



Articulation Agreement Between The College of Business at Southeastern Louisiana University And Delgado Community College

Purpose

Southeastern Louisiana University (Southeastern) and Delgado Community College (DCC) have entered into this articulation agreement establishing a transferable pathway for DCC students to become eligible for direct admission into Southeastern. This agreement provides students with a transparent and systematic outline for successfully completing a baccalaureate degree from Southeastern in Accounting, Business Administration, Finance, Management, Marketing, or Supply Chain Management and an associate degree and/or Certificate of Completion from DCC. The institutions will partner to facilitate student access through a seamless and concurrent blend of curricula. Should students not complete an associate degree or Certificate of Completion at DCC, completed courses will articulate to Southeastern as indicated in this agreement.

Program

Delgado Community College students who have completed an associate degree in Business Administration will be admitted as juniors at Southeastern. The total number of credit hours required to complete a baccalaureate degree in a business field at Southeastern is 120. A DCC student who successfully transfers to Southeastern will earn a baccalaureate degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Finance, Management, Marketing, or Supply Chain Management upon successfully completing the additional required course work at Southeastern and meeting all college and university degree requirements.

DCC students will follow the requirements in the Southeastern General Catalogue at the time they enroll at DCC provided it is not older than academic year 2017-2018 and provided there

was no break in enrollment for one regular semester (fall or spring) at DCC not including summer sessions. This will become the student's Southeastern catalogue of record.

In order to graduate from Southeastern, students must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all course work, on all work attempted at Southeastern and on all courses in the major, and meet all university requirements.

Enrollment Management

DCC and Southeastern mutually agree to review and approve together all student recruitment materials and events as defined in this agreement. DCC and Southeastern will participate in joint recruitment activities that include but are not limited to high school visits and presentations, community outreach events, and on-campus orientations.

Workforce Development

This articulation agreement between Southeastern and DCC will help to ensure that both institutions are being proactive in addressing challenges in the economy and resulting changes in the higher education landscape. In addition, the partnership ensures the participating institutions are responsive to relevant workforce needs of our local, state, and regional industry partners. As a result, DCC and Southeastern mutually agree to include a representative from both institutions for program advisory meetings, industry partnership meetings, economic development meetings, and chamber meetings when relevant to the articulation agreement.

Reverse Transfer

Reverse Transfer is the process by which former Delgado students enrolled at Southeastern transfer credits back to Delgado for the purpose of attaining a degree, diploma, or certification. Southeastern will forward Delgado a list of students who have earned a minimum of 66 combined hours from Southeastern and Delgado with at least 18 or more of the earned hours at Delgado, along with transcripts. Delgado will then evaluate this coursework to determine if degree, diploma, or certification requirements have been met.

Note – To facilitate progression, DCC students who transfer to Southeastern before completing 60 hours or who did not pass the CLEP exams may be allowed to take Principles of Management or Principles of Marketing as second-semester sophomores.

^{**}Note: ACCT 211 will not count towards the Accounting degree. In addition, prospective Accounting majors must take PSYC 127 or SOCI 151 to satisfy a social/behavioral science requirement, PSYC 101 or SOC 101. SOCI 151, SOCI 155, SOCI 250, SOCI 255, PSYC 127, PSYC 226, or PSYC 245 will satisfy either PSYC/SOC elective or free elective for all business majors.

Program Evaluation

Once every two academic years, Southeastern faculty and staff will meet with DCC faculty and staff to review current curriculum and course offerings and present any changes to the curriculum outlines in this agreement prior to implementing the proposed changes. This meeting will include a review of articulation agreement students' performance in upper-level business courses relative to that of continuing Southeastern students. Both Southeastern and DCC will agree upon mutually approved strategies for future program growth and development.

Program renewal

This agreement will be renewed every three years from the date of signing and will be continued, modified, or terminated upon mutual agreement of the parties.
