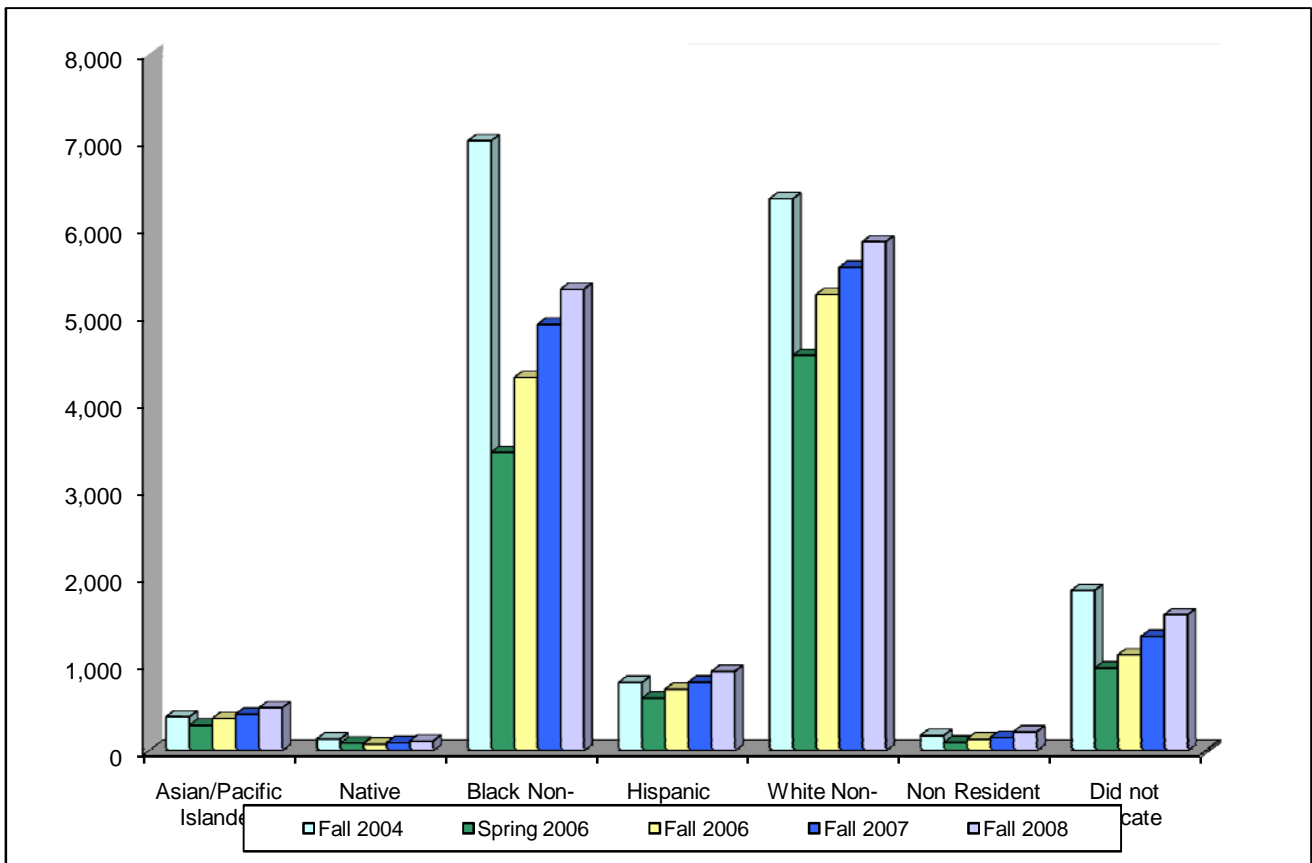

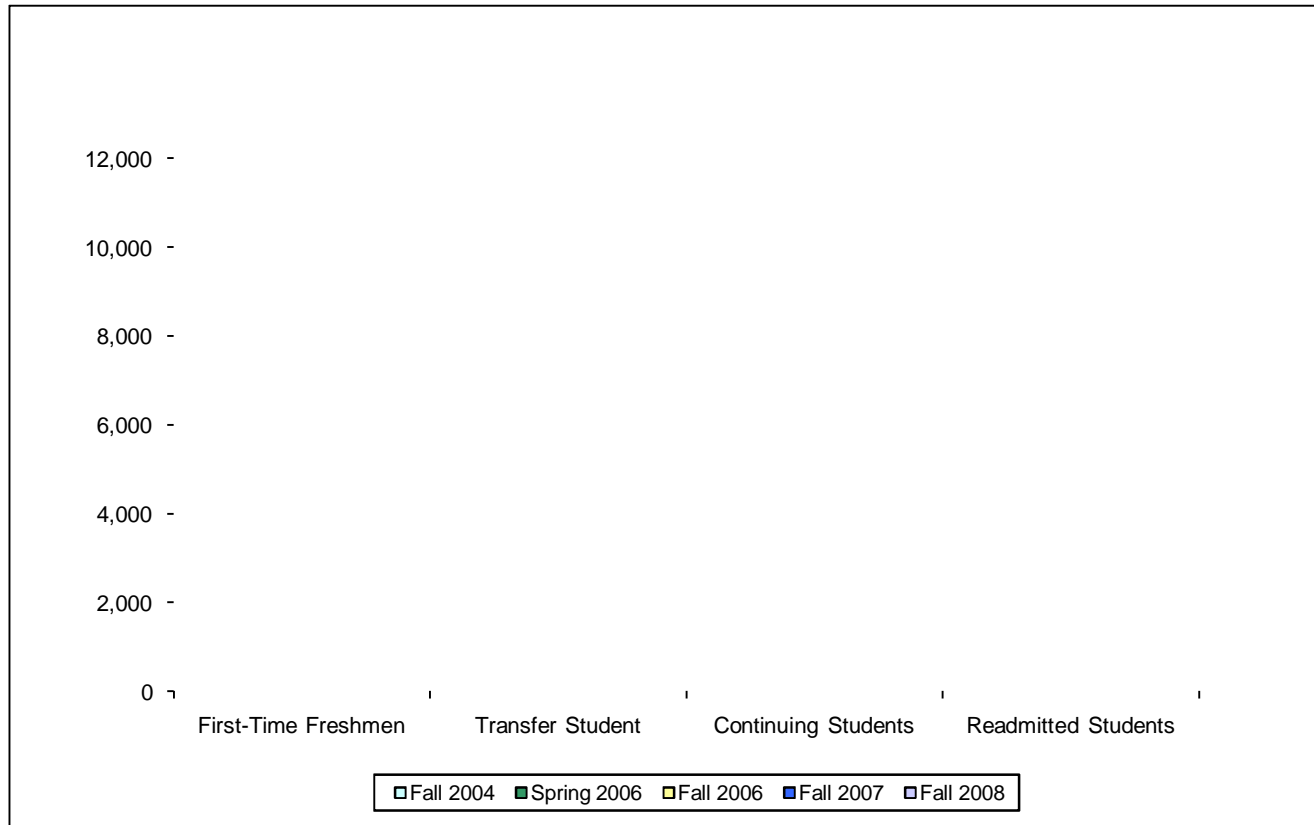
