

## **Fourteenth Day Enrollment Report**

**Spring 2015**



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## SUMMARY

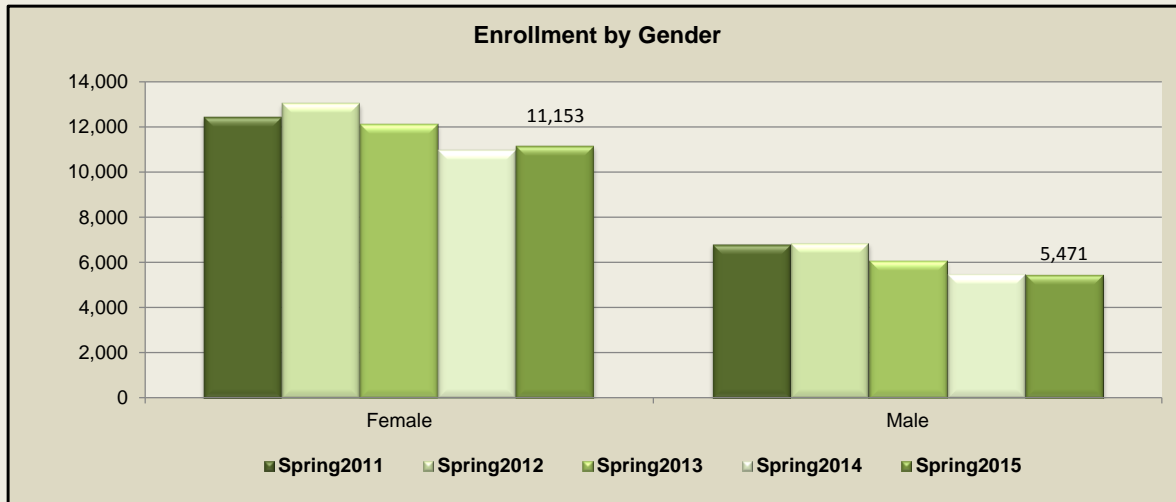
- ✓ Enrollment increased 1% from Spring 2014 (16,511) to Spring 2015 (16,624).
- ✓ Male students decreased by 0.7% from Spring 2014; female students increased by 1.4%.
- ✓ Black Non-Hispanic enrollment increased by 7.5% from Spring 2014.
- ✓ White Non-Hispanic enrollment decreased by 4.1%
- ✓ Exchange students increased from last year, now make up 3%; Transfer students make up 7%,.
- ✓ Full Time students decreased 4.1%.  
Full Time students now make up 38%, Part Time students make up 62% of our enrollment.
- ✓ Nursing, General Studies and Business & Management had the largest enrollment in Spring 2015.

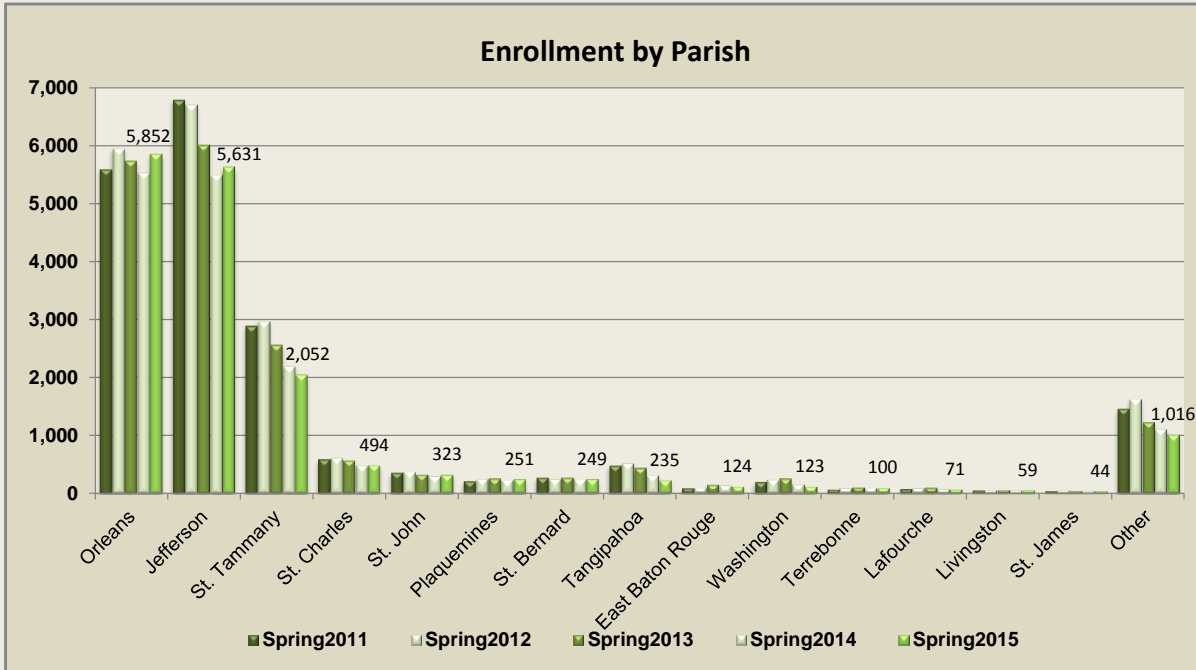
