Enrollment by Age

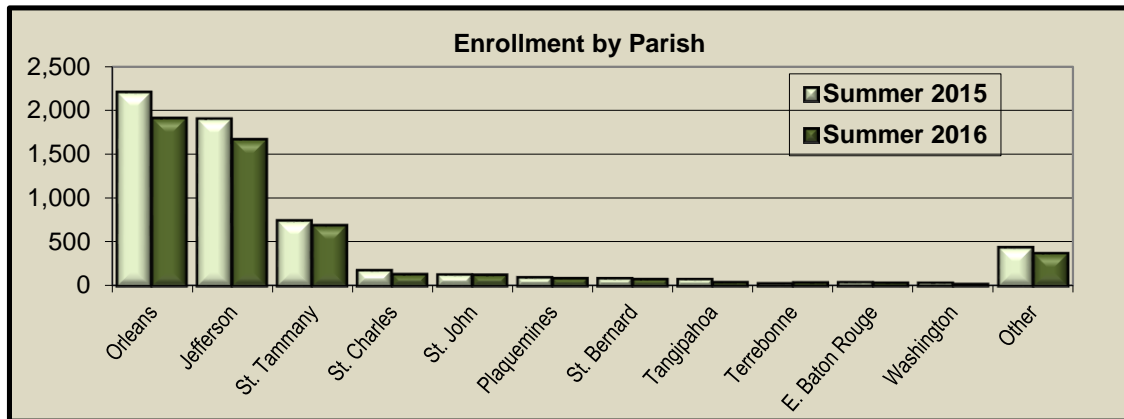
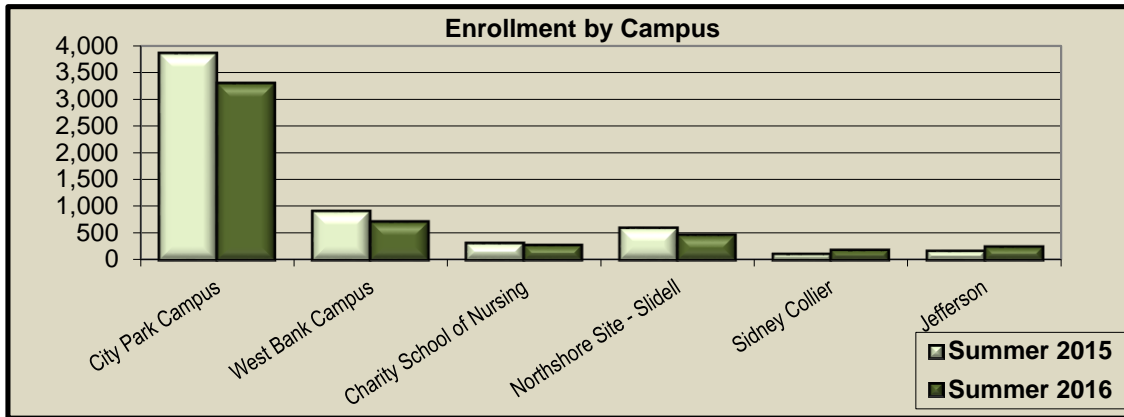

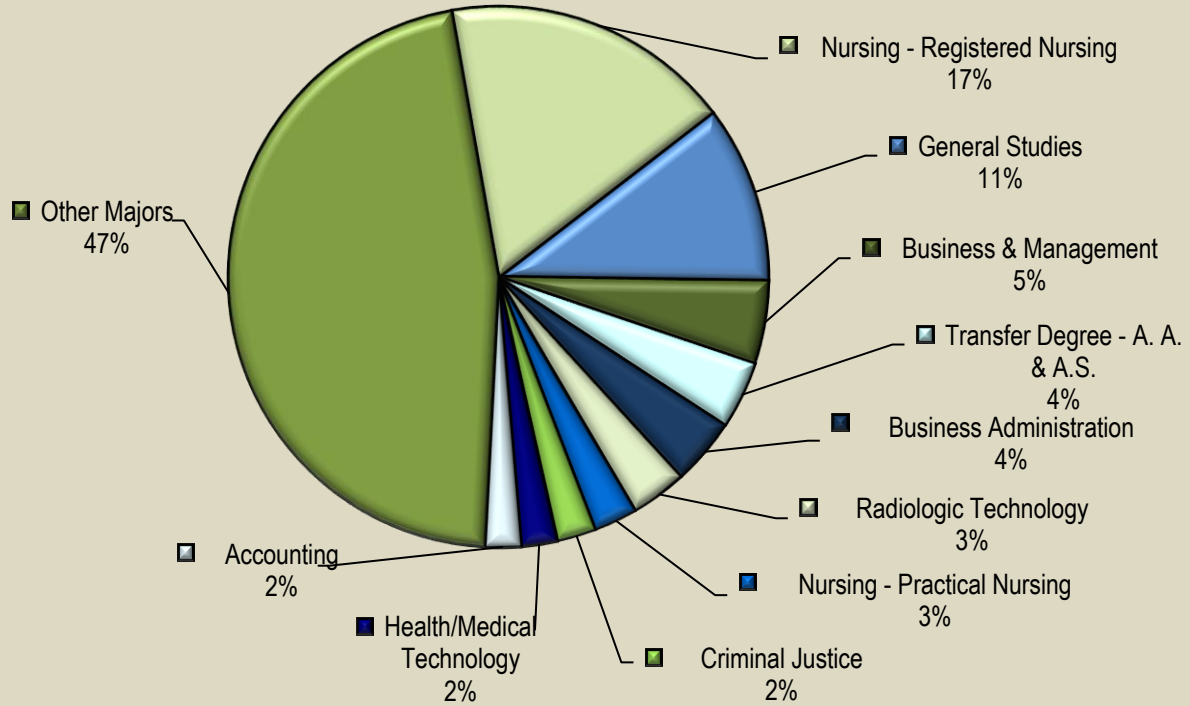
