Memorandum of Understanding

BETWEEN

AND

THE BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY DIVISION
OF DELGADO COMMUNITY COLLEGE (DELGADO)

By this memorandum, the College of Business of Louisiana State University at Alexandria (LSUA) and the Business and Technology Division of Delgado Community College (Delgado) agree to establish a 2+2 program that will allow students to transfer the 60 hours of coursework required by Delgado's Associate of Science in Business Administration to LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and to earn the 60 additional hours of coursework required for completion of the bachelor's degree.

Agreement Outline

Students who have earned an Associate of Science in Business Administration from Delgado Community College and who meet LSUA's admission requirements will be admitted to LSUA and be enrolled in the College of Business's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

The 60 credit hours that Delgado students earn to meet the requirements of the Associate of Science in Business Administration will be accepted by LSUA and entered on their LSUA transcripts.

To ensure, however, that all 60 credit hours can be applied specifically to LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Delgado students who intend to transfer to LSUA should follow the curriculum guide provided as an appendix to this document.

The guide specifies that Delgado students should

- 1) take MATH 130 (College Algebra) and MATH 203 (Introductory Statistics) to meet the General Education Mathematics requirement of the Associate of Science in Business Administration;
- 2) take ACCT 211 (Managerial Accounting) as one of the approved electives required by the Associate of Science in Business Administration;
- 3) take courses from the listings provided in the curriculum guide to meet the Humanities, Natural Science, and Fine Arts General Education requirements of the Associate of Science in Business Administration.

Students who follow the above recommendations; and who complete the curriculum of Delgado's Associate of Science in Business Administration; and who complete the remaining 60 hours required by LSUA's baccalaureate program; and who meet all other baccalaureate degree requirements specified in the LSUA Catalog, including the attainment of an overall GPA of 2.0 and a grade of "C" or higher in all major courses, will be eligible to receive LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

Delgado students will follow the requirements of the LSUA Catalog in force at the time they enter Delgado provided the catalog is not earlier than the 2019-2020 catalog and provided students do not interrupt their enrollment at Delgado.

If the requirements for either degree program, Delgado's Associate of Science in Business Administration or LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, change, the institution that has made the change will notify the other institution so that the curriculum guide for the two+two program can be modified accordingly.

Some courses required by both Delgado's Associate of Science in Business Administration and LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration may require prerequisites. Students should consult the Delgado and LSUA catalogs for specific information.
