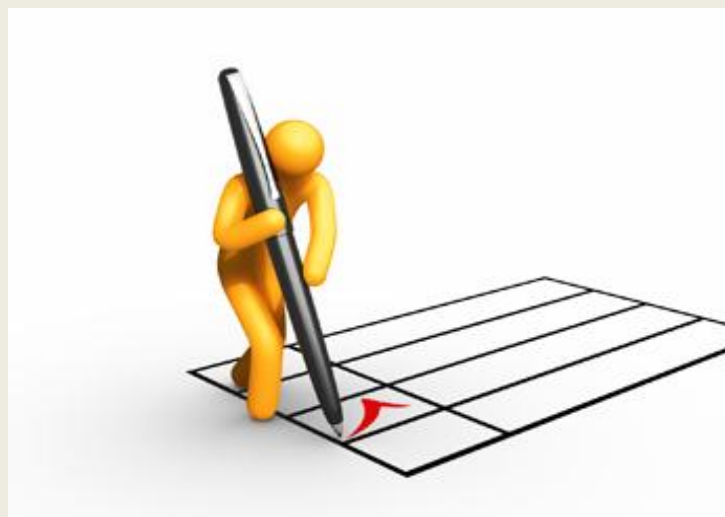

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SUMMARY

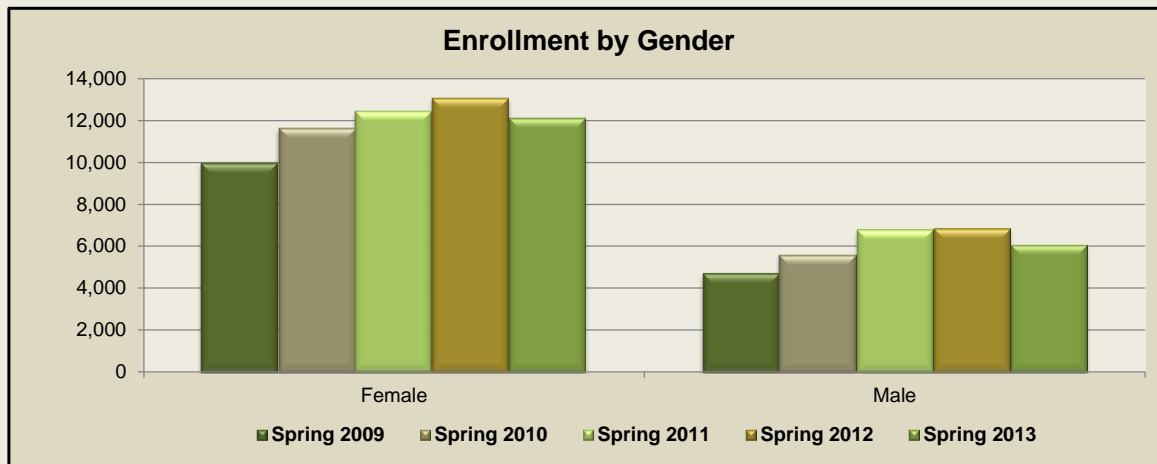
- ✓ Enrollment decreased 8.5% from Spring 2012 (19,909) to Spring 2013 (18,216).
- ✓ Male students decreased by 11.3% and female students decreased by 7.1%.
- ✓ African American enrollment decreased by 6.5%; White enrollment decreased by 5.6% and Hispanic enrollment remained even.
- ✓ African Americans make up 43.2% of our enrollment, Whites 34.4% and Hispanics 7.9%.
- ✓ Continuing students decreased 7.0%, First-time Freshmen decreased 21.8%, Transfer students increased 16.2% , Readmitted students decreased 25.0%.

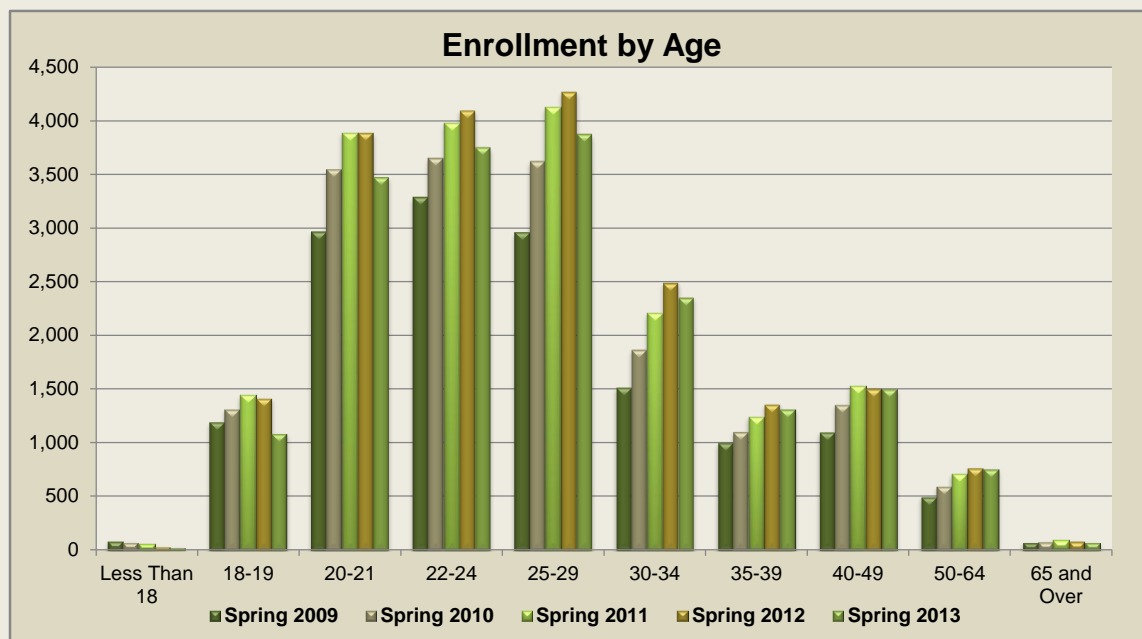

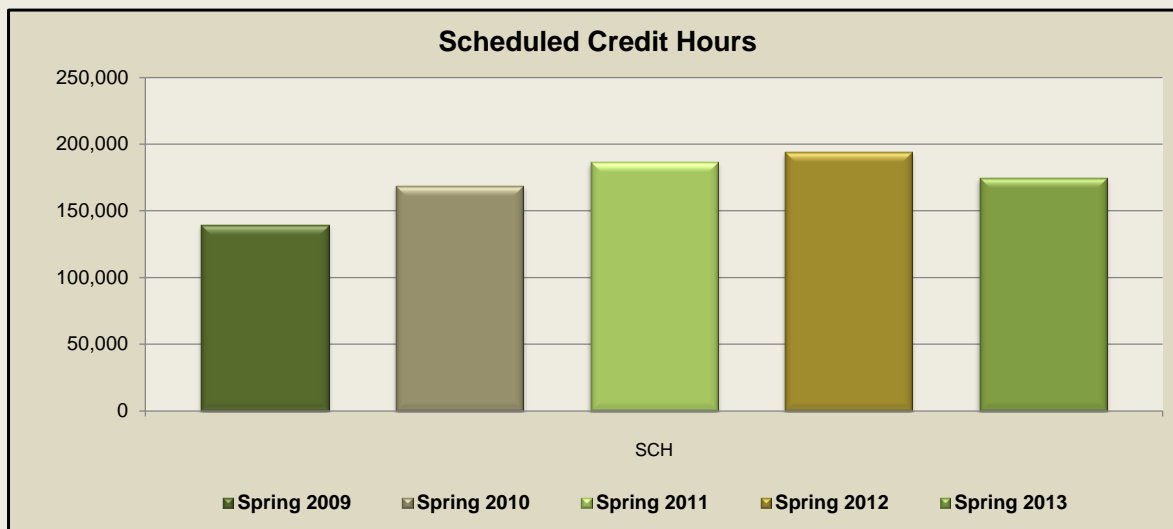
