AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BADM), COLLEGE OF BUSINESS & PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY AT NEW ORLEANS (SUNO)



AND

BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY DIVISION, DELGADO COMMUNITY COLLEGE



The College of Business and Public Administration (CBA), Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) and the Business and Technology Division, Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students that complete the courses prescribed in **Delgado's Business Administration Associate Degree program to transfer to a Bachelor of Science degree program in Business Administration (BADM) at SUNO.**

Delgado 2+2 SUNO Agreement

Program

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an associate degree in Business Administration will be admitted with junior standing to the CBA, provided they meet all SUNO admission requirements.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree in business administration at SUNO is 120 semester credit hours. Delgado students can transfer up to 60 semester credit hours based on the courses listed on this agreement to SUNO. This 2+2 agreement allows Delgado students to earn a bachelor's degree from SUNO after successfully completing the 60 additional semester credit hours in the BS-BADM curriculum and meeting all SUNO degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the SUNO Undergraduate Catalog in force at the time they entered Delgado, provided the transfer courses are not over 10 years old, and provided there was no breaks in student enrollment at Delgado of over 5 years.

Prerequisites

Some courses in this program may require prerequisites. See the Delgado and SUNO catalogs for specific information.

Reverse Transfer

Reverse Transfer is the process by which former Delgado students enrolled at SUNO transfer credits back to Delgado for the purpose of attaining a degree, diploma, or certification at Delgado. SUNO will forward Delgado a list of students who have earned a minimum of 66 combined hours from SUNO and Delgado with at least 18 or more of the earned hours at Delgado, along with transcripts. Delgado will then evaluate this coursework to determine if degree, diploma, or certification requirements are met.
