SUMMER SESSION 2021

On Monday, June 21, 2021, employees will return to campus and cease all remote work schedules. Faculty working during the Summer Session and all staff are expected to follow the in-person hours of 7:30 a.m. - 6 p.m., Monday - Thursday through July 29, 2021. Any deviation from the summer work schedule must be pre-arranged with your supervisor and documented in writing within your department in the event of an audit.

FALL SEMESTER 2021

The College will resume the regular in-person Monday through Friday schedule of 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. on Monday, August 2, 2021.

Faculty members with 9-month appointments should plan to return to their in-person work schedules on Monday, August 9, 2021.

We will maintain the same level of cleaning and disinfecting protocols to ensure the safety of our students, employees, and visitors. Based on current federal, state, and local guidance, temperature checks for visitors will be discontinued.

We all have a responsibility to keep ourselves and others safe. While on campus, all students, employees, and visitors should do the following:

- Continue to wear a mask.
- Continue to use the Delgado Pre-Screening app or handy QR Codes daily to gain clearance before arriving at your workplace on campus.
- Continue to maintain a 3-foot social distance from others at all times.
- Allow only two individuals in the elevator and restrooms at a time.
- Report directly to your work location and limit movement to other locations for work activities.
- As a courtesy, do not enter a co-worker's workspace without permission.
- Allow virtual options for all meeting participants.
- Practice good hygiene, including covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing, using hand sanitizer stations when entering common areas, and washing your hands multiple times a day.
