## **Spring 2008 Retention Report Summary**

In Fall 2008, 57.9% of students who enrolled in Spring 2008 were retained.

- 58.9% females and 55.5% males were retained
- Asians had the highest retention rate of 67.2%, African-Americans had the lowest at 53%
- 55.6% of First-Time, Fulltime Freshmen were retained
- 63.2% of Full-time students were retained, compared to 53.9% of Part-time students
- 20-21 year olds were retained at a rate of 59.7%
