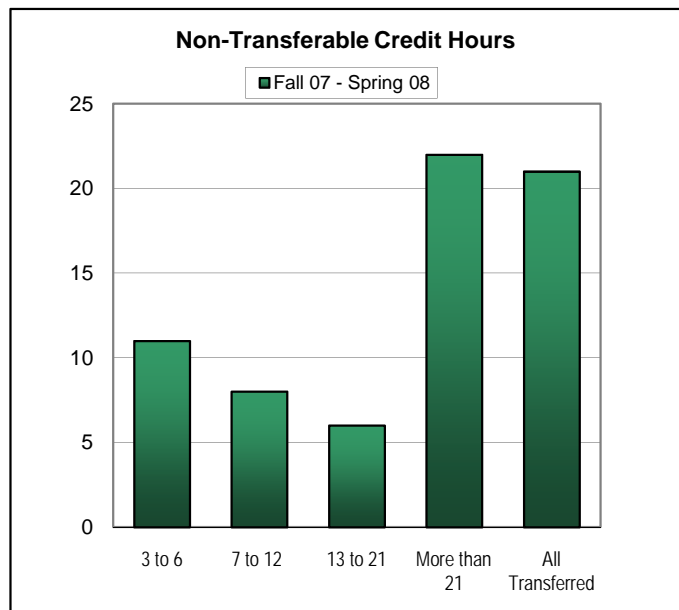

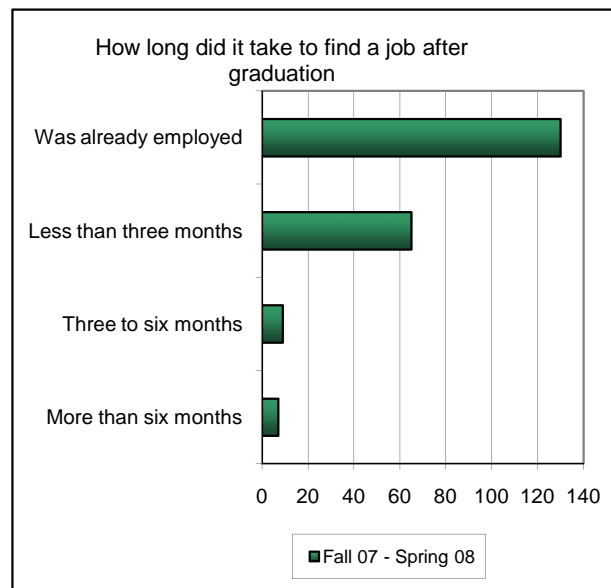

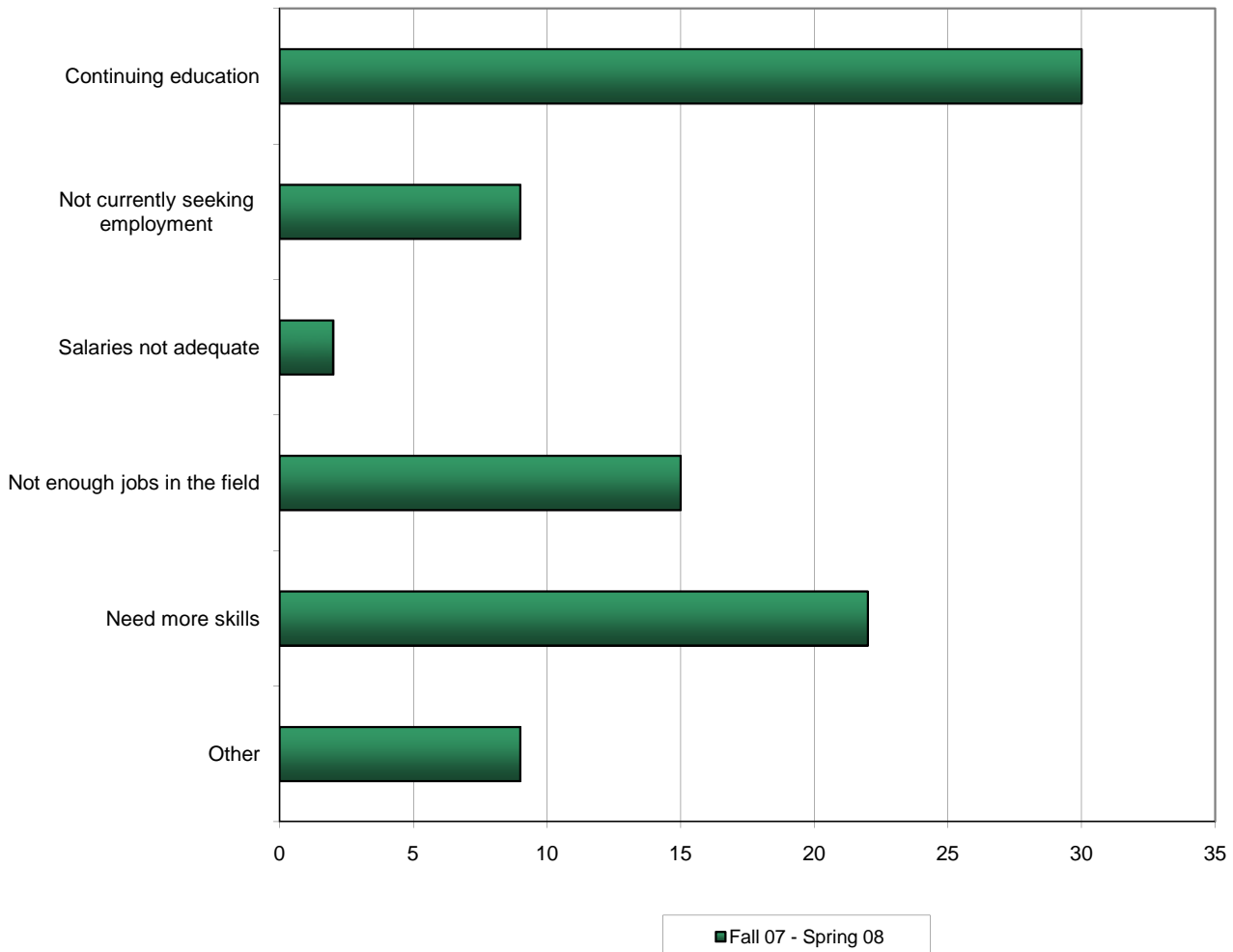

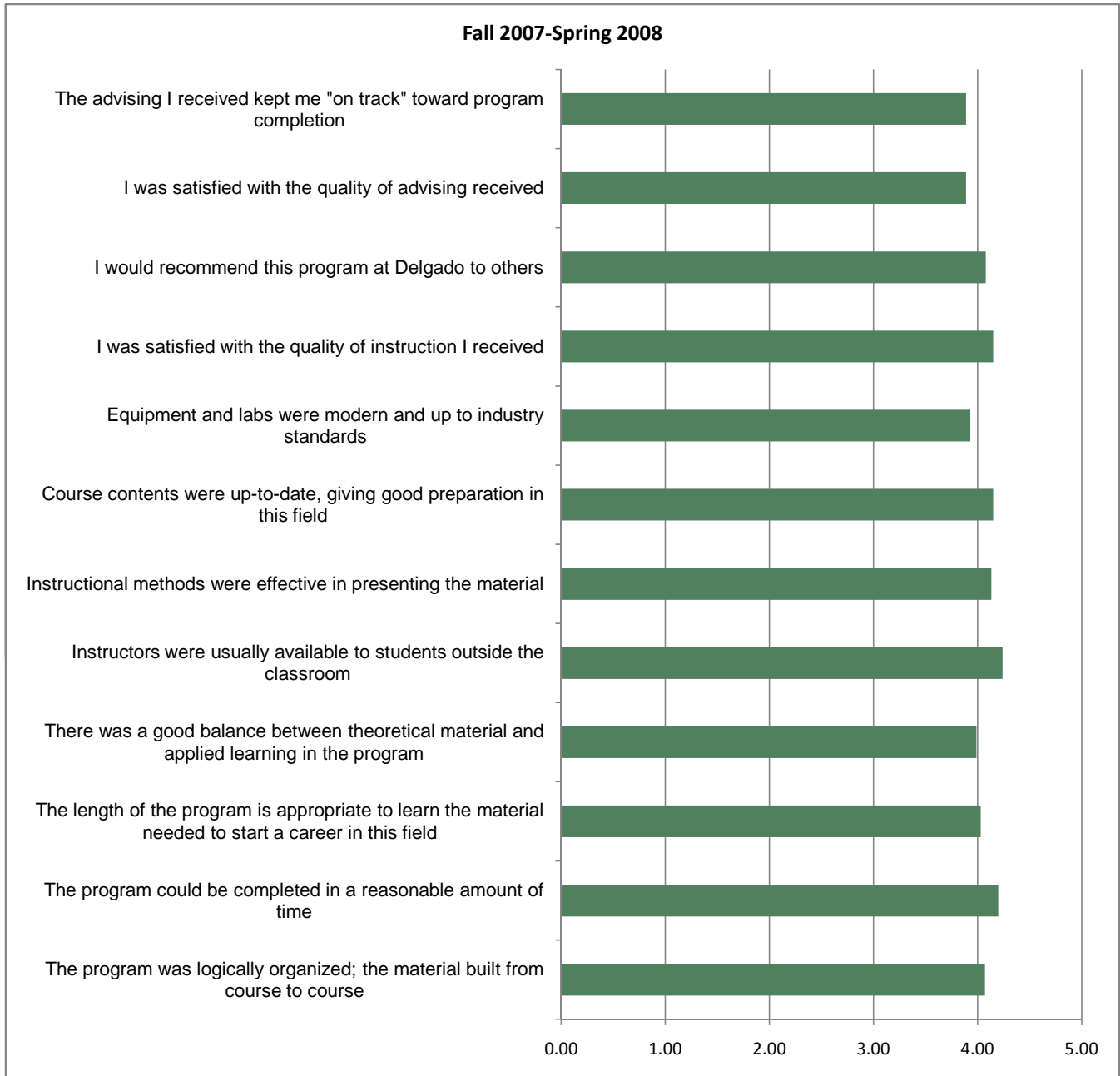

Students are placed under constraints in order to get in school. Often, like me or two occasions, you get kicked out because you never get the money in time. That causes one to often miss that semester. Please reconsider this format if possible so that fewer students are turned away.

I graduated in Education and received my two year degree and transferred to UNO. Almost all of my hours did not transfer. Now I am expected to remain at UNO for almost four more years to complete the rest of my degree in education. Why wasn't I informed about this when I started?

I did not continue my education because I already had a B.A. from Eastern New Mexico University.

Overall the programs was preparing me for the university but unfortunately not all credit transfer therefore a lot of the classes I have to retake.
