

**Memorandum of Understanding
An Articulation Agreement Between**

**Delgado Community College
School of Nursing**

AND

**SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY
School of Nursing**

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) serves as an articulation agreement between Delgado Community College (Delgado) and Southeastern Louisiana University (Southeastern), to provide a seamless transfer for students desiring to earn a bachelor's degree in Nursing (BSN) upon completion of their associate's degree in nursing (ADN) at Delgado, successful passing of the NCLEX Exam, and obtaining their Louisiana RN License.

Delgado students who receive their ADN and who declare their intent to pursue the Bachelor of Science in Nursing in Southeastern's School of Nursing upon receiving their Louisiana RN license will be:

1. Admitted to Southeastern as a junior. Formal admission to Southeastern must occur within five years of the intent to participate and is reliant on the successful completion of an Associate of Science Degree in Nursing (ADN) at Delgado.
2. Assigned a faculty advisor in the School of Nursing at Southeastern for assistance with their progression in the RN to BSN Program. In addition, files will be kept by Southeastern on these students and their progression tracked.
3. Positioned to maximize credit transferability by pursuing a pre-approved program of study.
4. Maintenance of a catalogue of record is contingent on a student completing the Delgado ADN entering Southeastern within five years of his/her declaration to participate in the program. A period of non-enrollment exceeding two semesters, including summer, will result in using the most current catalogue.

Southeastern Louisiana University will:

1. Make curriculum information sheets available to Delgado for the RN to BSN Program in Nursing.
2. Develop, in conjunction with Delgado, an "Intent to Participate" form to expedite program progression.

3. Encourage program participants to progress in the BSN program in a timely manner.
4. Provide advisors to program participants. Advisors will be available through phone and on-line consultation, as well as through on-site appointments.
5. Collaborate with Delgado and involve students in professional Nursing organizations such as the National Student Nurses Association.

Delgado will:

1. Maintain files related to the progression of students in this program.
2. Encourage students to pursue their BSN at Southeastern and progress in a timely manner.
3. Provide Southeastern with participating students' transcripts (student approval required upon enrollment) each semester to facilitate the timely recording of student data at Southeastern and allow for timely advising.
4. Develop, with Southeastern representatives, and "Intent to Participate" form that will allow for easy record transferability and data sharing that is in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
5. Meet periodically with Southeastern representatives to assess program progress.
6. Communicate degree program changes to Southeastern in a timely manner.
7. Promote the program in the Delgado service area.
8. Delgado accepts the commitment to help Southeastern with Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) accreditation issues and concerns as they arise relating to the Nursing RN to BSN Program.



Southeastern Louisiana University and Delgado Community College enter into this agreement in a joint effort to promote degree program progression and easy transferability between two and four-year degree programs in Nursing.



This agreement is effective upon signing. Either party may terminate the agreement through a written notice to the other party 90 days prior to the date of termination. Should the agreement be discontinued, students who declared their intent to participate will be allowed to progress through the program and complete it within three years.

Both parties will meet to periodically assess the program for effectiveness and impact and share the outcome of that assessment for planning purposes.

Changes to this agreement may be made at any time in writing with a 60 day notice, with the express agreement of the chief academic officers of each campus.

An attachment indicating current Associate of Science Degree in Nursing at Delgado and the transferability of that degree's credits to a bachelor's degree in Nursing at Southeastern Louisiana University is attached and made a part of this agreement.
