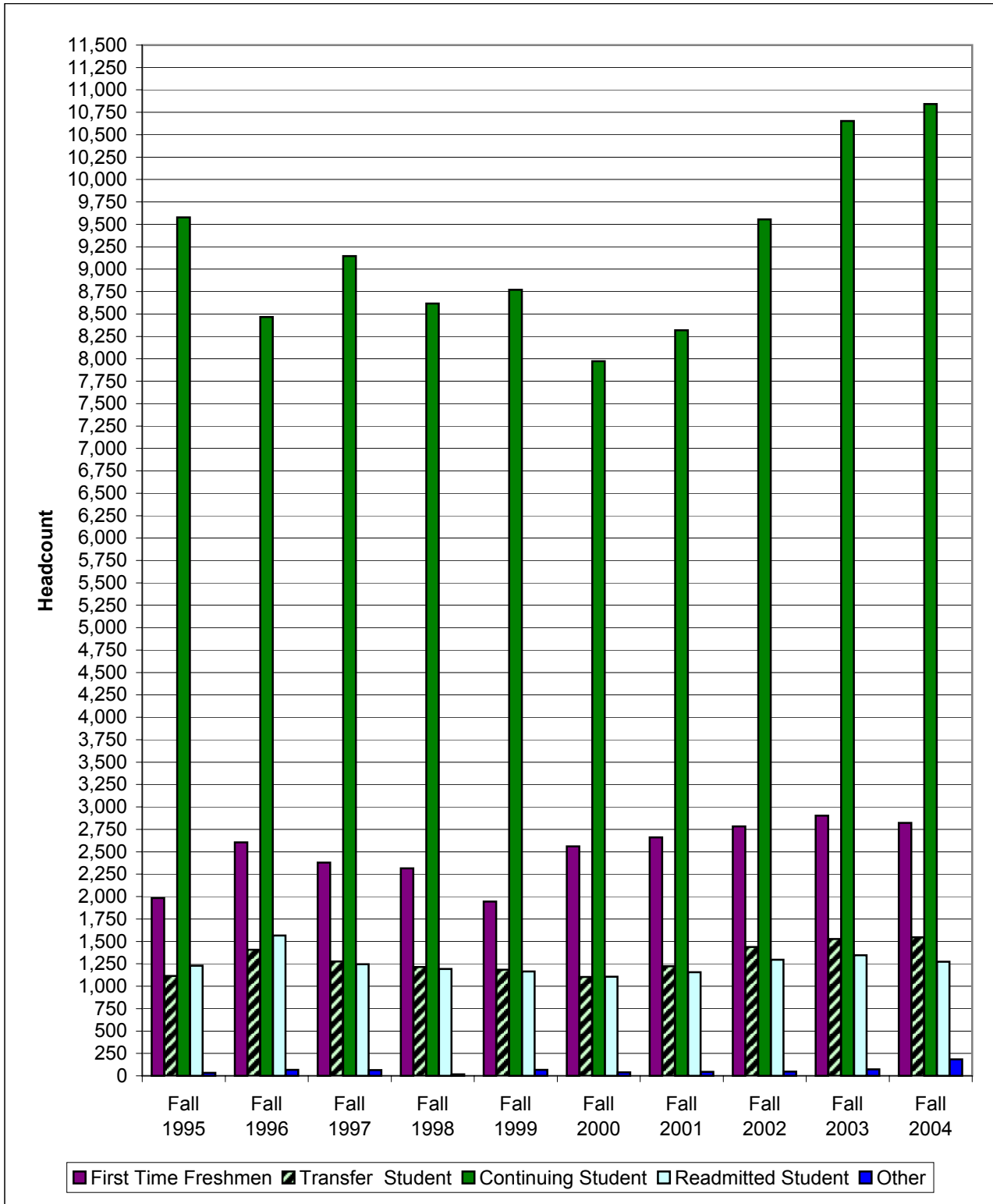

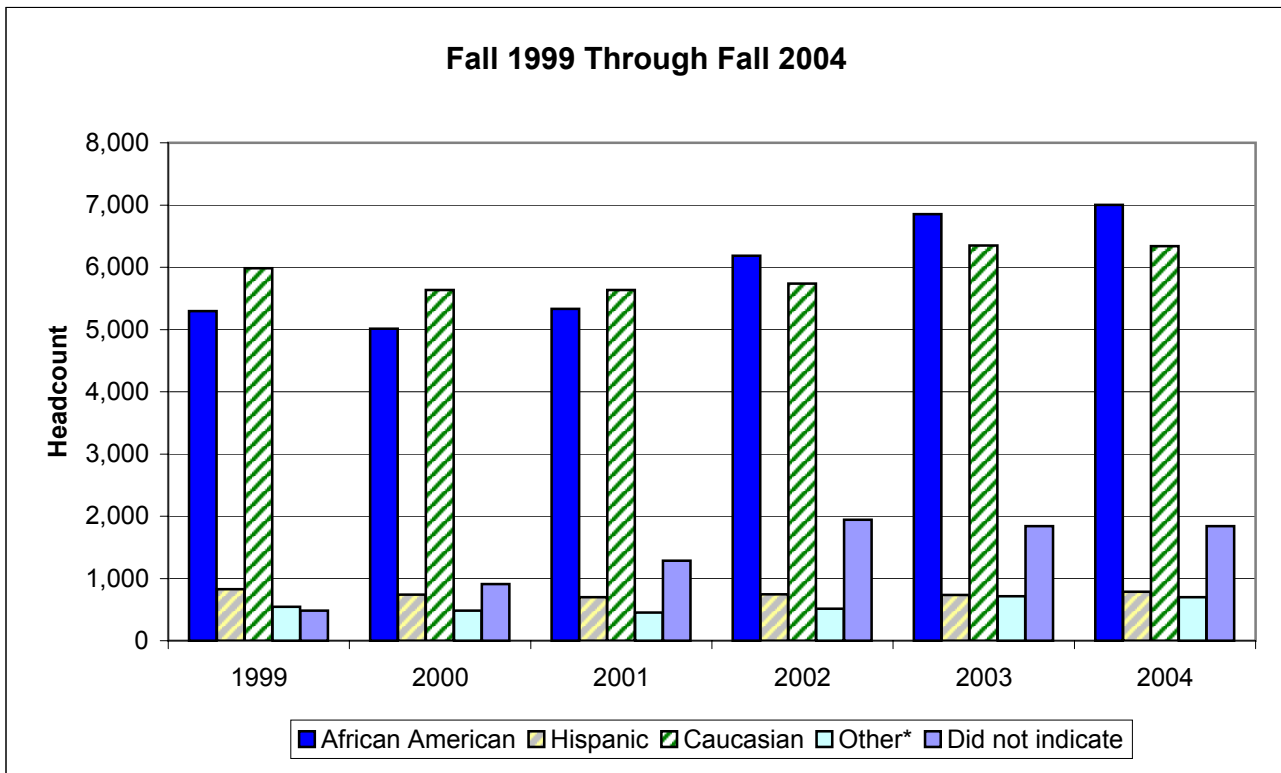

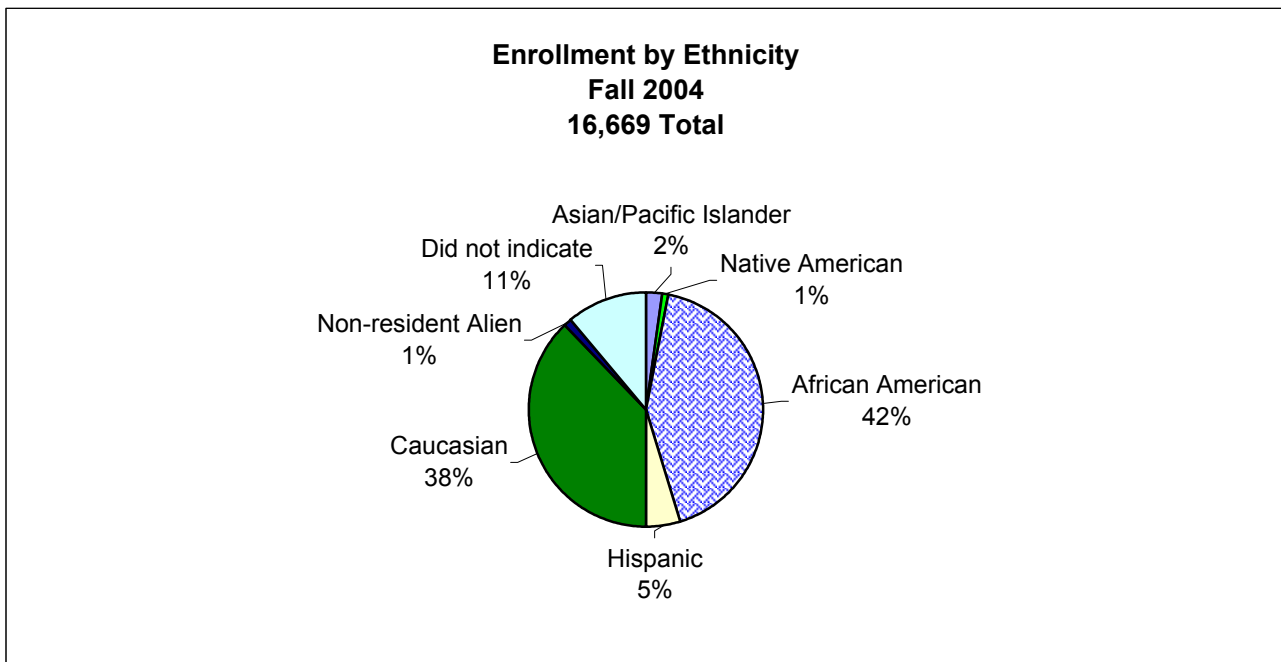
## Enrollment by Gender

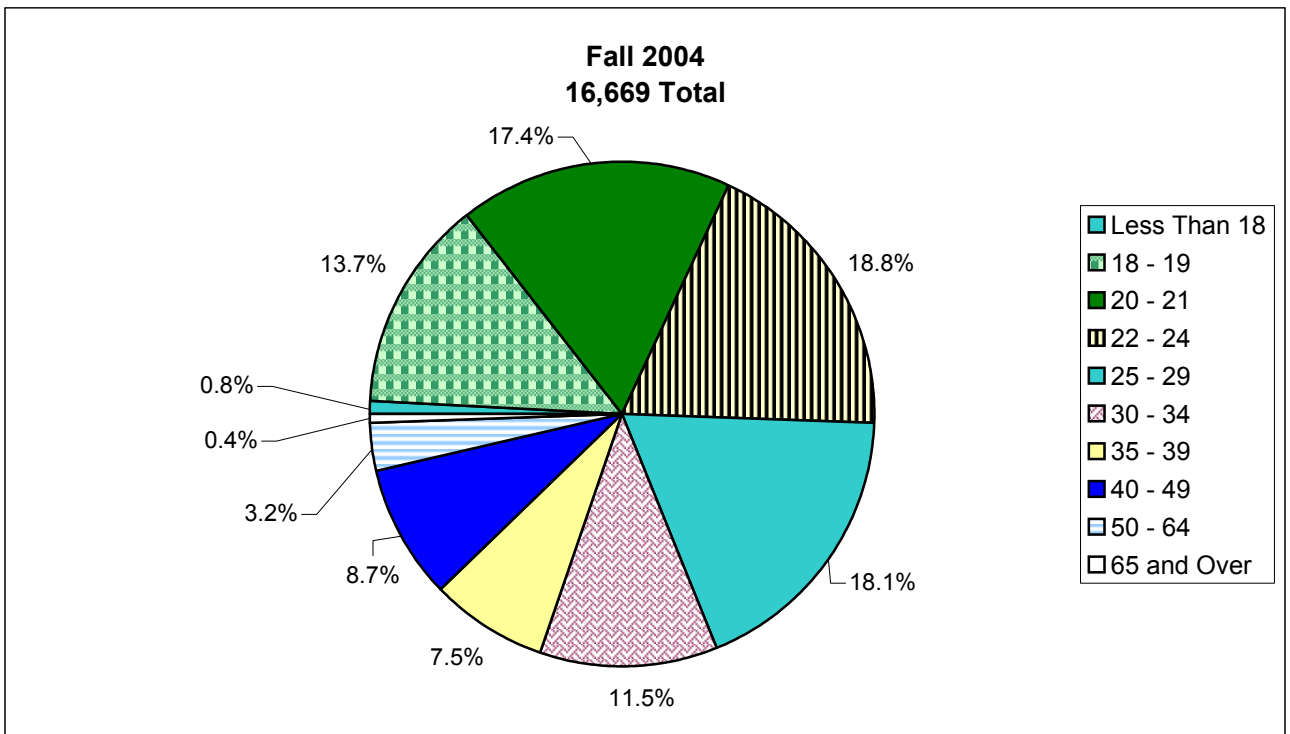
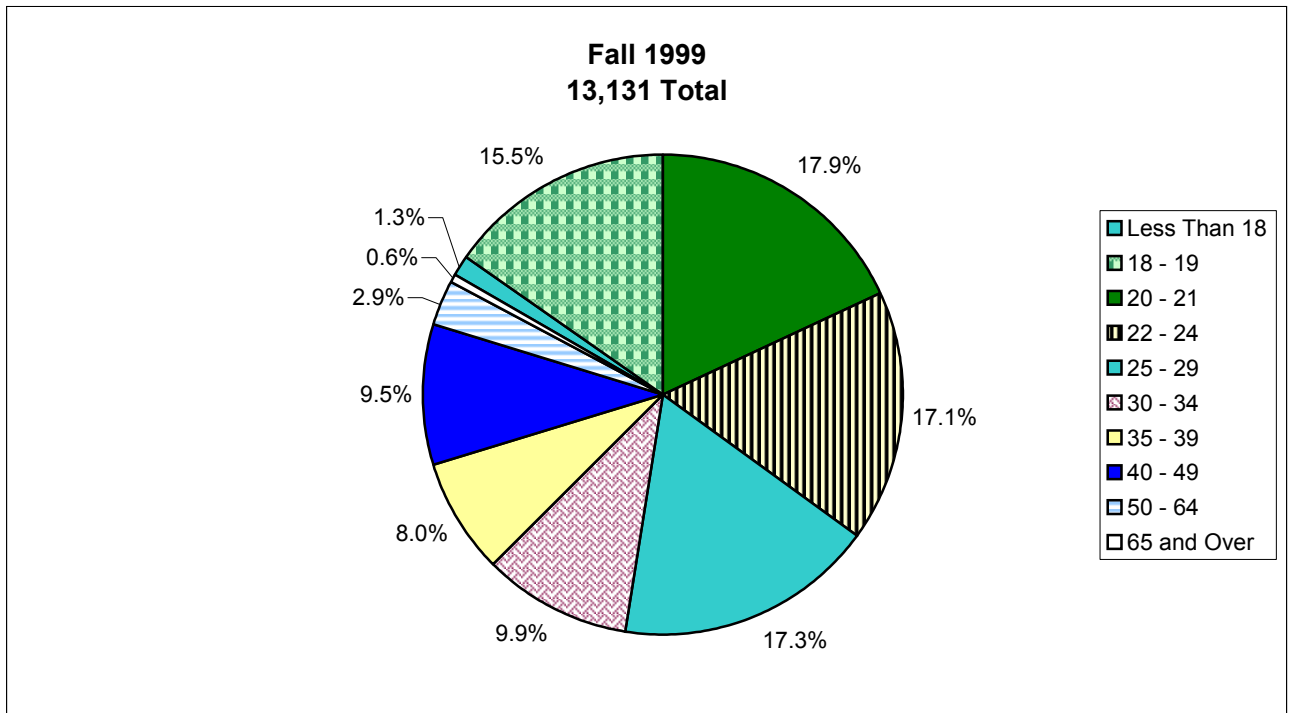

## Enrollment by Age



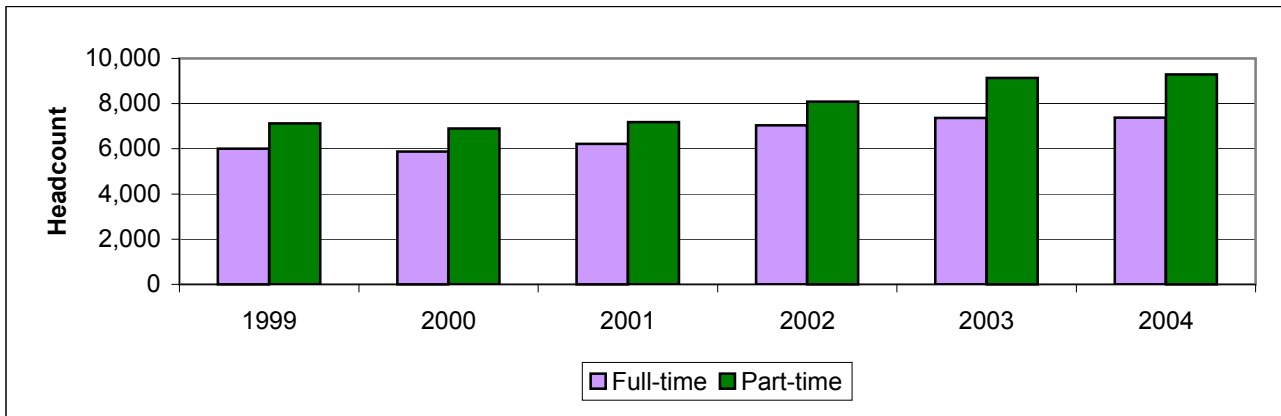

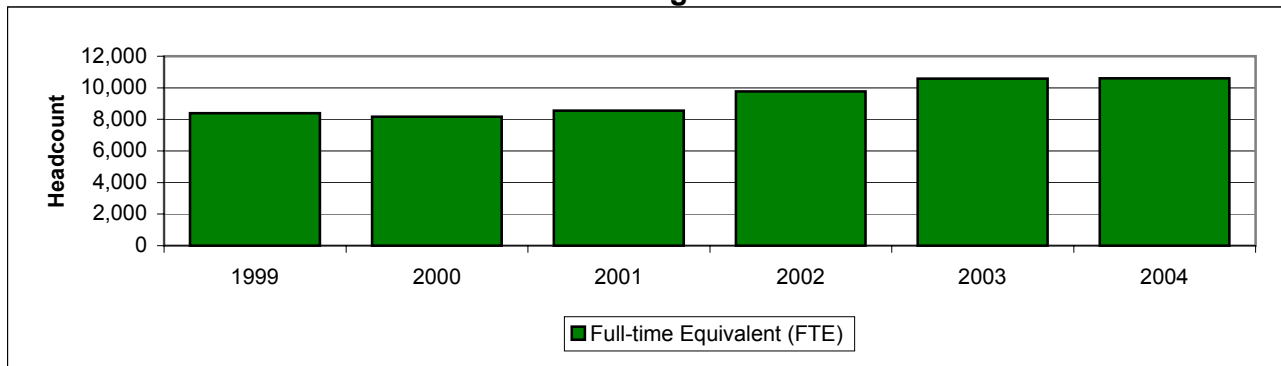

Fall 1999 through Fall 2004**

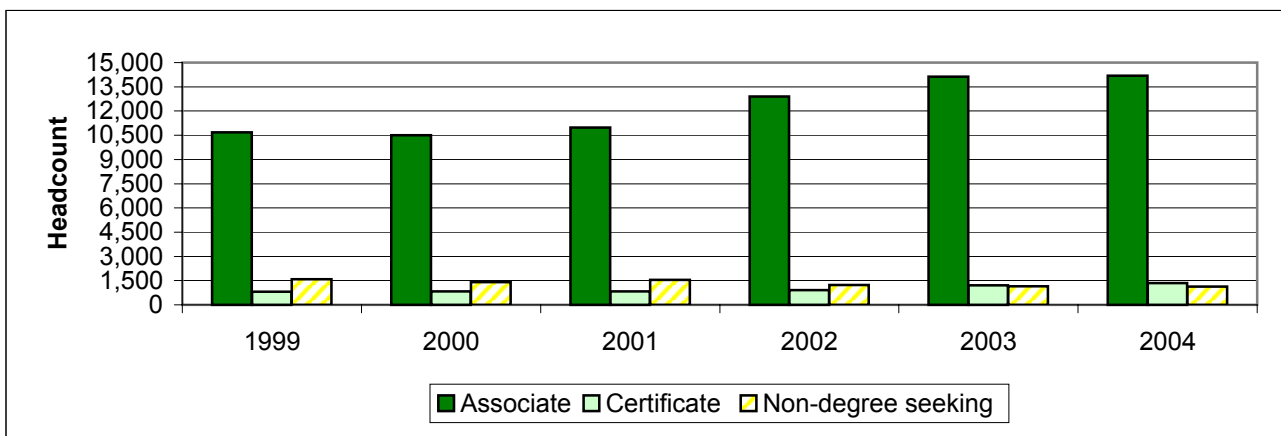


**Enrollment by Full-Time Equivalent (FTE\*)

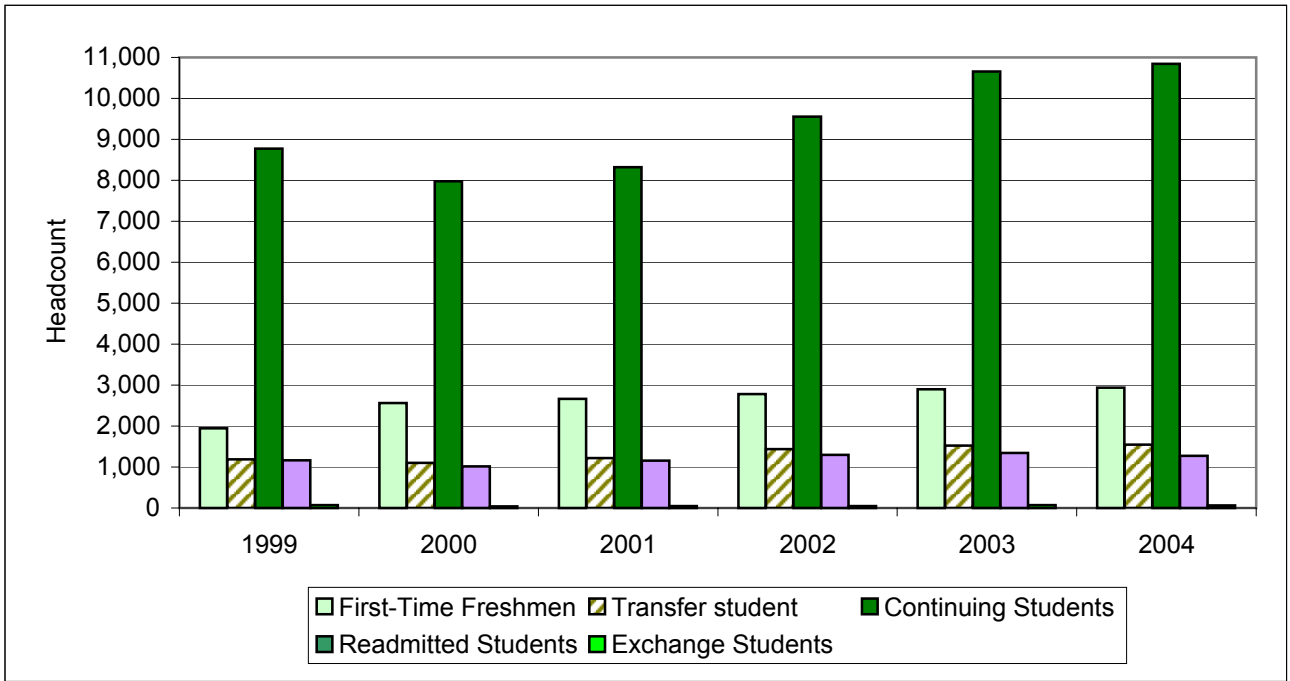

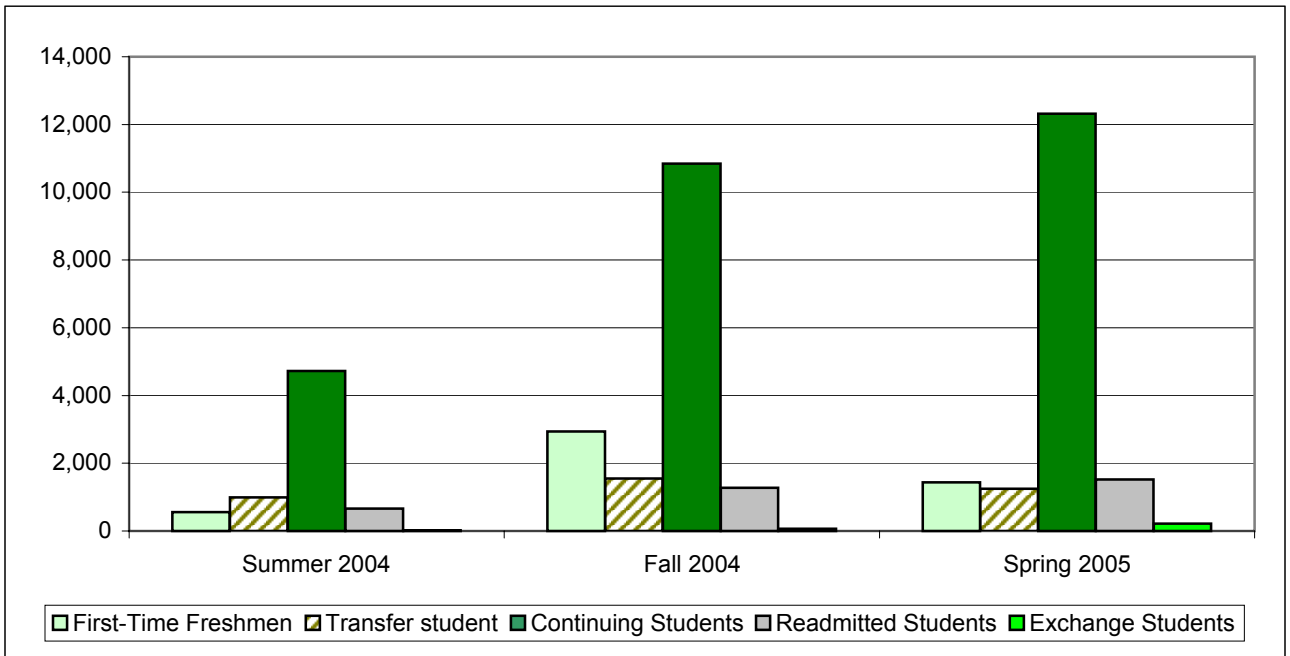

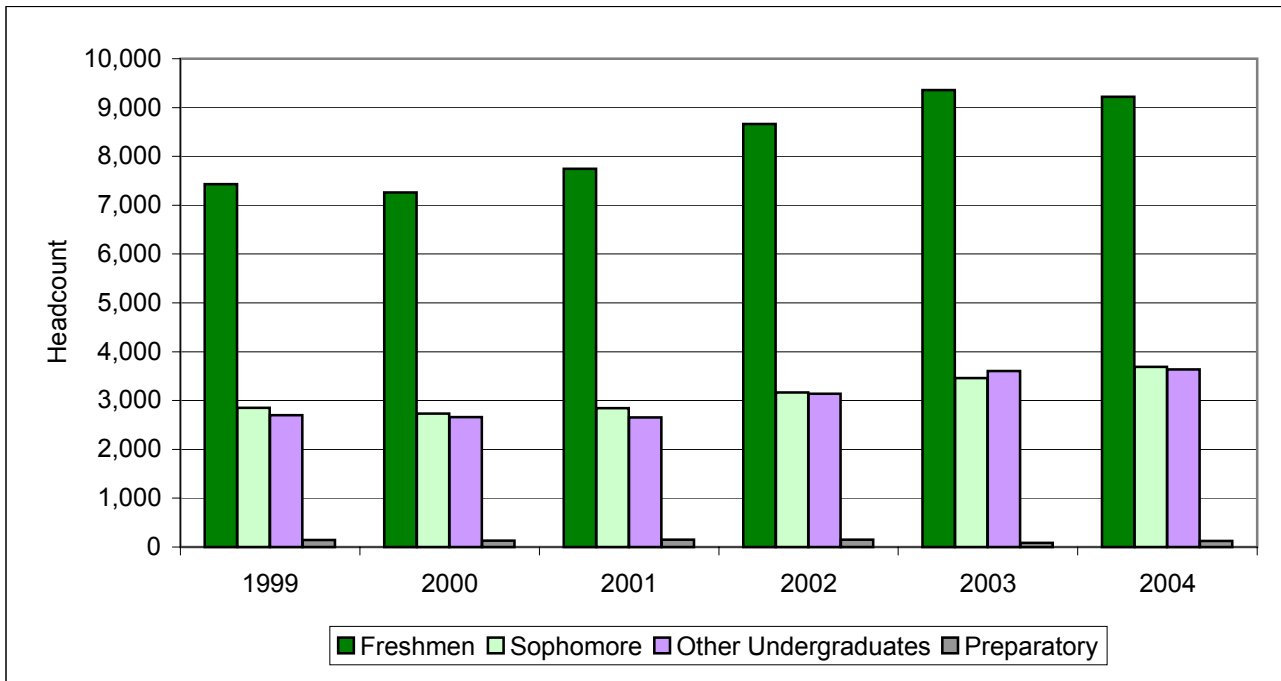
**Student Admission Status  
Fall 1999 through Fall 2004**



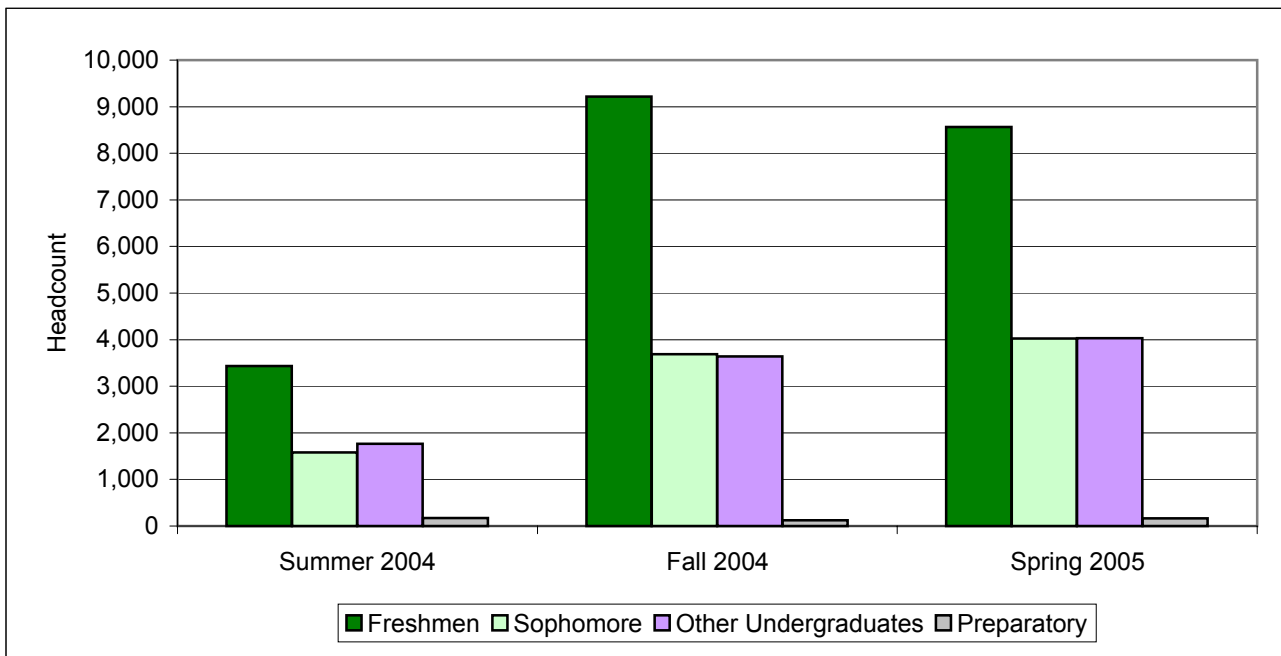
**Student Admission Status
