The Department of Business Administration of the University of Holy Cross (UHC) and the Business and Technology Division of Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that established a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students that complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's Business Administration Associate Degree to transfer and leads to a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Holy Cross

## **Delgado - UHC Agreement**

#### **Program**

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an associate degree in Business Administration will be admitted as juniors in the Business Administration Department of the University of Holy Cross (UHC), provided they meet UNC's admission requirements. Course requirements for Delgado's associate degree in Business Administration are described on page two of this document.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree in business administration from UHC is 120 semester hours and students can transfer up to 60 semester hours for degree credit from Delgado to UHC. This is a 2+2 program in which Delgado students will earn a bachelor's degree from UHC after successfully completing at least 60 additional semester hours in the Business Program at UHC and meeting all UHC degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the UHC Undergraduate Catalog in force at the time they enter Delgado provided it is not over 10 years old and provided there was no break in enrollment of over 5 years.

In order to graduate from UHC, students must complete at least 50% of business courses at UHC and achieve a quality point ratio of 2.5 or better in all work attempted, all work taken at UHC, "C" in all business courses, and 2.5 or better in all course work.

- Students not completing the degree program at Delgado, regardless of the grades achieved in English or mathematics must validate that credit for the classes by passing the English and Math Proficiency Examinations. The exam must be passed prior to registration for classes at UHC so that the student can be properly placed.
- Sciences –UHC's General Degree Requirements include 9 hours of science, including 4
  hours of biology lecture and lab and 5 hours of another natural science. If the student
  completes the associate degree program for business at Delgado, the lab requirement
  will be waived. If the program is not completed, all requirements for science at UHC
  revert back to the original requirement.
