Summary

- 1692 Delgado students live in New Orleans East zip codes 70126(627), 70127(479), 70128(331) and 70129(255).
- 71.5% are women and 79.3% are African American.
- Students from these zip codes account for 16,733 enrollment credits.
- 52.7% are part-time and 93.4% are seeking degrees.
- 71.8% are under the age of 30.
- 94% attend City Park campus with 22.3% of them in the Basic Education Division.
- Almost 60% of students from these zip codes are freshmen



Enrollment by Age and Zip Code








Admission Status & Classification Enrollment by Zip Code


