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SUMMARY

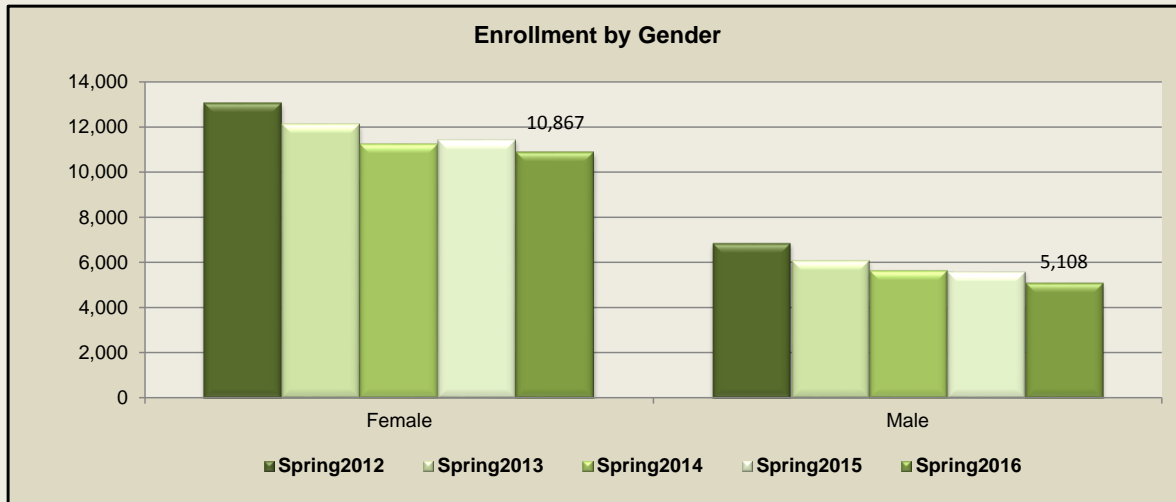
- ✓ Enrollment decreased 6.1% from Spring 2015 (17,016) to Spring 2016 (15,975).
- ✓ Male students decreased by 8.8% from Spring 2015; Female students decreased by 4.8%. Percentage of Female students is in a uptrend and Male is in a downtrend over the five years.
- ✓ Black Non-Hispanic enrollment decreased by 5.9% from Spring 2015.
- ✓ White Non-Hispanic enrollment decreased by 4.7%
- ✓ First-Time Freshmen decreased 16.3% from last spring, now make up 5.5%. Transfer and Exchange students increased 14.8% and 15.9% respectively from last spring.
- ✓ Percentage of Freshmen enrollment is in a downward trend over the five years.
- ✓ Percentage of Full-Time students is in a downtrend and Part-Time is in a uptrend over the five years. Full-Time students now make up 36.9%, Part-Time students make up 63.1% of our enrollment.
- ✓ Nursing, General Studies and Business & Management had the largest enrollment in Spring 2016.

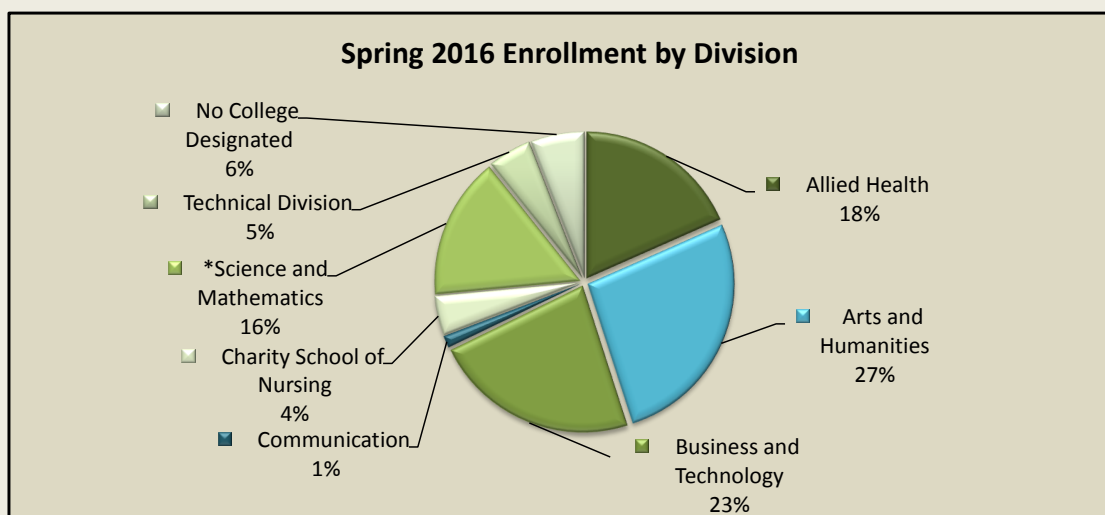
