



## Summary



- 968 Delgado students live in Kenner zip codes 70062-63(211) and 700064-65(757)
- 95.4% attend City Park campus with 17.8% of them in the Science & Math Division.
- Students from these zip codes account for 9,316 credit hours.
- 45.0% are Caucasian, 26.2% are Black and 17.5% are Hispanic.
- 55.9% of students in the Kenner zip codes are freshmen.
- 56.5% are part-time and 90.5% are seeking degrees.
- 71.9% are under the age of 30.
- 71.1% are women.

## Student Demographics by Zip Code










## Admission Status & Classification Enrollment by Zip Code
