# V. Curriculum Operations Report: Board of Regents for Louisiana Higher Education – Academic Program (Low Completer) Review – Tim Stamm

- a) Summary: The Board of Regents reviewed, state-wide, 205 Instructional Programs as part of the Academic (Low Completer) Program Review. Of these:
  - i. 152 programs were Continued, with enrollment/completer reports due upon staff request
  - ii. 49 programs were Terminated, effective May, 2017
  - iii. 14 programs were Revised, with cancelations inherent in some of the revisions
  - iv. 2 new programs were created, as a result of program restructuring
  - v. Program Review will be <u>repeated</u> in the 2018-2019 Academic Year
- b) Delgado Impact: 4 instructional programs were selected for review; 3 maintained, with one termination:
  - i. Associate of Arts in American Sign Language Maintained, basic reporting required in one year
  - ii. Associate of Applied Science in Health Information Technology –
     Maintained, reporting required in one year
  - iii. Associate of Applied Science in Medical Laboratory Technology –
     Maintained, second time on Low Completer Review, reporting required each semester
  - iv. Associate of Applied Science in Dietetics Technology Terminated;
     multiple times on Low Completer Review
