2 =	 -Proposal lacks vital descriptive information as to the application of the technology to the curriculum and for student use. Proposal contains little, if any, justification. -Proposal requests the STEP fund be used to support-totally-the curricular function or special project as opposed to augmenting or expanding. Author does not demonstrate a linkage with Strategic Initiatives. -Information (requisition, specifications, etc.) is lacking. Back-up documentation to support the requisition is not current and/or does not include detailed specifications. 	
3 =	 -Proposal is descriptive and informative; however, it lacks detailed information regarding maximum benefit/usage by/for students. -Proposal is well-organized but may not include information about impacts of space, IT infrastructure, electrical, security, and/or staffing. -Proposal does not indicate a long-range plan for upgrading and replacement.
