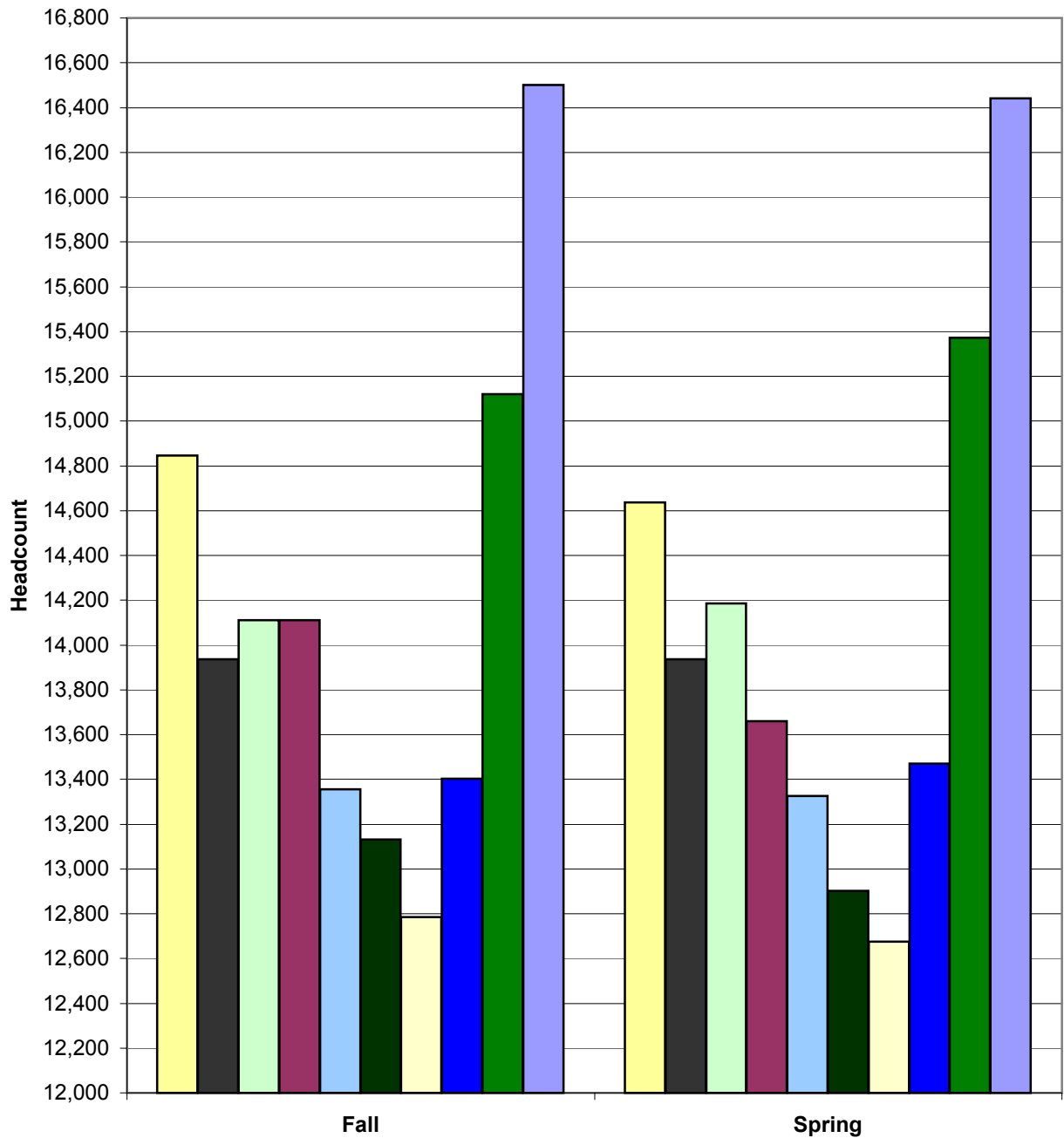

Ten Year Enrollment History

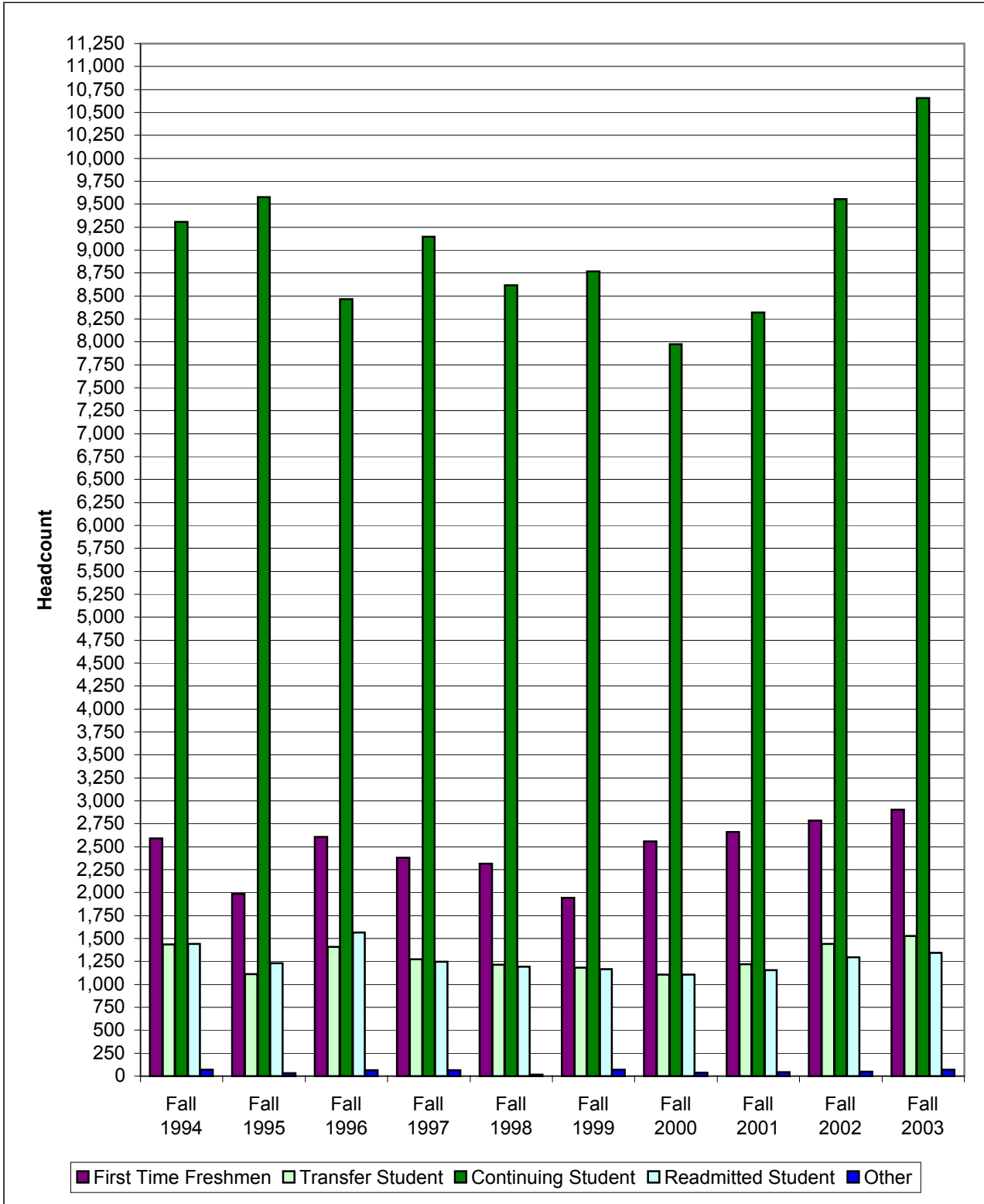

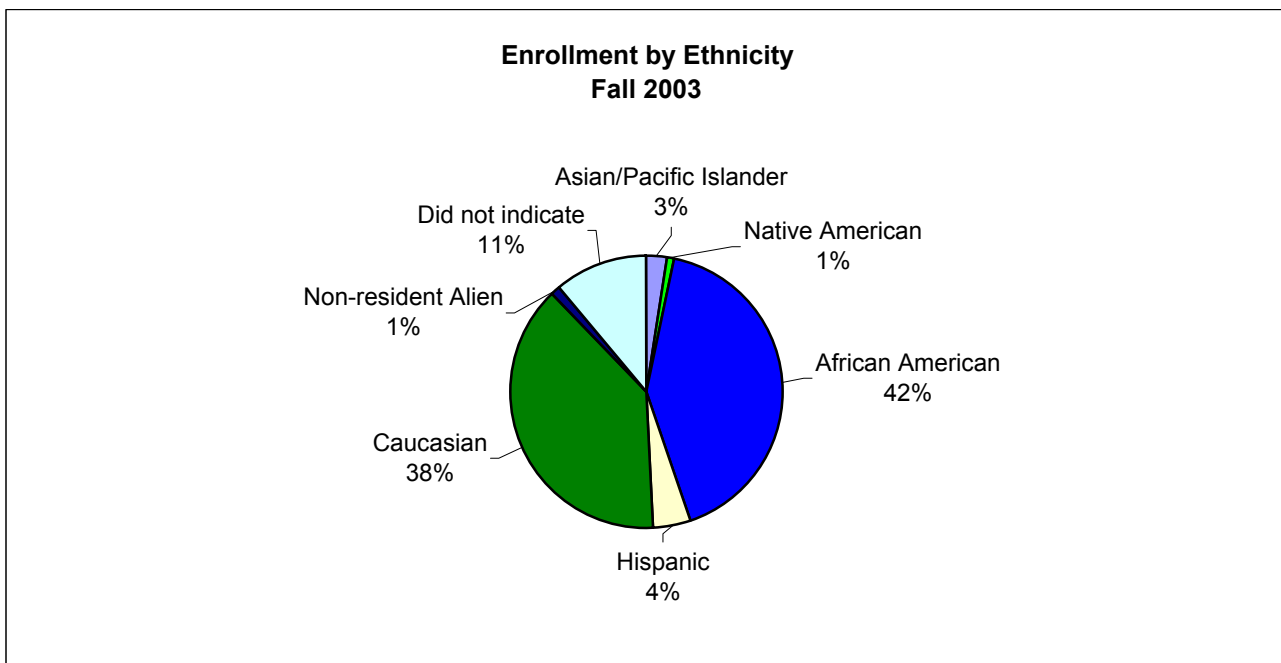
Enrollment by Gender

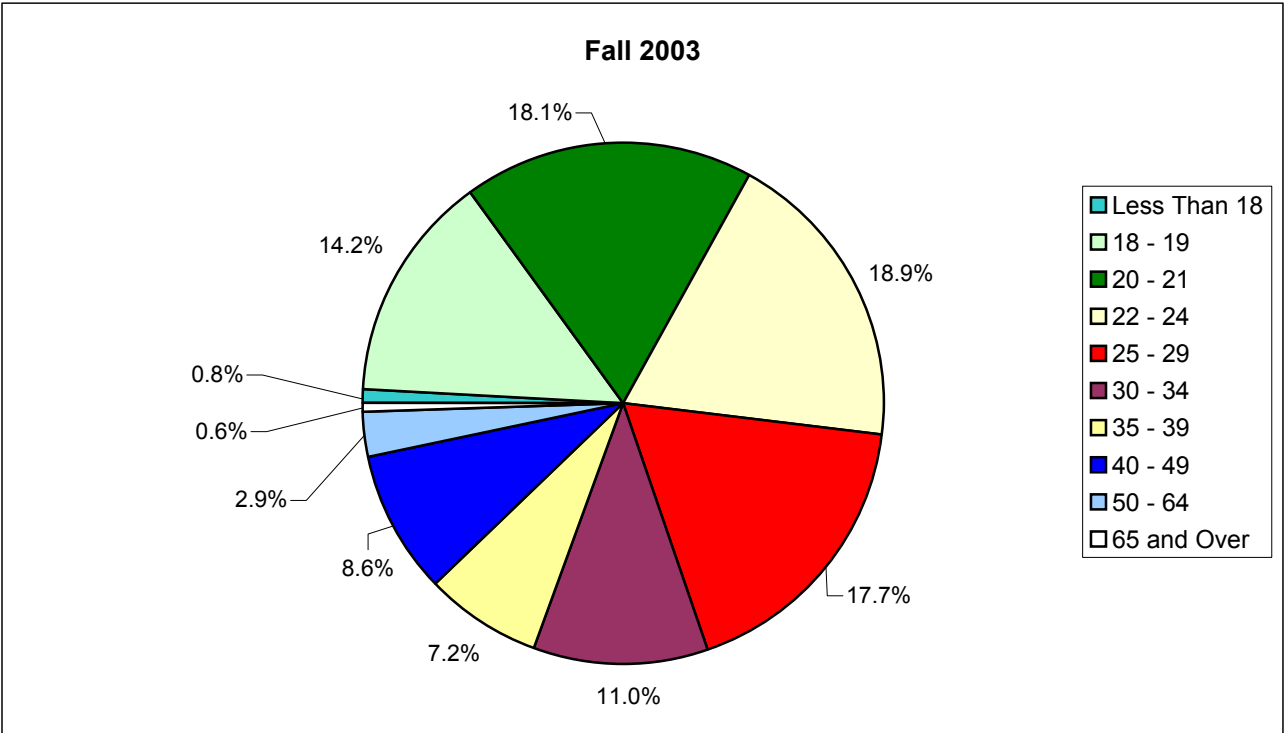
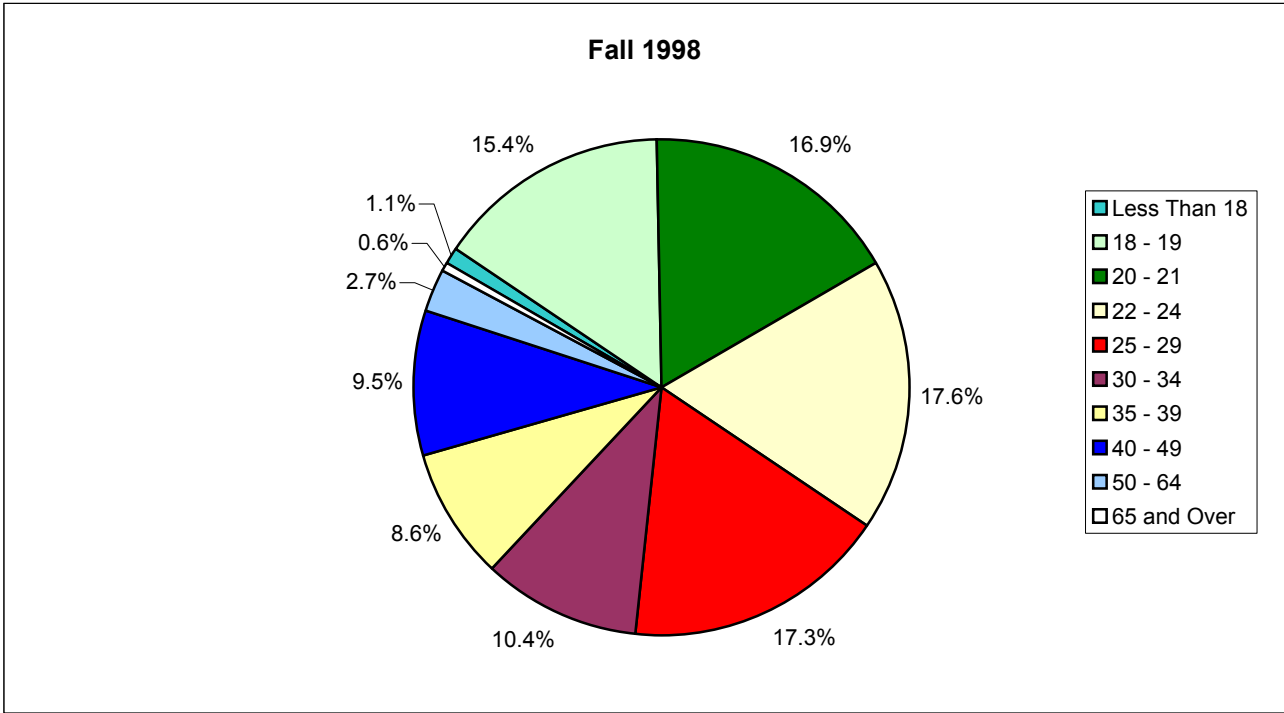

Enrollment by Age



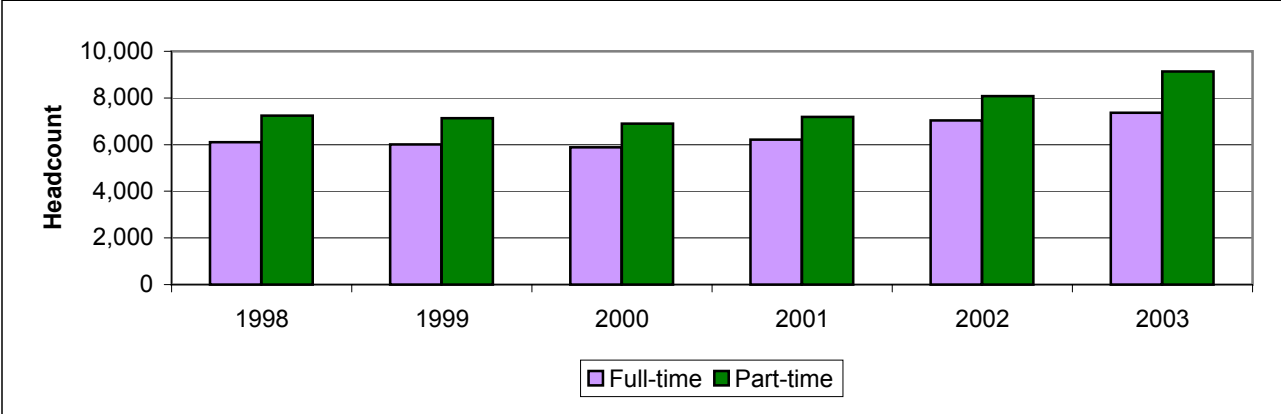

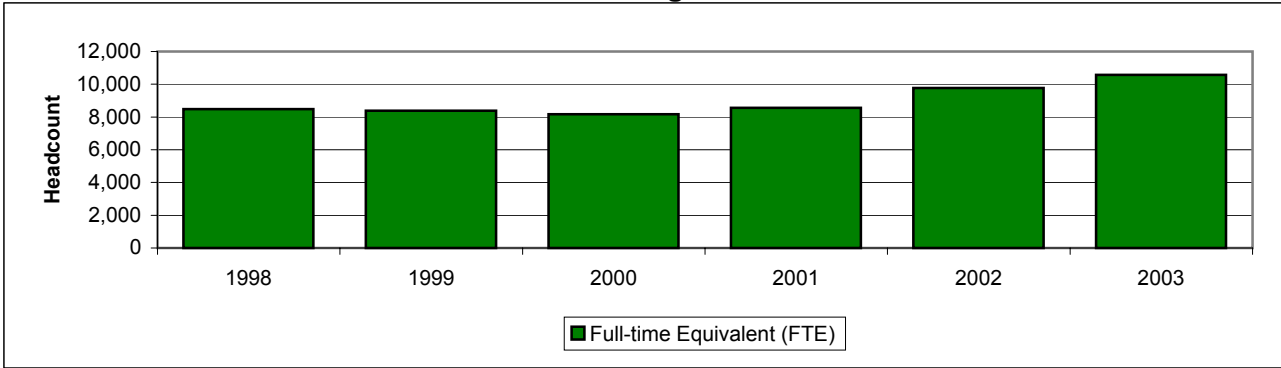

Fall 1998 through Fall 2003**

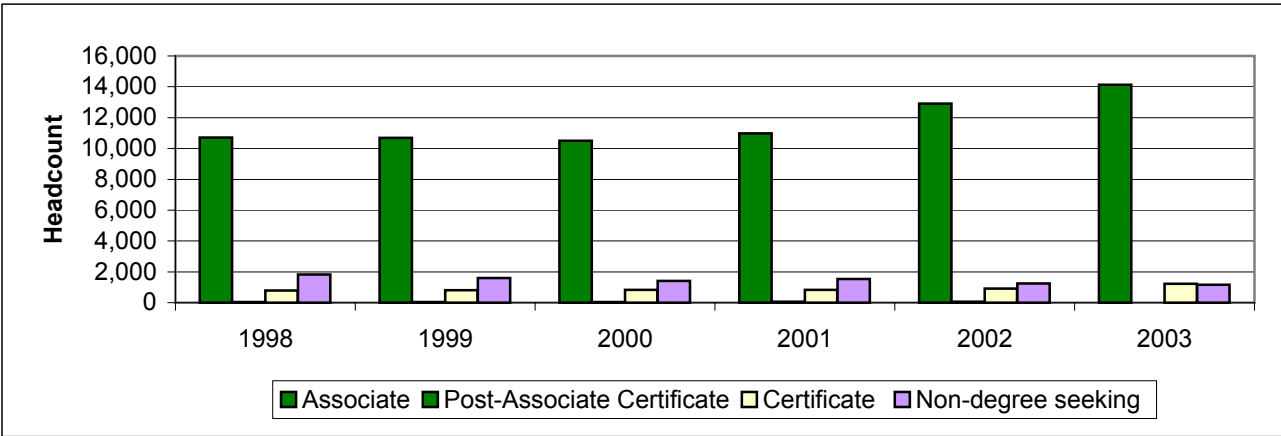


**Enrollment by Full-Time Equivalent (FTE*)

Enrollment by Admission Status and Classification

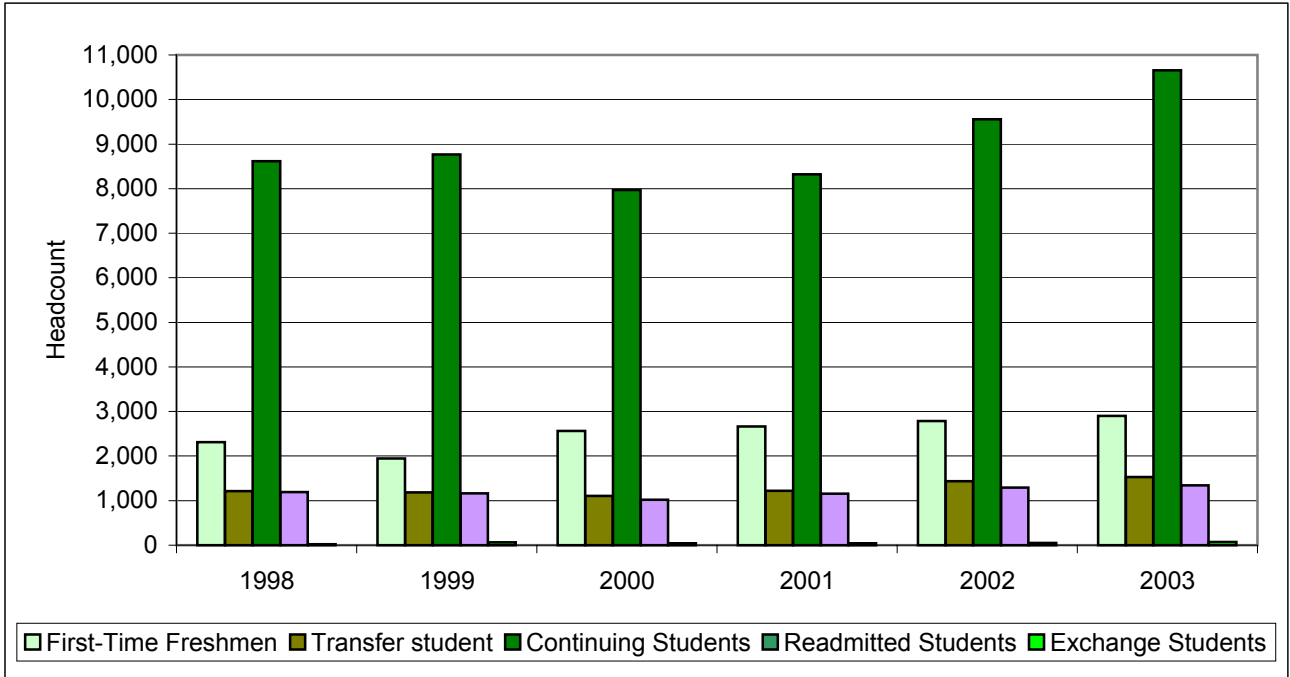

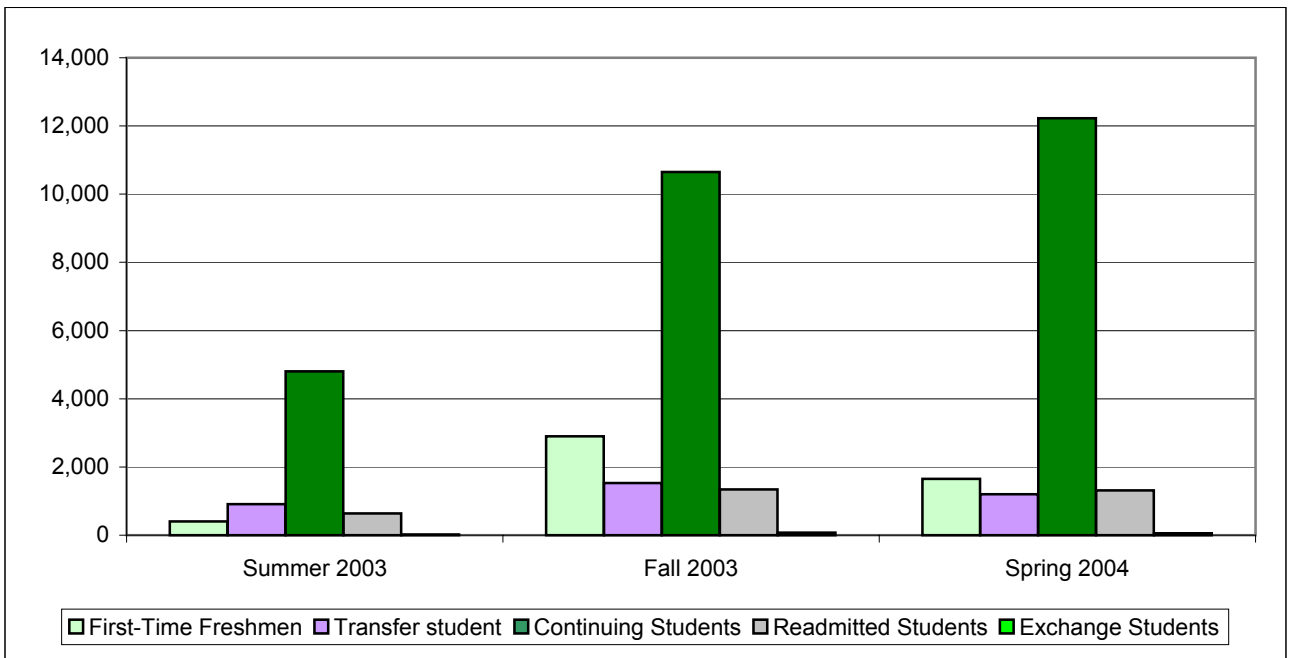

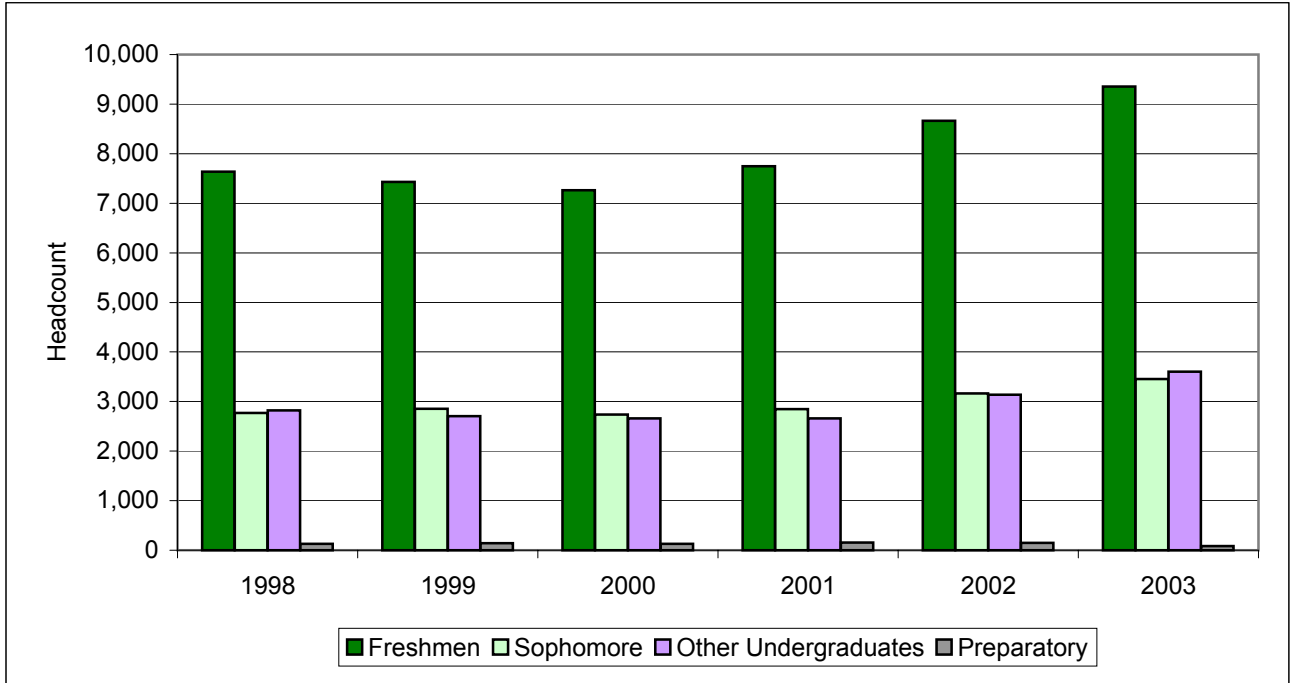
**Student Admission Status
Fall 1998 through Fall 2003**



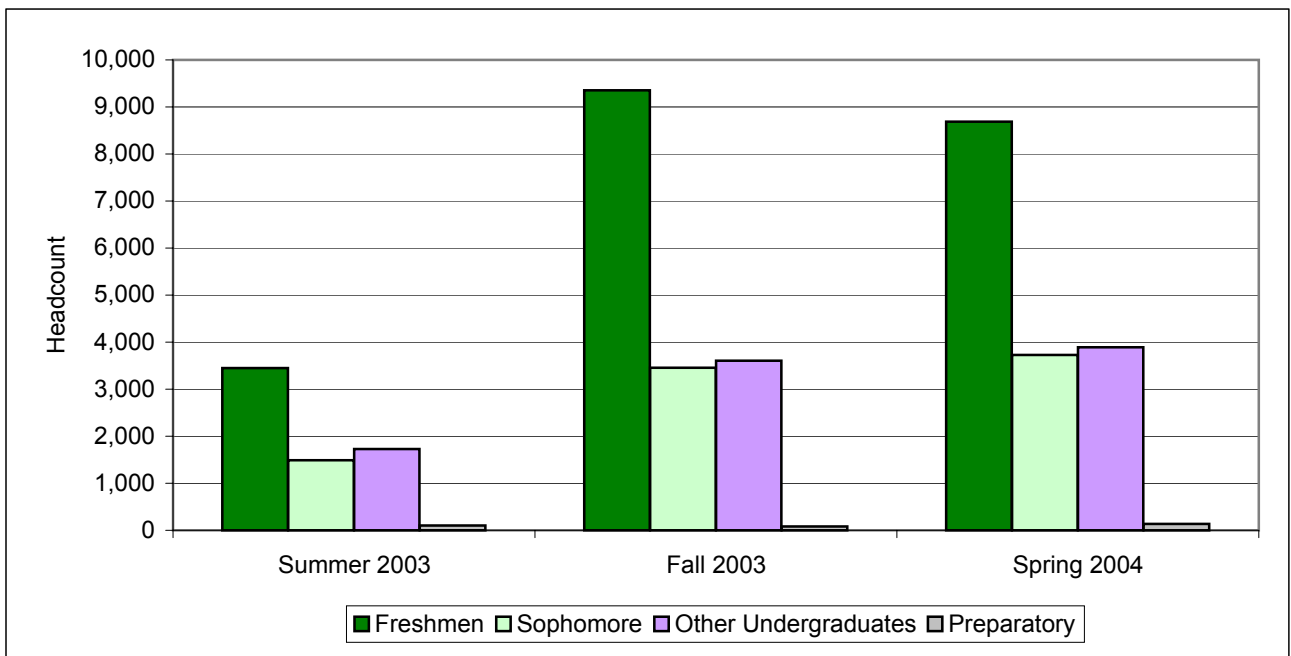
**Student Admission Status

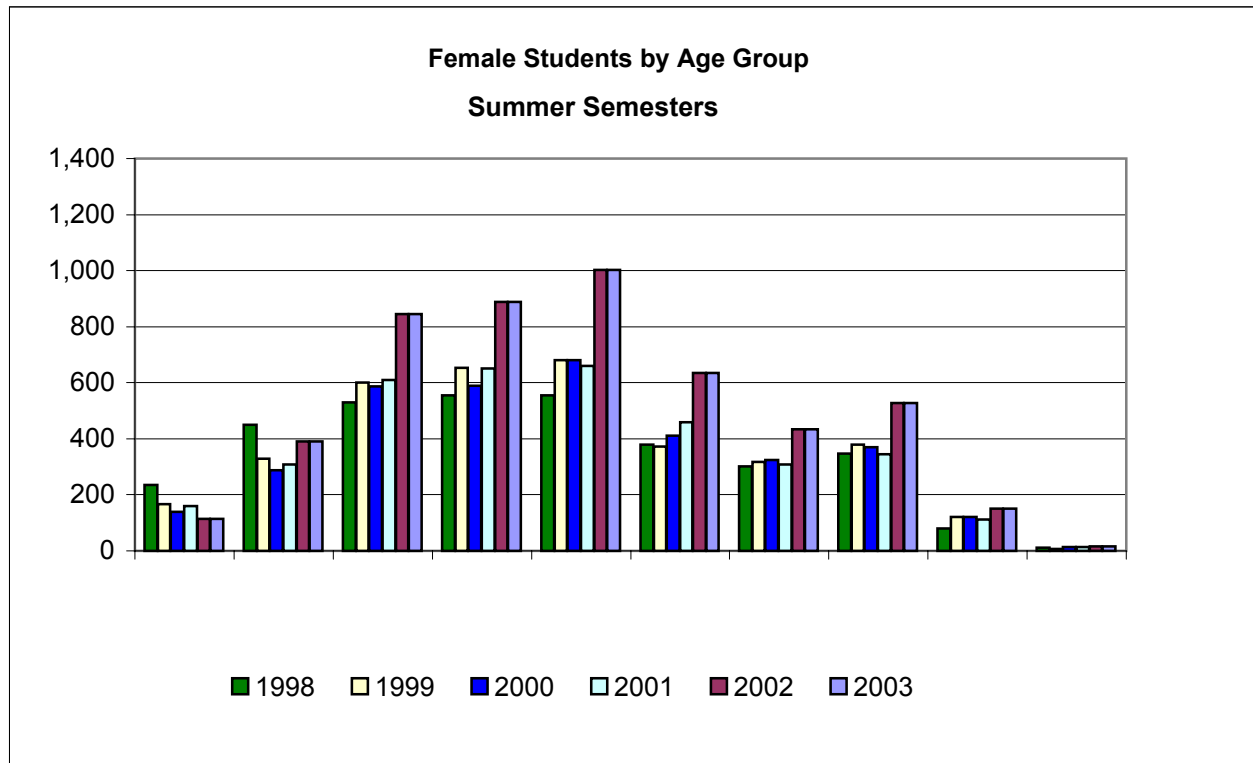
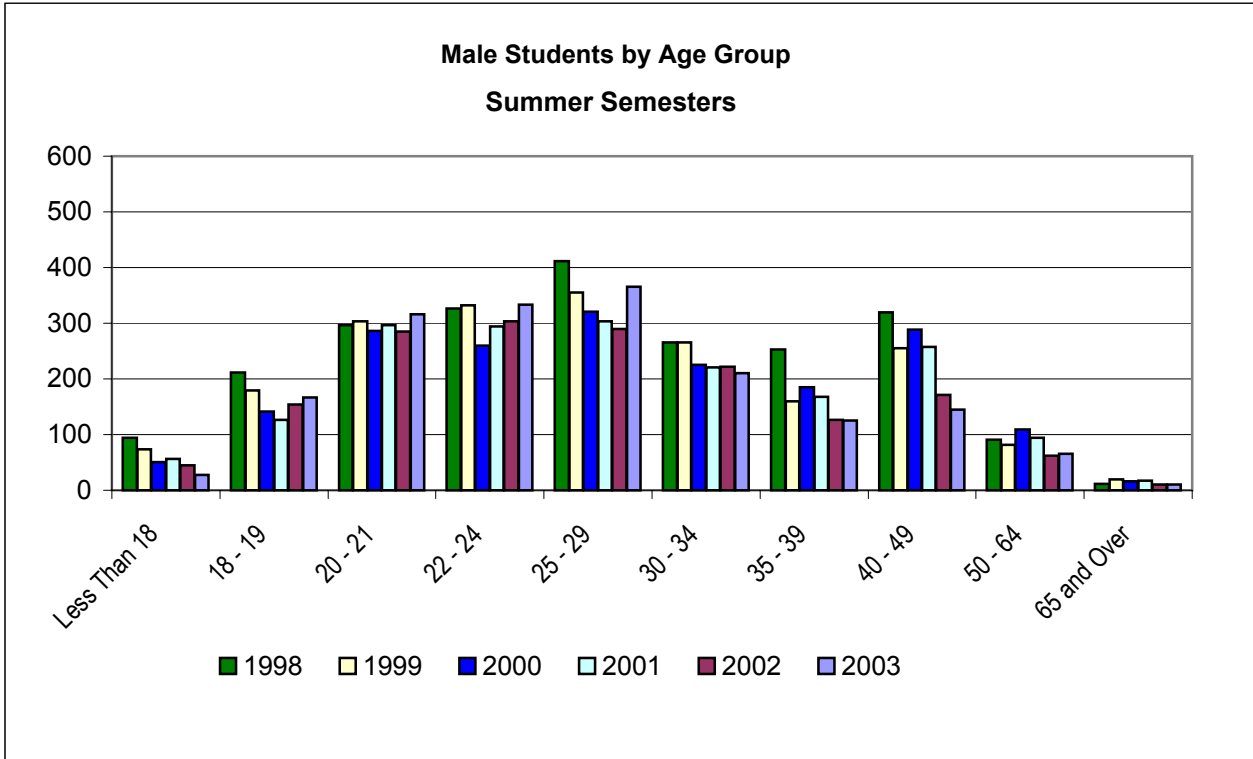
Student Age Groups by Gender

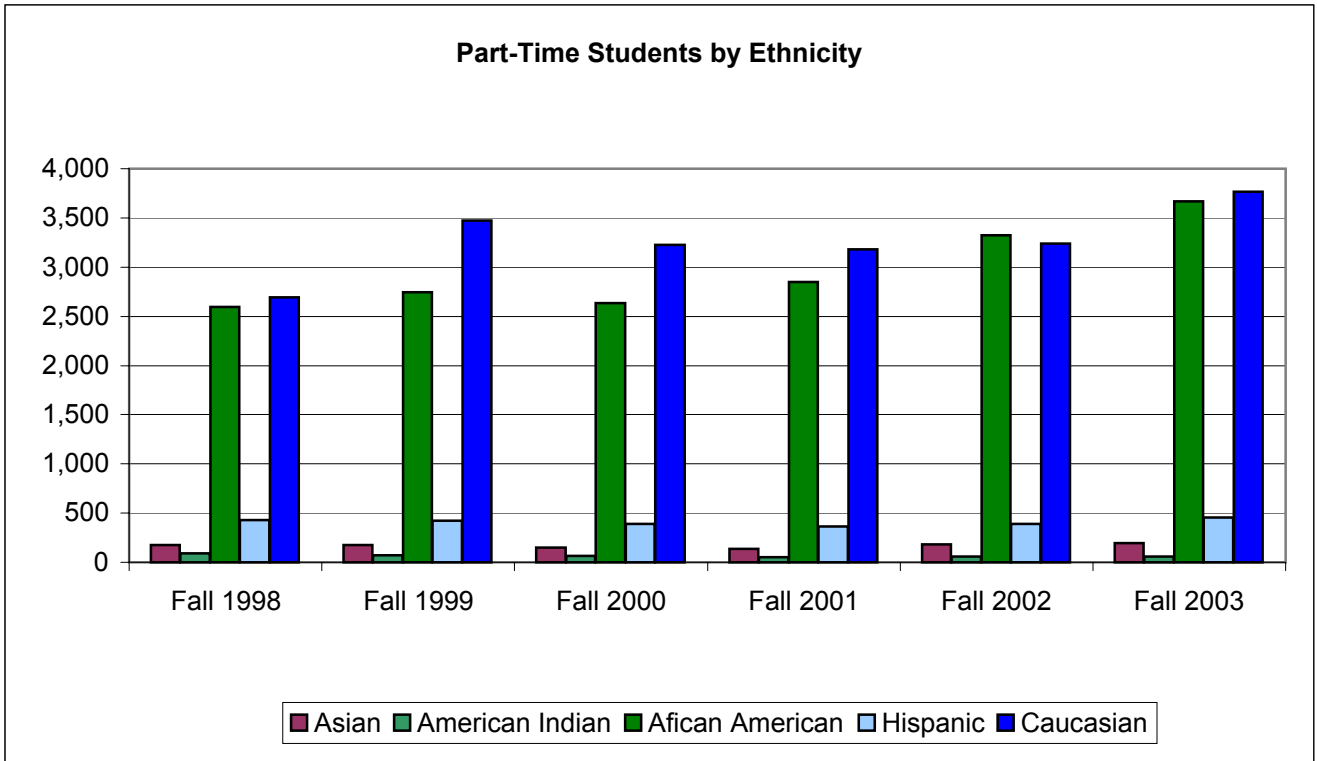
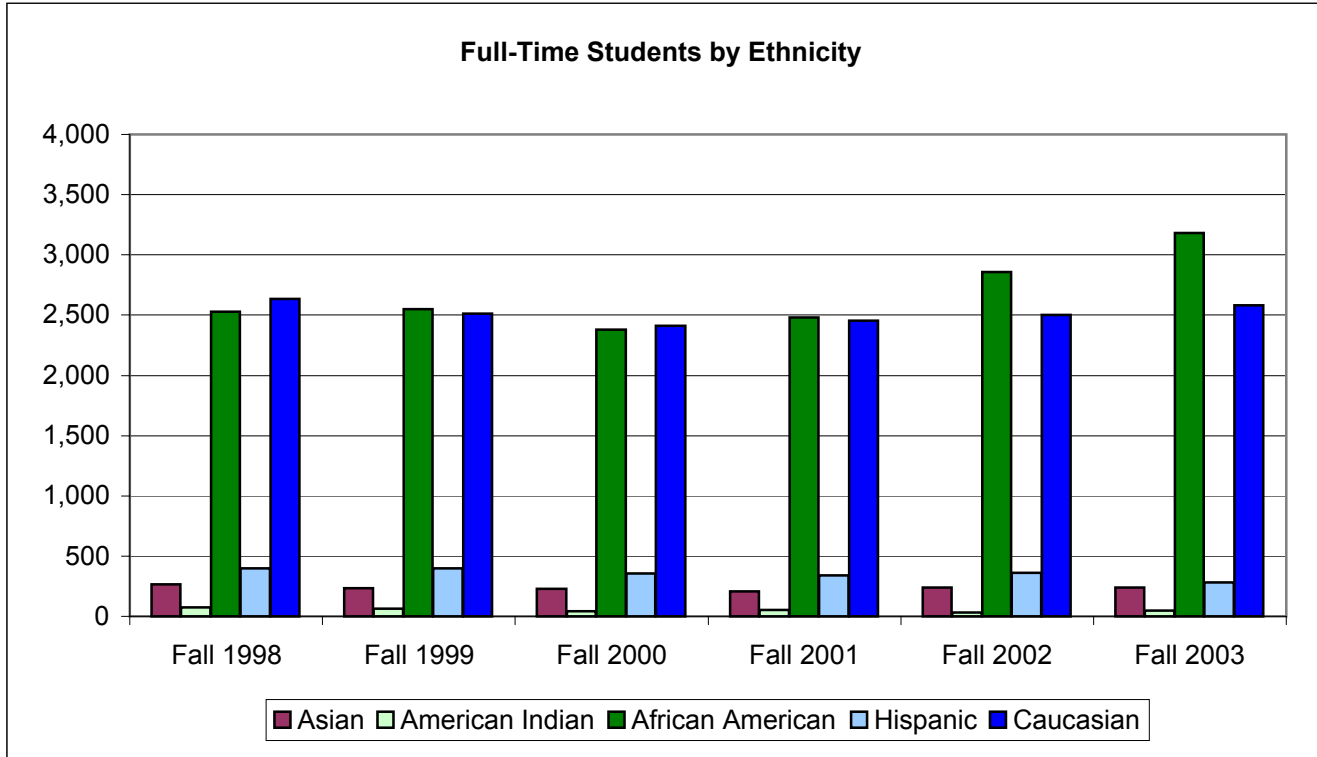
