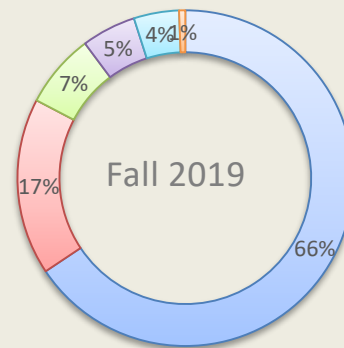

SUMMARY

- ✓ The COVID-19 pandemic drove Delgado's fall enrollment down 6.4%, from 14,140 to a ten-year low of 13,262.
- ✓ The proportion of male students fell disproportionately; female students reached an all-time high of 71.2%.
- ✓ Native American, Black, and foreign students fell in number in proportion to the rest of the student body.
- ✓ Average age reached a longtime high of 28.1 amidst a drop in preparatory students and students under 22.
- ✓ Full-time enrollment recovered somewhat to 36% of all students; the average student took 9.3 credit hours.
- ✓ In response to the pandemic, Delgado's students moved online. 71% of students took at least one online course, and 30% of students took only online courses.
- ✓ Nursing (21.3%), General Studies (9.7%) and Business & Management (6.6%) have the largest Programs of Study enrollment in Fall 2020.

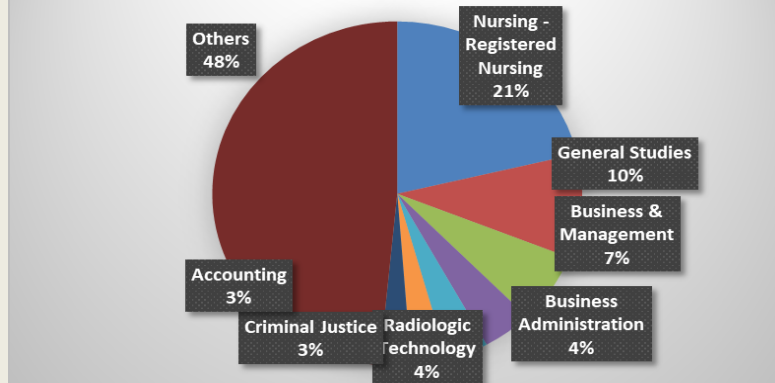

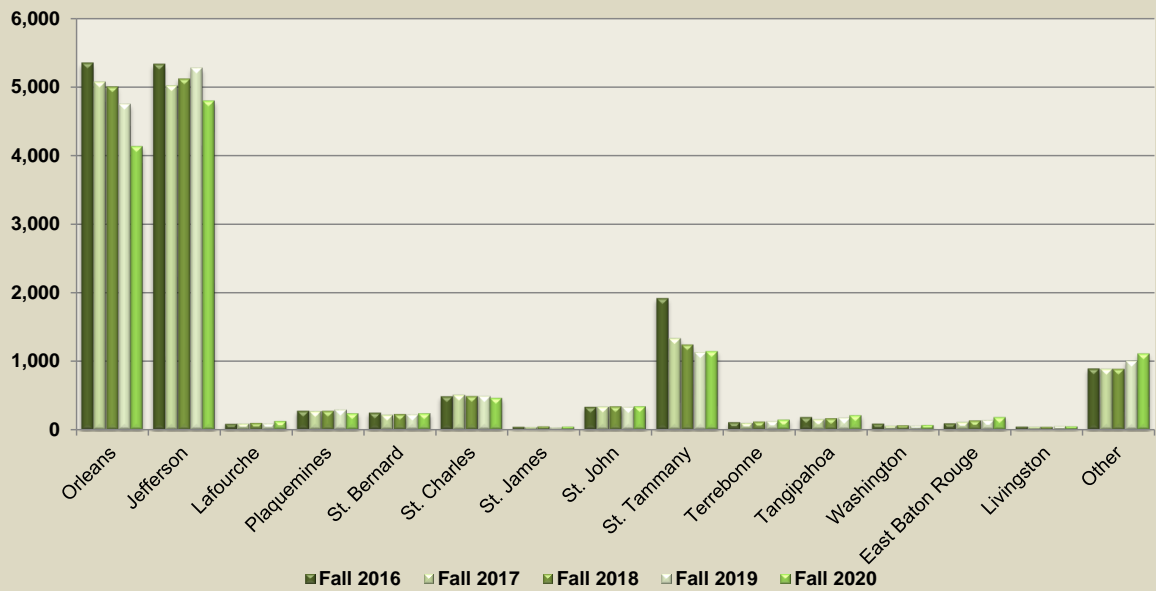
