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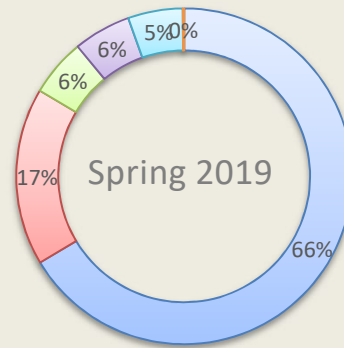
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SUMMARY

- ✓ Delgado's long-term downward trend in spring enrollment flattened this year, with enrollment falling just 0.1% from 13,596 to 13,576.
- ✓ The proportions of male and female students remained steady, with 68% of students being female.
- ✓ White enrollment reached a long-term low of 29% as Hispanic enrollment peaked at over 10%.
- ✓ An 18% increase in preparatory students powers the historically high 31% of students under 21.
- ✓ Full-time students dropped to a long-term low of 33%, driving an 0.9% decrease in credit hours attempted.
- ✓ Students taking only face-to-face classes declined by three percentage points from Spring 2018. Online-only students increased by 2%, reaching an all-time high of 15.7%.
- ✓ Nursing (16.3%), General Studies (9.3%), and Business & Management (5.2%) have the largest enrollment of all programs of study in Spring 2019.

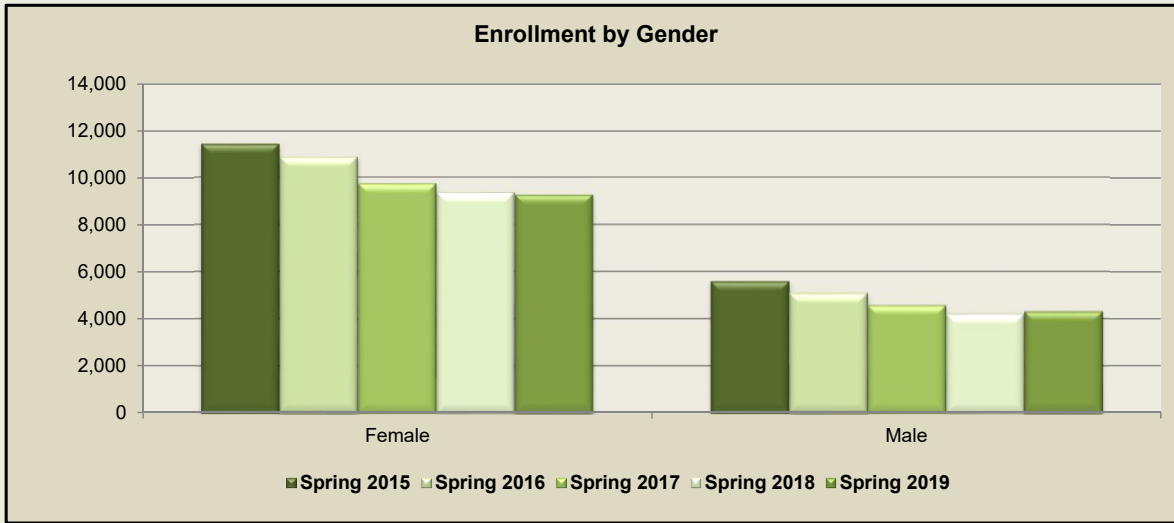

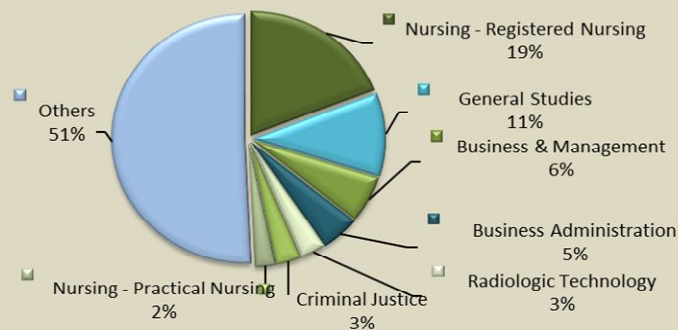

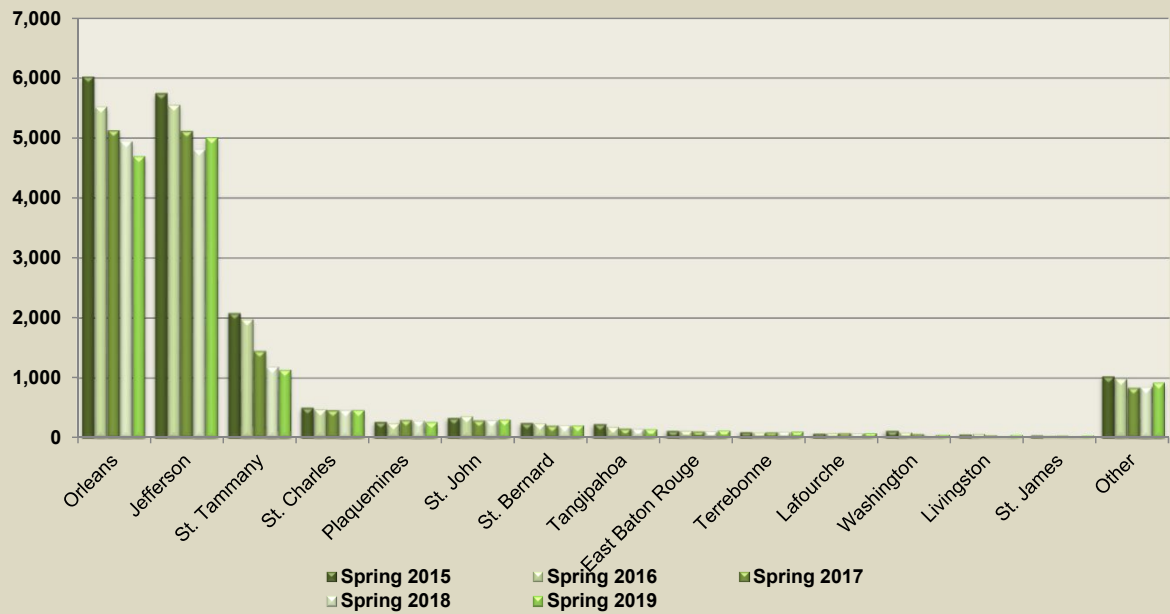
Spring 2019 Top 7 Majors/Programs
